High School English Graduation Requirement

-Four English credits are required for graduation

-Current English courses that meet Graduation requirements

-English 9 (1 credit; full year)

-English 10 (1 credit; full year)

-English 11 (1 credit; full year)

-English 12 (1 credit; full year)

Honors, Advanced Placement, or International Baccalaureate are also possible options for earning ELA credit towards graduation.

Over time, this would result in the phase out of the year-long English 11 and English 12 courses,

Proposed New Course Titles: Film Analysis, Sports Literature & Composition, Mystery: Fiction, and True Crime, Graphic Novels and the Visual Narrative, Senior Symposium, and Junior Forum.

ELA Courses to Bring Back: Ideas that Shape the Modern World (Humanities), Diverse Global Voices (Minority Voices), and African American Literature. (African American History is also coming back as an offering.) Some were renamed to connect better with students. Students provided input.

High School Personal Finance Math Course

Michigan established Personal Finance Standards. Current 8th graders are required to receive .5 credit in Personal Finance as part of their graduation requirement. Districts have flexibility on how this credit is earned.

Proposing a High School Personal Finance Math Course

-Offer a .5 math credit course for 11th and 12th graders focused on personal finance through an entrepreneurship and investment lens focusing on credit, investment, insurance, and taxes and will involve partnership with local business to contextualize the learning.

-Course is taught by a math certified teacher.

-Course counts towards the personal finance credit requirement, as well as for the fourth year math credit required in the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MCM).

**Program update:**

- The Head Start program is currently full with 83 students with 9 students having an IEP.
- Our program participated in Focus Area Two Monitoring Review. Review teams from the Federal level were onsite doing classroom observations where they focused on classroom management, individualized instruction, learning environments, and safety. They monitored the center for safety of facilities, learning environments, and staffing credentials. They reviewed a random sampling of student files to ensure eligibility was determined correctly and completed a fiscal review at the county level. We anticipate feedback from the review within the next month.
- Staff completed conferences for all enrolled students.
- The program reviewed the first Child Observation Record data and set school improvement goals: Teachers will explicitly teach a social emotional lesson one time per week which includes the five ingredients of active learning (Child Observation Record Category of Social Emotional Development). The category will improve from a 3.01 in scoring period one, to a 3.5 in scoring period two. A data collection goal was set that 90% of staff will enter Child Observation data by the designated percentages weekly.
- The program partnered with Shepherd King Lutheran Church to distribute over 70 Thanksgiving food baskets to families.
- A total of 1004 breakfasts and 1023 lunches were served through National School Lunch and 1014 snacks were served through CACFP.
