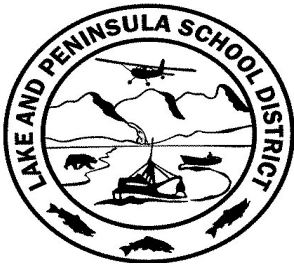

Re: Joint Recommendation for FY2019, FY2020, AND FY2021 Contract



From Superintendent Ty Mase's contract:

4. CONTRACT CONTINUATION: Upon completion of a satisfactory evaluation, the Board will move to extend the Superintendent's contract by one year, thereby making it a perpetual or "rolling" three-year contract. Continuation salary will be negotiated at the time of the evaluation based on a yearly 2% raise.
