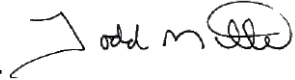



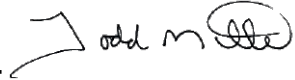

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:**

McAllen ISD continues to implement COVID 19 state guidelines as prescribed by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), Hidalgo County, and the Office of the Governor. On July 14, 2020 the Hidalgo County Local Health Authority ordered "all public and private schools, from grades pre-kindergarten through grade 12, will not re-open for in-campus instruction until after September 27, 2020." Following these guidelines, the District will implement Stage 3 of the COVID- 19 Action Plan. Under Stage 3, the majority of our employees, including teachers and support staff at both the District and Campus levels, will perform their duties via technology from the safety of their homes.

The Executive Leadership Team will provide an update to the Board on the action steps that are being followed to prepare for remote instruction.

# CARES ACT

- **Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER)**
- **Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF):**
  - The greater of \$250 per State Compensatory student (16,066) or \$50,000
  - Reimbursements of up to 75% of eligible expenditures
  - Must apply and valid for eligible expenditures from 3/1/2020 through 5/20/2020
  - TEA has not released funding parameters, expected Summer 2020
- **Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (GEERF):**
  - Texas will be allocated \$307 Million
  - Gov. Abbott has discretion over how this will be spent/distributed
  - A portion of these funds is to provide Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to Districts
    - Estimated allocated amount to MISD is \$226,133.01
    - Disposable and Reusable Masks, Gloves, Hand Sanitizer, Thermometers, and Face Shields
  - Additional information is forthcoming



# Additional Aid

- Health and Economic Recovery Omnibus Emergency Solutions (HEROES) ACT:
  - Passed by the House in March 2020
  - Would create a \$90 billion "state fiscal stabilization fund" for the U.S. Department of Education.
  - About 65% (\$58B) would go through states to local school districts.
  - Pending passage by Senate
- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA):
  - Public Assistance Program Category B Emergency Protective Measures
  - Eligible expenditures include Health and Safety
    - Health Services
    - FMO Custodial Division
    - Police Department
  - Reimbursements of up to 75% of eligible expenditures



# ESSER Federal Grant

## Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER)

- Funding:
  - ESSER funds may take the place of state or local funds for allowable activities
  - ESSER funds are to replace state or local funds \$1 for \$1
  - ESSER funds do not represent new monies to the District
  - MISD entitlement amount is \$8,802,678
    - \$8,362,544 - 95% of District allowable activities
    - \$440,134 - 5% of PNP equitable services
- Grant Application Process:
  - MISD must apply through TEA
  - Application deadline is August 24, 2020
  - TEA will issue a Notice of Grant Award (NOGA) to the District of 20% within 10 days of grant submission. After negotiation, will have 100% access.
- Eligible Expenditures Timeline:
  - Pre-award costs beginning March 13, 2020 are allowed (for any cost responding to pandemic)
  - Funds need to be expended by September 30, 2021 (with extension to Sept. 30, 2022)

# District Plan for ESSER Federal Grant

- The allowable ESSER Federal Grant activity selected by the District will be:
  - Other activities that are necessary to maintain the operation of and continuity of services in LEAs and continuing to employ existing staff
- April 2020 monthly payroll expenses will be transferred from the General Fund (state fund) to the ESSER Fund (federal grant)
  - Selected Fund 199 staff will be required to sign a semi-annual certification statement through TalentEd (as required of all Federally-funded programs) prior to reimbursement

# District Plan for ESSER Federal Grant

- Financial Reporting Requirements:
  - ESSER funds are subject to audit requirements under the Single Audit Act
  - ESSER funds are subject to Education Department General Administrative Regulations (EDGAR)
  - Expenditure reports are required to be submitted to TEA for reimbursement purposes

# District Plan for ESSER Federal Grant

- McAllen ISD selected to reserve funds at the district level in order to serve all Title 1 and non-Title 1 campuses by counting ages 5 to 17 students in the district and the same in the participating private non-profit (PNP) schools.
- ESSER Grant/Private School Distribution

**McAllen ISD-Option 2.** District reserves funds at district level to serve both Title 1 and non-Title 1 campuses for 2019-2020 school year.

