SUBJECT: Driver Ed. Cars Purchase

Department: Driver Education

Amount: \$22,497.00 per car, times 4 cars – Total \$89,988.00

Budget: Driver Education

Justification: To replace obsolete cars, 4 new cars for our high schools will be rotated into the driver's education inventory. The \$89,988.00 will be covered from \$97,384.00 allocated from the State Driver's Education budget for Weber School District.

Obsolete Cars: One obsolete car was purchased from the WSD CTE department; another is being placed at Two Rivers High School to start a Driver Education program; two obsolete cars will be sold through Public Surplus.

Recommendation: Young Hyundai won the purchasing bid.
