Virtual Regular School Board Meeting
June 22, 2020**

Chair Edwards called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 13D.021 with regards to the COVID-19 pandemic and the Minnesota Governors peacetime emergency declaration, the meeting was held by conference call. High Student Achievement

The Board discussed recent events regarding the death of George Floyd, racism and diversity education.

Member Gordee moved the adoption of the following resolution:

Resolution to Reinforce the District's Commitment to Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Justice by the School Board

WHEREAS, Independent School District 883, Rockford Area Schools, is responsible for student well-being and climate in our schools, creating a safe and secure learning environment for our students, and encouraging diversity and inclusion of all regardless of race, gender, creed, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or any other protected class; and

WHEREAS, minority groups, have been historically marginalized, underrepresented, targeted, and discriminated against in our country; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge discrimination, prejudice, and racism exist in our community; and

WHEREAS, District Policy 514 states, "The administration will establish strategies for creating a positive school climate and will use evidence-based social-emotional learning to prevent and reduce discrimination and other improper conduct."

SO, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the School Board of Independent School District 883 decries and rebukes any and all forms of racism, bigotry, or intolerance to any member of the community in which they serve; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED any student, faculty, staff, administrator, or any citizen to which this governing board has authority, is free to contact district administration or the School Board without fear of reprisal; and

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED the School Board of Independent School District 883 directs the Superintendent to provide the Board with recommendations to address inequalities in our schools.

A candidate for this office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or more on assuming office, must have been a resident of the school district from which the candidate seeks election for thirty (30) days before the general election, and must have no other affidavit on file for any other office at the same primary or next ensuing general election.