**NOTE:** In McAllen ISD, the PNP equitable services share exceeds 5%, so the district will contact TEA Grant Support to request additional PNP equitable services funding. The overage is \$32,726.


# District Plan for ESSER Federal Grant


- McAllen ISD must conduct consultations with all participating private schools before submitting the application to discuss:
  - The methodology for equitable services as provided under Title 1, Part A to students and teachers in both entities
  - Not based on PNP poverty data (as in Title 1, Part A), only on number of children ages 5-17 during the 19-20 school year (a per pupil allocation)
  - The allowable use of funds (12 categories), not required to provide supplemental services
  - The regulations concerning how funds may be expended/purchasing guidelines
  - LEA timelines for providing services and reporting requirements to TEA
  - The District retains all control over purchases, licenses, inventory, etc. of this grant
  - Must work towards a “goal of agreement” between LEA and PNPs.
- Additionally, McAllen ISD will:
  - Comply with OMB standard assurances, certifications, EDGAR, all federal regulations, etc.
  - Cooperate with all TEA requirements for programmatic monitoring and reporting requirements

INCORPORATED**

This Contract, made and entered into effective by and between **McALLEN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT** (hereinafter referred to as "District") and **Proctor.io Incorporated**, an Arizona corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, District recognizes that the Instructional Services Department of District (the "Department") requires certain services ("Services") rendered by Contractor who has the training, experience, and qualifications necessary to provide the services;

**WHEREAS**, Contractor submitted a quote in response to the needs of the District;

**WHEREAS**, District has determined that the proper, orderly and efficient delivery of quality Services for the District can be accomplished best by contracting with Contractor in accordance with the local, state and federal regulations for procurement;

**WHEREAS**, District has determined that for proper and efficient operation of the Department, several objectives must be met, including, among others, coordination of schedules and assignments, administrative ease and efficiency, consistency and uniformity in book and recordkeeping, and the delivery of quality Services;

**WHEREAS**, the Contractor is willing to accept the responsibility of providing the Services to the District in accordance with recognized standards, the Board Policies of District, applicable laws and regulations and the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to provide a full statement of their agreement in connection with the provision of the Services by Contractor during the term of this Contract;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the following mutual agreements and covenants, it is understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

**1. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CONTRACTOR**

Contractor shall perform all of the work and provide all equipment, materials, and labor required in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract Documents, as hereinafter defined.

Contractor represents and warrants to District that Contractor possesses all of the licenses, permits, and expertise required to provide the equipment, materials, and labor and perform the services contemplated hereunder. Contractor warrants and represents that during the term of this Contract, Contractor shall maintain all such licenses and

permits. Contractor warrants that the services rendered and equipment, materials, and labor furnished shall be in accordance with the terms of the Contract Documents.

The term Contract Documents as used herein shall include the following documents, and this Contract does hereby expressly incorporate same herein as fully as if set forth verbatim in this Contract. The terms and provisions of this Contract shall control with respect to any conflicting or inconsistent terms or provisions in any exhibit to this Contract.

- A. This Contract
- B. Exhibit "A" – Contractor's Services & Fees
- C. Exhibit "B" – Contractor's Certificate of Insurance

This Contract is entered into subject to the following conditions:

- A. Contractor shall use its best efforts to keep to a minimum disruption or interruption of duties and/or work of employees of District and /or the learning environment of students of District while performing its work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- B. Contractor assumes full responsibility and liability for all labor and materials furnished and activities conducted by Contractor pursuant to this Contract and any action or omission incident thereto.

## **2. INSURANCE COVERAGE**

At all times during the term of this Contract, Contractor will, at Contractor's expense, carry and maintain the following insurance coverages with the minimum coverage amounts as follows:

- A. Statutory Workers' Compensation (REQUIRED FOR WORK PERFORMED ON DISTRICT PROPERTY) and Employer's Liability Limits - \$500,000
- B. Commercial General Insurance (occurrence basis only) \$1,000,000 each claim and in the aggregate
- C. Business Commercial or Personal Automobile Liability Insurance in the amounts specified by the Texas Tort Claims Act, Chapter 101 of the Texas Practice and Remedies Code for all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles; each person \$100,000; each accident \$300,000; and for property damage, each occurrence of \$100,000. No deletions/exclusions from standard coverage form allowed without written consent of District. (REQUIRED FOR WORK PERFORMED ON DISTRICT PROPERTY)
- D. The District shall be named as an additional insured by endorsement on the Contractor's policy as to the subject job.
- E. The Contractor will provide a certificate of insurance to the Administrator of the Department evidencing such coverage and will notify the Administrator in writing immediately if any change in coverage occurs for any reason. Such Certificate of insurance shall be attached to this Contract as Exhibit B.

