Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the third grading cycle (November 9, 2015 – December 18, 2015).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 25 days (November 9, 2012 – December 18, 2012).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 3 is 95.46%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for PK (90.84), followed by 12th grade (93.94).
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade (96.12), followed by 6th grade (96.02).
- First Semester attendance for 78 days of instruction is 96.34%
