Curriculum and School Improvement

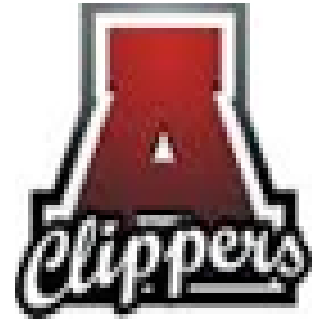
- Student of the Month was James Curl!!