### **3. TRANSFER, ASSIGNMENT, ETC.**

Contractor agrees, for itself and on behalf of its successors, and any person or persons claiming under Contractor by virtue hereof, that this Contract and the rights, interests, and benefits hereunder cannot be assigned, transferred, pledged, or hypothecated in any way and shall not be subject to execution, attachment, or similar process. Any such attempt to do so, contrary to the terms hereof, shall be null and void and shall relieve the District of any and all obligations or liability hereunder.

### **4. ADJUDICATION**

If any provision, paragraph, or subparagraph of this Contract is adjudged by any court of law to be void or unenforceable, in whole or in part, such adjudication shall not be deemed to affect the validity of the remainder of the Contract, including any other provision, paragraph, or subparagraph.

### **5. PROVISIONS, PARAGRAPHS**

Each provision, paragraph, and subparagraph of this Contract is declared to be separable from every other provision, paragraph, and subparagraph and constitutes a separate and distinct covenant.

### **6. PAYMENT**

As consideration for performing the services and supplying the equipment, materials and labor pursuant to the Contract Documents, District agrees to pay Contractor a cost consistent with the pricing agreed upon, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein for all purposes. The payment for services, materials, and labor shall be paid by District to Contractor as invoiced upon successful and satisfactory installation of equipment and materials pursuant to the Contract Documents upon verification by District's authorized representative of such invoice in compliance with the Contract Documents.

### **7. TAXES AND BENEFITS**

Contractor expressly acknowledges that Contractor will be acting as an independent contractor for all purposes, including payment of social security, withholding taxes, and all other federal, state, and local taxes. Contractor, as independent contractor, shall be solely responsible to its employees, agents, third party contractors any other person supplying labor or material for Contractor in performing any portion of this Contract or any action or omission incident thereto. Contractor also agrees to pay for and provide workers compensation insurance covering all employees working for Contractor in performing labor pursuant to this Contract or any activity incident thereto.

### **8. INCURRING FINANCIAL OBLIGATION**

The Contractor will incur no financial obligation on behalf of District without prior written approval of the Superintendent of District. The Contractor will be responsible for all personal and professional expenses.

## 9. ACCESS TO BOOKS AND RECORDS

Contractor recognizes that District is a participant in governmental payment programs. In connection with such programs, the Contractor agrees to cooperate with District and provide to District reasonable assistance in District's efforts to meet the requirements for participation in and payment under such programs.

## 10. NON-DISCRIMINATION

Contractor will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, age, religion, national origin, or handicap in providing services under this Contract or in the selection of associates, employees, or independent contractors.

## 11. HOLD HARMLESS

Contractor agrees to hold harmless and indemnify District from any liability and/or damages, which may directly or indirectly arise from or occur in connection with Contractor's performance under this Contract or any action, activity or omission incident thereto. Such indemnification shall include but not be limited to all District's attorneys' fees and costs incurred in defending or responding to any action brought or threatened against District for any action or omission arising from or incident to Contractor's performance under this Contract.

## 12. TERM AND TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

**Term.** The term of this Contract commence on August 24, 2020 and remain effective for one (1) year through August 23, 2021. All services must be completed during the term of the Contract.

A. **Termination without Cause.** District shall have the right to terminate this Contract without cause on thirty (30) days written notice to the Contractor.

B. **Termination with Cause.**

a. **Termination by District.** District may terminate this Contract immediately upon the occurrence of any of the following events:

- i. Any conduct of the Contractor, which jeopardizes the health, safety, or welfare of any person, or the safety, reputation, or the regular functions of the District.
- ii. Failure to provide evidence of liability insurance, as required by numbered Paragraph 2 hereof.
- iii. Failure of Contractor to immediately bar any individual from performing services under this Contract, if such individual does not meet the qualifications required by this Contract or if such individual commits a material breach of one of the terms of this Contract.
- iv. In addition, if the Contractor commits a material breach of any of the terms of this Contract, other than those listed in subsections (i) through (iii) above, District may terminate this Contract upon no less than thirty (30) days written notice.

