RE: Proposal to Purchase Former Dena'ina School Buildings & Reconfigure Site Parcel

Dear Mayor Alsworth:

As you are aware, the Dena'ina School buildings in Pedro Bay have not been used to operate and maintain a school for nearly ten years. The Borough's Comprehensive Plan states: "In November 2010, Pedro Bay's student count dropped below ten students, and the school was closed. LPSD ended maintenance and completely suspended operations in Pedro Bay in 2012." The former school buildings are situated on a 7.5 acre parcel (known as Tract A, Big Hill Subdivision) leased through the State DCRA Municipal Land Trust. The 55-year lease was established on March 15, 2001 and terms and conditions of the lease require that the lessee (LPSD) must "operate and maintain a school" on the property. Considering this has not been the case for at least eight years now, there are legitimate questions as to the ongoing validity of the MLT lease.

In 2016, at the suggestion of DCRA MLT personnel, the Pedro Bay Village Council provided a resolution requesting the LPSD relinquish the lease. The LPSD was not amenable to this due to concerns about future Department of Education funding. In the following years, reuse and sublease options were presented, but the only follow-through on this has been to have MLT prepare sublease documents for PBVC's existing power plant facility located on a portion of Tract A. To date, PBVC has not executed the sublease as the Council no longer views LPSD's lease on Tract A as legitimate. Additionally, terms in the sublease include the statement: "If the sublessee uses the Parcel for other than electric utility generation purposes, the sublease will automatically terminate and all interests in the Parcel will revert to the sublessor..." This seems to be a double standard, holding the tribal Council to something that the LPSD has not been held to with regard to their lease with MLT; this "breach and default" language is not in the original lease.

The Pedro Bay Village Council would like to see the Borough and LPSD move off-center (as it were) regarding the former Dena'ina School in Pedro Bay. Given the current COVID-19 pandemic and additional resources at-hand, the Council would like to propose purchase of the former teacher housing building at a fair market price so that it can be put

to use as COVID-19 emergency temporary housing and also refurbished for long-term housing in the village. Additionally, the Council would like to initiate negotiations to purchase other buildings/assets on the former school site, and eventually see the LPSD relinquish the lease on Tract A so that the full extent of the 7.5 acre property will again be available for potential community uses. Your timely consideration of this proposal is greatly appreciated.

COVID-19: What You Need to Know INDOOR EVENTS

A social distance of 6 feet should be maintained when participants are not exercising or competing.

Accommodations should be made for High risk participants.

Those that have been sick should stay at home

Screen participants prior to each practice

Cleaning and disinfecting must be conducted

All shared equipment, (including balls) should be cleaned intermittently and prior to the next session.
(Intermittently - every 10 min)

Hand sanitizer should be plentiful and available to all participants.

Participants should always be allowed to wear face coverings, if desired

Cloth face coverings by participants should be encouraged when not engaging in vigorous activity. Such as sitting on the bench, in the locker room, on the sidelines, etc.

Each participant will be provided a Water Bottle. Water bottles must not be shared.

All individuals should refrain from handshakes, high fives, fist/elbow bumps, group celebrations, etc.

For InDoor Events:

Only in region travel (BBBSD, DCSD, SWRSD) with approved mitigation plans. These must be approved by the superintendent or their designee for each trip.

- No pre or post-match handshakes or fist bumps

Each team should bring their own warm-up balls/equipment. Host school could supply a cart for each team that has been sanitized.

Each team is responsible for its own towels, hand sanitizer and med kit

3-4 sanitized back up balls should be at the table

Identify separate points of Entry/Exit for participants & spectators that follow social distancing guidelines.

Hello Lake and Pen,

As you have probably heard, our plan is to open our doors and have students in our schools this Fall. The challenge will be to keep the doors open and stay in a “low risk”, or “green” zone. We are hopeful that we can return to some sort of “normal” and get our students rolling and making up for lost time.

I wanted to reach out and ask for your help and understanding so the district will be able to travel certain essential employees in order to support and maintain our schools. These employees include site principals, technology support, special education personnel, and maintenance workers. I can assure you that travel will only be scheduled when deemed essential and employees will abide by district protocols (masks, distancing, etc.).

In addition, we will make sure:

- Supervisors of Essential Workers will communicate with the Principal or Head- Teacher of the school prior to their arrival. The Principal or the Head-Teacher will be responsible for notification of the Village Covid Committee of the expected arrival of the Essential Worker.
- Upon arrival, the Essential Workers will present to the school authority proof of recent testing showing a negative test result.
- While in the community the Essential Worker will abide by Covid Protocols (masks, distancing, etc.)
- Just like students, Essential Workers will be required to health screen prior to entering the school building.
- Travel to or from “high risk” villages will be avoided at all costs.

While our plan is to follow local mandates whenever possible, we will be unable to operate our schools if essential LPSD employees are not allowed in or are required to quarantine upon entry to the village.
