1. Welcome and Roll Call - The meeting was called to order at 2:15 p.m.

2. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes - The previous meeting minutes were approved as read.

3. Old Business

- **Member Attendance** - We currently have four vacant positions: 6-12th grade parent, alumni, 6-12th grade teacher, and Deaf community representative. Please encourage others to apply.
- **Elect Chair/Vice Chair** - Mike Provancha has accepted the role of Site Council Chair for the remaining months of this school year.
- **Update on MSA Board Member Appointments** - We've submitted our recommendations to the Governor's office, but have not yet received a response. We still need to fill the Special Education Director position. Please encourage qualified applicants to apply.
- **Parent Directory** - The MSAD and MSAB directories are ready to be shared with organizations.
- **Parent Survey Results and Future Parent Surveys** - The parent survey results were included in Terry's recent Weekly Update newsletter. Please contact Terry if you have any questions.
- **Naming the New Security Corridor/Educational Complex** - This is on hold as the Board has not discussed it yet.

4. New Business

- **Food/Snacks at Holidays, Birthday Celebrations, Events, etc.** - A question was raised about whether we are following the 'USDA Smart Snacks in Schools' guidelines. Our Wellness Policy does not allow sweets, but it is hard to control this when items are brought in from home for special events. Allergies are also a concern. We will follow up on this item.
- **Foreign Language Interpreters at MSAD Sponsored Events** - A question was raised about how foreign language interpreters are determined for events. It was suggested that an RSVP be required. If a need is identified for a foreign language interpreter, the organization can request one.
- **Outreach Discussion** - More questions and conversions are happening about establishing outreach. This is at the conceptual level right now. We need to determine what this would look like, what services would be provided and how this would differ from Lance's position. A discussion was held and ideas were shared. - **Policy and Procedure Review** - This procedure was discussed. Feedback was provided.
 - **Procedure #5200 - Supporting Transgender and Gender-Expansive Students** - The purpose of this procedure is to establish expectations and guidelines for MSA to address the needs and concerns of transgender and gender-expansive students to ensure safe, supportive, and healthy school environments where every child can learn.
- **Superintendent's Report**
 - **Weekly Newsletter** - This has been sent out.
 - **Austria Trip** - The trip to Austria went well. Two students went with and participated in the youth leadership portion of the conference. They met leaders from the international disabled community, attended workshops, presented on a panel about Deaf leadership, did some sightseeing, went to Parliament and listened to a presentation on disability rights. It was a great trip.
 - **Strategic Plan/Accreditation** - The strategic plan is an ongoing cycle that will lead to a new strategic plan for the next five years as we continue making improvements.
 - **Lobby Day** - Students attended and participated in Lobby Day at the State Capitol. MSAD alumni were recognized. MSAD teacher, Michele Heise, received an Education Excellence Award. MSA Board member, Jessica Eggert, received a Community Advocacy Award. Ralph Fuechtmann, received a Lifetime Achievement Award for leadership within the Deaf community.

 - **Lance Hall** - Lobby Day went great. Terry will be attending the MASA conference and we will have a booth at that event. This weekend will be Deafopia. The Hilltopper Athletic Booster Club and the Alumni Association will be hosting booths at this event.

Our three high school teams competed and, out of 35 teams, one of our teams won it all and won the Best Builder Award. Another team won the Judges Award. Our middle school team got sixth out of 33 teams. This was our first year competing and they did great. It was a wonderful experience for all.