- b. Termination by Contractor.** In the event District breaches any material term of this Contract, Contractor may terminate this Contract upon no less than fifteen (15) days written notice.
- c. Non-Interference.** Following the expiration of this Contract or its termination for any reason, Contractor agrees to do nothing that may interfere with any contract of District with any other individual or entity for the provision of the services herein.

### 13. NOTICES

All notices provided to be given under this Contract shall be given in writing and will be deemed delivered when deposited in the United States Postal Service by certified or registered mail, addressed to the proper party, at the following addresses:

### 14. LAW

**THE INTERPRETATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND ALL OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES CREATED BY THIS AGREEMENT ARE PERFORMABLE IN HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS.**

### 15. NO IMPLIED WAIVER

No waiver or modification of the Contract Documents shall be valid unless it is in writing and signed by the District and Contractor.

### 16. SEVERABILITY

The invalidity or unenforceability of any provisions of this Contract will not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision.

### 17. ASSIGNABILITY

The right and obligations of District hereunder shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the successors and assigns of District. The Contractor may not assign Contractor's rights or obligations under this Contract without District's written consent. Any assignment in violation of this provision shall give District the right to terminate this Contract immediately, upon written notice to the Contractor.

## **18. AMENDMENTS**

All provisions of the Contract Documents shall be strictly complied with and performed by Contractor; and no amendment to this Contract shall be made except upon the written agreement by the parties. No amendment shall be construed to release either party from any obligation, representation, and/or warranty of the Contract Documents except as specifically provided for in such amendment.

## **19. ENTIRE CONTRACT**

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Contract supersedes any and all other agreements, whether oral or in writing, between the parties with respect to the subject matter the Contract.

## **20. INTERPRETATION**

The defined terms used herein are for convenience only and do not limit the contents of this Contract.

## **21. VARIATIONS OF POUNOUNS**

All pronouns and all variations thereof shall be deemed to refer to the masculine, feminine or neuter, singular or plural, as the identity of the person or persons or entity may require.

## **22. AUTHORIZATION FOR CONTRACT**

The execution and performance of this Contract by District and Contractor have been duly authorized by all necessary laws, resolutions or corporate action, and this Contract constitutes the valid and enforceable obligations of Contractor and District in accordance with its terms.

## **23. IMMUNITIES**

Nothing in this Contract is intended to and District does not hereby waive, release or relinquish any right to assert any of the defenses District enjoys by virtue of the state or federal constitution, laws, rules or regulations, and any sovereign, official or qualified immunity available to District as to any claim or action of any person, entity, or individual against District.

## **24. NON-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.**

In the event no funds or insufficient funds are appropriated and budgeted for the services and funds are otherwise unavailable, by any means whatsoever, in any fiscal period in which the payments for the services are due under this Contract, then District shall, not less than sixty (60) days prior to the end of such applicable fiscal period, in writing, notify Contractor and any assignee of such occurrence. This Contract shall thereafter terminate and be rendered null and void on the last day of the fiscal period for which appropriations were made, without penalty, liability or expense to the District of any kind, except as to (i) the portions of the payment herein agreed upon for which funds shall have been appropriated and budgeted or are otherwise available and (ii) District's other obligations and liabilities under this Contract relating to,

accruing or arising prior to such termination. In the event of such termination, District agrees to peaceably request that the Contractor or its assignee stop the services on the date of such termination.

**25. FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA).**

Parental consent must be obtained before personally identifiable information is used for any purpose other than meeting a requirement under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act or disclosed to anyone other than officials of agencies collecting or using this information. The District may not release information from these records without parental consent, except as provided in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).

**26. CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION.**

Pursuant to Texas Education Code Section 22.0834, Contractor shall obtain criminal history record information that relates to an employee, applicant for employment, agent or subcontractor of the Contractor if the employee, applicant, agent, or subcontractor has or will have continuing duties related to the contracted services herein, and the duties are or will be performed on school property or at another location where students are regularly present. Contractor shall certify to District before beginning work and at no less than on an annual basis thereafter, that this process was followed.

