Hello,

Today, we met with Ethan's juvenile counselor, and he not only recommended but fully supports us in this pursuit. As I am sure you know, studies show the less time kids spend in active school, the more kids turn to other negative pursuits outside of school. There are other avenues that should be approached first, and we are working with outside sources to get Ethan the help he deserves.

We would like to appeal the decision of the expulsion for Ethan Kosoff. At this time, we are in the process of retaining legal counsel to help us navigate this process, and we would like to get this on the radar in the time frame allowed. We feel that there is potentially some new information about the first incident at the high school this year. The second incident with the backpack has seemingly been put on Ethan with a decision for expulsion where the other party (who in fact participated) involved was only suspended for one week with known behavioral issues of assault(s) in the past. We were also asked to provide 100% monetary restitution for the backpack and water bottle where the 50/50 split was on the initial document. There seems to be a disparity issue with that incident that we are also trying to navigate. We understand that typically an expulsion decision goes back to the history of a year, but we still feel that an expulsion was extreme in this case as typically these incidents are suspensions. We understand that the last incident to get here is also something that typically gets a day suspension. Ethan is in counseling and we are doing all we can to support his future and feel that Ethan being in school and sports are only beneficial to his future, and we would appreciate the opportunity to address the possibility that he be allowed to return to school.
