

Data Boost—Estimated FY 2024 New Money Amounts

The Legislature recently agreed to approve Supplemental State Aid (SSA) state percent of growth rate at 3.0% for FY 2024 (SF 192). Additionally, SF 192 extended the property tax replacement payment provision through FY 2024 and provided \$30.3 million in transportation equity. The Governor signed the bill on February 7, 2023. As a result of the bill:

- All districts will receive a \$222 per pupil increase for the regular program cost per pupil in FY 2024.
- The state cost per pupil will increase from \$7,413 to \$7,635. Note that SF 192 did not extend the district cost per pupil equity provision for FY 2024.
- New money is estimated to total \$110.9 million (3.07%) in FY 2024, up from \$83.2 million (2.4%) in FY 2023.
- The number of districts eligible for budget guarantee in FY 2024 totaled 72 (21.8%) and totaled \$5.5 million (unadjusted for two school mergers that will occur in FY 2024).


New money represents the change in total regular program dollars from one year to the next. The new money percent is the percentage change in total regular program dollars. Total regular program funding represents about 70% of the funding generated through the school aid formula. New money provides a good indication of how much funding will be available to cover cost increases a school district will incur for that year. The following map provides the estimated percentage of new money for each school district for FY 2024.

The following tables provide information by enrollment categories. **Table 1** has new money information, **Table 2** has information on budget enrollments, and **Table 3** has data on budget guarantee amounts. Information of note:

- 27 school districts (8.3%) will have no increase in new money for FY 2024.
- Overall enrollments increased by 845 while 166 districts (50.8%) had a decrease.
- Pending board approval, the estimated budget guarantee amount for FY 2024 totals \$5.5 million, with 72 school districts (22.0%) eligible for the provision. It should be noted this provision is funded entirely with local property taxes.
- Note that amounts displayed assume all 72 districts eligible for the budget guarantee will pass
 the board resolution for the budget guarantee at the full amount, and don't include the impact
 of the two school district mergers beginning in FY 2024.