Contractor shall assume all expenses associated with the background checks, and shall immediately remove any employee or agent who was convicted of a felony, or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, as defined by Texas law, from District's property or other location where students are regularly present, District shall be the final decider of what constitutes a "location where students are regularly present". Contractor's violation of this section shall constitute a material breach of contract. If the Contractor is the person, owner, or operator of the business entity, that individual may not self-certify regarding the criminal history record information and its review, and must submit original evidence of compliance acceptable to District, with this Contract.

**27. ENTITIES THAT BOYCOTT ISRAEL**

If Contractor is required to make a certification pursuant to Section 2270.002 of the Texas Government Code, Contractor certifies that Contractor does not boycott Israel and will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract resulting from this solicitation. If Contractor does not make that certification, Contractor must indicate that in its Response and state why the certification is not required.

**28. Sec. 2252.152 CONTRACTS WITH COMPANIES ENGAGED IN BUSINESS WITH IRAN, SUDAN, OR FOREIGN TERRORIST ORGANIZATION PROHIBITED.**

A governmental entity may not enter into a governmental contract with a company that is identified on a list prepared and maintained under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153.

Sec. 2252.153. **LISTED COMPANIES.** The comptroller shall prepare and maintain, and make available to each governmental entity, a list of companies known to have contracts with or provide supplies or services to a foreign terrorist organization.

Sec. 2252.154. **EXCEPTION.** Notwithstanding any other law, a company that the United States government affirmatively declares to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan its federal sanctions regime relating to Iran, or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization is not subject to contract prohibition under this subchapter. SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 2252, Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a contract or purchase for which a governmental entity first advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications on or after the effective date of this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

### **29. BREACH OF CONTRACT AND FEES**

If either party hereto shall breach any of the terms hereof, such party shall pay to the non-defaulting party all of the non-defaulting party's costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by such party in enforcing the terms of this Contract.

### **30. FURTHER DOCUMENTS**

The parties hereto covenant and agree that they will execute such other and future instruments and documents as are or may become necessary or convenient to effectuate and carry out the terms of this Contract.

### **31. BINDING NATURE**

This Contract shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns where permitted by this Contract.

### **32. CONTRACT TERMS CONTROL**

The terms and provisions of this Contract shall control with respect to any conflicting or inconsistent terms or provisions in any exhibit to this Contract.

