Section 3: Public notice shall be given in The DuPage County Chronicle newspaper of general circulation published in the county in which said district is located, and a public hearing shall be held, all in the manner and time prescribed in said notice, which notice shall be not less than 1/8 page in size, with type no smaller than 12 point, enclosed in a black border not less than 1/4 inch wide, and in substantially the following form:

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Winfield School District 34 for 2025 will be held on December 18th, 2025 at 6:55 P.M. at the Winfield Central School.

- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$5,661,304.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$5,940,000. This represents a 4.92% increase over the previous year.

- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2024 were \$799,532.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2025 are \$789,700.

- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$6,460,836.
The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$6,729,700. This represents a 4.16% increase over the previous year.
