Scholarships - Phase 1	1 - 2022/23 School Year	\$500 to \$5,000 each (6 Academies, 1 potential general scholarship opportunity)	Moderate (3-4 hours set up structure, 2-4 hours as a board per application; 2 hour Award Night)
Transportation Program	2 - 2023/24 School Year	\$12,000/yr	Minimal (less than 2 hours annually)
Annual Student Respect Retreat (onsite, 9th graders)	2 - 2023/24 or 2024/25 School Year	\$9,000/yr (event)	Minimal - Moderate (depends on retreat attendance and interaction)
Academy Kits (seniors)	2 - 2023/24 or 2024/25 School Year	\$50 - \$200+ per kit/~\$5,000 - \$15,000 per year	Moderate - High (larger start up time investment, SPS to manage compilation)
Grants	2 - 2023/24 School Year	None, revenue generator for Foundation	High (can include SPS support)