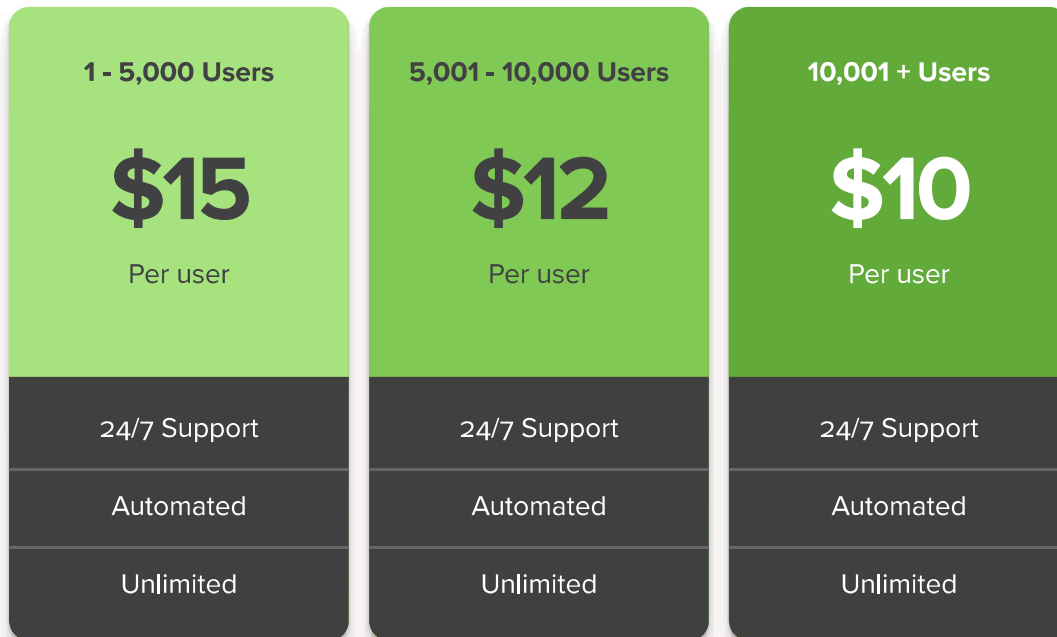

# SOFTWARE-AS-A-SERVICE AGREEMENT

Proctor.io Incorporated (“**Company**”) and customer (“**Customer**”) (each a “**Party**,” collectively the “**Parties**”), enter into this Software-As-A-Service Agreement (the “**SaaS Agreement**”), incorporating in whole the Order Form, Terms of Service <https://proctorio.com/terms> (including SaaS Agreement definitions), Privacy Policy, <https://proctorio.com/privacy>, and Service Level Performance Standards, <https://proctorio.com/sla>, (collectively, the “**Agreement**”), effective when both Parties’ execute the SaaS Agreement (the “**Effective Date**”).

## 1. ACCESS AND USE.

**1.1 Provision of Access.** Subject to this Agreement, Company grants to Customer a non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access the features and functions of the Application Service during the Term (as defined below), solely for use by Authorized End Users according to this Agreement’s terms and conditions. Customer may use the Application Service for proctoring purposes only, and solely for the number of Authorized End Users permitted in the Order Form. For Company to configure the Application Service, Customer agrees to provide Company all logins to its platform (“**Platform**”). Customer must provide Platform log-in information to configure the Application Service and associated services. After configuring the Application Service, Company will provide Customer passwords and network links or connections allowing Customer to access the Application Service (the “**Access Protocols**”), and the applicable Application Documentation. Customer is responsible for all Authorized End Users’ acts and omissions and will inform them of this Agreement’s applicable provisions and require them to comply.

**1.2 Application Documentation License.** Subject to this Agreement’s terms, Company grants Customer a non-exclusive, non-transferable right and license to use the Application Documentation during the Term related to Customer’s use of the Application Service. As between the Parties, Company agrees that Customer retains all right, title, and interest in and to Customer Content, granting Company a non-exclusive, worldwide right and license to use, copy, manipulate and render Customer Content through the Application Service.

**1.3 Suspension.** Company may temporarily suspend Customer’s and any Authorized End User’s access to any portion of, or all of the Application Service according to Company’s obligations and responsibilities in the Service Level Performance Standards.

## 2. FEES AND EXPENSES; PAYMENTS.

**2.1 Fees.** Customer shall pay to Company, without offset or deduction, the fees stated in the Order Form (the “**Fees**”). Unless otherwise stated, Customer shall pay all Fees within thirty (30) calendar days after the Company issues an invoice. Company may adjust the Fees after the initial term of this Agreement, and each year following, by providing at least one hundred and twenty (120) days written notice, electronically or otherwise.

**2.2 Customer Operating Expenses.** Customer must pay to implement this Agreement, including Application Service or Authorized End User costs.

**2.3 Taxes.** As allowable by law, Customer must pay all applicable taxes, export and import fees, customs, duties, and similar charges (other than Company income tax), and related penalties and interest for the grant of license rights, or delivery of services. Customer’s payments to Company are free and clear of any withholding taxes. Customer is solely responsible for any taxes, and will provide Company with evidence of payment.

**2.4 Late Payments; Interest.** Any unpaid amount will accrue interest at the lesser of 1.5% per month or the legal maximum rate, until paid.

## 3. TREATMENT OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION AND DATA.

**3.1 Ownership of Confidential Information.** Each Party has access to the other Party’s Confidential Information or third-party Confidential Information. The disclosing Party/applicable third party owns, and considers proprietary, all Confidential Information.

**3.2 Confidentiality Obligations.** Each Party agrees: (i) to use Confidential Information disclosed by the other Party only for the stated purposes; (ii) not to reproduce Confidential Information the other Party discloses, and to hold in confidence and protect such Confidential Information from dissemination to, and use by, any third party; (iii) neither Party will create any derivative work from the other party’s Confidential Information; (iv) to restrict access to the other Party’s Confidential Information to its personnel, agents, and/or consultants, if any, who have a need to have access and who have been advised of and have agreed in writing to treat such information according to this Agreement’s terms; (v) to assist Company with objecting to a Public Records Law request, and (v) to return or destroy, pursuant to Section 5.4, all Confidential Information in its possession when this Agreement terminates or expires. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Customer agrees that Company may collect and provide non-specific, aggregated, statistical data regarding Customer’s use of the Application Service to third parties. Customer further agrees that Company’s Confidential Information is not: (i) disclosable under any state data practices act, public record act, freedom of information act, or similar laws (“**Public Records Law**”) regarding disclosing documents and information supplied to a state’s Attorney General or member of the public; or (ii) is exempt from disclosure under any Public Records Law.

