4. Approval of Financial Report

Chris Marcy has provided a memo and last month's financials for your approval.

5. Scheduling of Budget Hearing

In order to levy the fully authorized operating millage without going through the Truth & Taxation Hearing process, we must comply with Section 16 of the Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act. This calls for the establishment of a budget hearing, including newspaper notification and resolutions proposing the adoption of millage rates. The law requires school budgets to be adopted prior to the beginning of the fiscal year, which is July 1, 2026. A copy of the notice for such a hearing, including the time, date, and place, along with the availability of the budget for public inspection, is in your board packet. This notice must be published at least six (6) days prior to the hearing.

It is recommended that the Board take action to schedule the budget hearing for 6:00 p.m., Monday, June 8, 2026, in the boardroom of the Center for the Arts.

6. Approval of OAISD General Fund Budget Resolution

Furniture & Equipment, asphalt paving and technology will also be presented at future meetings. It is recommended that \$59,327,157 is approved tonight for construction cost bid package #2.
