### **QISD Board Report for Reagan Elementary, Month of April 2017**

- **STAAR testing went well**

We have completed our first round of STAAR testing (4<sup>th</sup> grade Writing and 5<sup>th</sup> grade Reading/Math). 5<sup>th</sup> graders are under SSI (Student Success Initiative), which means they must Meet Standard on both the Reading and Math STAAR tests to be promoted to 6<sup>th</sup> grade. We should receive results from this round of STAAR testing on April 18, and we will communicate these results to parents. Students who do not Meet Standard will have intensive intervention from both the grade level teachers and Success Center. And if any student does not Meet Standard on the second round, he/she will attend summer school (June 5-9 and June 12-16) and take the test for a third time in June (June 19-20). The next round of STAAR tests will be:

- Monday, May 8 – 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade Math, 5<sup>th</sup> grade Math retest (if needed)
- Tuesday, May 9 – 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade Reading, 5<sup>th</sup> Reading retest (if needed)
- Wednesday, May 10 – 5<sup>th</sup> grade Science

- **Pre-K/Kindergarten Round-Up**

Scheduled for Tuesday, April 25, 8:00 am- 4:00 pm  
Children who are 4 by September 1 will qualify for Pre-K  
Children who are 5 by September 1 will qualify for Kindergarten  
Round-Up allows us to get an idea of enrollment so we can plan for staffing/classrooms.
