

- ✓ All Grades by Student Group
  - ✓ Race/Ethnicity District performance at the Meets Grade Level or Above exceeded State and Region in every Race/Ethnicity student group by up to 21 points.
  - ✓ Program Groups District performance at the Meets Grade Level or Above met or exceeded State and Region in most student program groups by up to 17 points.
- ✓ **Annual Growth and Accelerated Learning -** District rates of Annual Growth in Reading and Math exceeded the State and Region, while Accelerated Learning exceeded State and Region in Math.