Parties may

disclose Confidential Information (i) to comply with court, governmental order, or law, if disclosing Party notifies the other Party and attempts obtaining a protective order.

**3.4 Customer Data Uses.** If Customer and any Authorized End User, through the Application Service, collect, use, store and disclose data from any other party, including,

but not limited to Student Users, Customer shall accurately and adequately disclose, either through a privacy policy or otherwise, how Customer collects, uses, stores and discloses

data, including, where applicable, that third parties may serve content and/or advertisements and collect information directly from visitors and may place or recognize cookies on visitors’ browsers. Customer shall follow all federal and state regulations, including, but not limited to, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, when managing all Student User information.

**3.5. Data Transfer or Destruction.** When Company no longer needs Customer Content and, upon Customer request, Company will destroy or transfer all Customer Content in its possession. Company only retains Customer De-Identified Data.

## 4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.

**4.1 Mutual Representations.** Each Party represents and warrants (i) that it is duly organized, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of its jurisdiction of incorporation or organization; (ii) that the execution and performance of this Agreement will not conflict with or violate any provision of any law having applicability to such Party; and (iii) that this Agreement, when executed and delivered, constitutes a valid and binding obligation, and will be enforceable against such Party in accordance with its terms.

**4.2 Service Levels.** Company warrants the Application Service will materially conform to the Service Level Performance Standards when accessed and used according to the Application Documentation and the Access Protocols. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, Customer agrees that its sole and exclusive remedy, and Company’s sole and exclusive obligation, for this warranty breach is in the Service Level Performance Standards which states all representations for Application Service uptime/availability.

**4.3 Security Controls.** Company will store and process Customer Content according to industry best practices, including administrative, physical, and technical safeguards to secure Customer Content from unauthorized access, disclosure, and use. Company will conduct periodic risk assessments and remediate any identified security vulnerabilities in a timely manner. Company has an incident response plan and will notify Customer if a security or privacy incident occurs, as well as best practices for responding to a breach.

## 5. TERM AND TERMINATION.

**5.1 Term.** This Agreement begins on the Effective Date and, unless terminated according to its terms, continues for the Initial Term (stated on the Order Form), and automatically renews for successive 1-year terms, unless a Party provides 60 days’ written notice of nonrenewal before then-current term ends (initial term, and renewal terms, the “**Term**”).

**5.2 Termination for Breach.** Either Party may terminate this Agreement if the other Party materially breaches. The terminating Party must notify the breaching Party, identifying the breach(es) necessitating termination, and the breaching Party, must cure the breach(es) within thirty (30) days of receiving the written notice, otherwise this Agreement terminates.

**5.3 Termination Upon Bankruptcy or Insolvency.** Either Party may terminate this Agreement immediately upon written notice to the other Party, if (i) the other Party is insolvent or unable to pay its debts when due; (ii) the other Party files a bankruptcy or similar petition, or, if filed against, the petition is not removed within ninety (90) days; or (iii) the other Party’s business discontinues; a receiver is appointed, or an assignment made.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:**

In preparation for delivery of remote instruction, the Texas Education Agency has provided guidance to school districts on providing professional development support to educators on the delivery of remote instruction. The guidance includes but is not limited to the following:

- There is a pre-planned calendar for educators with specific supports for implementing asynchronous instruction;
- The professional development calendar includes both initial and ongoing, job-embedded development opportunities;
- And it is clear how the professional learning will develop content knowledge to help educators internalize the asynchronous curriculum and analyze and respond to data with the use of the instructional materials

In order to meet the professional development needs of educators, the school calendar will be revised to replace two teacher workdays (Friday, August 14 and Monday, August 17) scheduled at the beginning of the school year with professional learning days to allow teachers to receive the necessary professional development and planning time to deliver teaching in a remote environment.
