WORLD LANGUAGE & NATIVE LANGUAGE LITERACY INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ADOPTION

POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION

In February 2010 the Second Language & Native Language Literacy Project Team was charged to conduct a curriculum review and make recommendations to the Board in accordance with the District's Quality Curriculum Cycle. The Project Team's Final Report was presented to and discussed by the Board on June 7, 2011. Included in the Final Report was the Project Team's recommendation for re-adoption of the current materials.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Based on teacher surveys indicating that currently adopted materials remain adequate for teaching, the Project Team unanimously voted to recommend that the Board re-adopt the following list of instructional materials for Second Language & Native Language Literacy. Upon re-adoption of these texts by the school board, Teaching and Learning will file the *Notification of District Independent Textbook Adoption* forms with ODE.

RECOMMENDATION:

(11-84) It is recommended that the School Board approve the Second Language & Native Language Literacy Project Team's recommendation of re-adoption of the World Language and Native Language Literacy instructional materials listed on page 23 of the Second Language & Native Language Literacy Project Team Final Report.
