Facility Study

- While the Junior High remains a priority in reducing our footprint in a time of declining enrollment, our facility study has identified additional opportunities for restructure.
- Space is opening within buildings which has presented an opportunity to decommission the Idea/Odyssey building.
- Schools/programs like Idea and Odyssey are part of the essence of who we are as a District
- While we work to maintain these opportunities as a team, location changes are a financial consideration.



Facility Study

- Annual operational expenses for the Idea/Odyssey building amount to just over \$55,000.
 - Includes: utilities, pest control, plowing, security software, general maintenance, tech supplies
- The building would need approximately \$100,000 worth of planned capital maintenance over the next 5 years
- There is room for some staffing adjustments that would result from a location change.

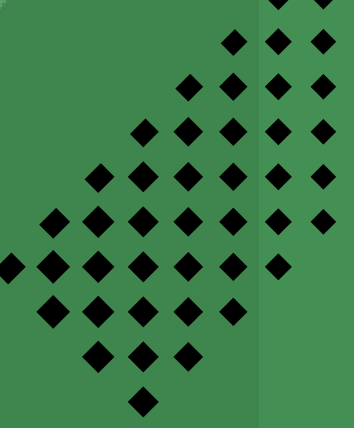

SUBJECT: Health Insurance Renewal for 2027

As the District prepares for the 2027 health insurance plan year, Administration is recommending renewal with Aspirus Health Plan. The recommended renewal reflects a thorough review of the District's claims experience, available alternatives through the bid process, projected costs, employee feedback, and the long-term sustainability of the District's health insurance program.

Renewal Recommendation

Administration is recommending renewal with Aspirus Health Plan for the 2027 plan year with an overall 19.1% increase in premiums. While this remains a significant increase, the final renewal represents a substantial improvement from the 32% increase initially proposed by Aspirus Health Plan.

Plan Design and Contribution Changes

In addition to the premium increase, the plan design and employee contribution structure will change for 2027. The primary changes include:

- Single deductible: increases from \$3,400 to \$4,000
- Family deductible: increases from \$6,800 to \$8,000
- Coinsurance: 10% coinsurance will apply after the deductible, subject to applicable plan limits
 - Coinsurance maximum: \$5,000 single / \$10,000 family
 - Maximum out-of-pocket: \$6,000 single / \$12,000 family, after applicable copays

Employer HSA Contribution

Recognizing that the plan design changes will increase the potential out-of-pocket costs for employees, the Administration carefully considered options to help offset this impact.

After consultation with our broker, a review of strategies and plan design among regional school districts, and feedback from staff, the District will provide an employer HSA contribution of \$1,000 for employees enrolled in single coverage and \$2,000 for employees enrolled in family coverage. The HSA contribution provides a direct benefit to employees and will help offset the

higher deductible and other eligible out-of-pocket healthcare expenses. Administration believes the HSA is a familiar and easy-to-understand benefit for employees and provides employees with flexibility in how they use the funds. This is an increase from the \$100 employer contribution in 2026.

This approach allows the District to provide meaningful financial support to employees while maintaining the \$0 employee premium contribution for the Signature (narrow) network plan for full-time employees, which staff have identified as an important benefit priority.

Employee Contributions for Less-than-Full-Time Employees

The District will also make an adjustment to the employee contribution structure for less-than-full-time employees.

For single coverage, the existing employee contribution will continue to be capped at 17.5% of the premium.

For family coverage under the Signature (narrow) plan, the employee contribution will be capped at 30% of the premium for employees working less than 1.0 FTE. This provides a defined maximum employee contribution while recognizing the District's ongoing commitment to providing access to the same health insurance options for part-time employees.

Administration believes this adjustment provides a reasonable balance between the District's cost responsibility and the employee contribution for less than 1.0 FTE employees.

Recommendation:

Administration recommends that the Board approve renewal with Aspirus Health Plan for the 2027 plan year, including:

1. An overall 19.1% premium increase that includes the above noted changes to deductibles, coinsurance, and maximum out-of-pocket amounts;
2. An employer HSA contribution of \$1,000 for single coverage and \$2,000 for family coverage;
3. A 30% employee premium contribution cap for family coverage under the Signature plan for employees working less than 1.0 FTE, while maintaining the existing 17.5% cap for single coverage. No changes to the employee contributions for Freedom plan and maintaining 0% premium for 1.0 FTE for the Signature network;
4. Continued evaluation of alternative health insurance strategies, including the potential transition to a self-funded model in the future.

Overview

Overall teacher hiring quantity is nearly identical to last year, and the overall experience level of newly hired teachers remains consistent. This year's hiring data also highlights three important trends: an increase in early-career educators, the continued importance of special education recruitment, and the value of developing candidates who already have a connection to D.C. Everest through one of our pipelines.

Certified Staff/Teacher Hiring

For 2026–2027, the District has hired 28 teachers (one teaching vacancy remains as of September 8th). In addition, the District hired one occupational therapist, one school social worker, one psychologist, and two nurses.

Where Our New Teachers Are Coming From

Of this year's teacher hires:

- 17 previously taught in other districts: 7 from local districts, 9 from other Wisconsin districts, and 1 from out of state.
- 6 were D.C. Everest student teachers or interns during 2025–2026.
- 2 student-taught in other districts during 2025–2026.
- 1 previously worked as a D.C. Everest substitute.
- 1 previously worked as a D.C. Everest paraprofessional.
- 1 previously held a limited-term contract with D.C. Everest.

Of particular interest, 11 of the 28 teachers hired (39%) had a prior connection to D.C. Everest through student teaching/internships or non-certified employment. This includes past D.C. Everest graduates that chose to come home to either start or continue their teaching career. Continuing to develop strong connections with and provide support to student-teachers, interns, guest teachers, paraprofessionals, and other employees provides a pipeline of candidates who already understand our schools, students, and culture.

Certified Staff/Teacher Candidate Pool

The District had 565 certified applicants during the 2026–2027 hiring season, averaging 12.5 candidates per posting which is a small increase from previous years (10 candidates/position in 2024-2025). However, the size of candidate pools varies by position with Elementary postings having the largest average number of applicants (29) and specialized positions such as Spanish (5) and Special Education (8) having the fewest. This representation is consistent with past candidate pools. One key in attracting larger pools remains the ability to post open positions early in the hiring season (late Winter) as our candidate pools tend to experience sharp declines in the summer months.

Support Staff Hiring

Between July 1 and September 4, the District hired 29 support staff employees, including 11 special education assistants. For comparison, during



approximately the same period last year, the District hired 35 support staff employees, including 23 special education assistants.

As of early September, 17 support staff vacancies remain in departments across the District. 11 of 17 are educational assistant positions, including six special education assistant vacancies.

Key Takeaways

- **Hiring volume remains stable.** The District hired 28 teachers for 2026–27, compared with 27 total teacher hires, including two counselors, in 2025–2026.
- **Our new teacher workforce is increasingly early-career.** More than 7 in 10 of this year's teacher hires have fewer than five years of experience, making onboarding, mentoring, support, and retention increasingly important.
- **Special education remains a significant staffing need.** 9 of the District's 28 teacher hires are in special education, and special education assistants represent the largest single category of remaining support staff vacancies.
- **Our pipelines have a strong impact on hiring.** Nearly 40% of this year's teacher hires had a prior D.C. Everest connection.
- **Applicant numbers alone do not tell the full story.** While the District attracted 565 certified candidates, candidate availability varies considerably by position.

Looking Ahead

Talent & Culture will continue to focus on recruitment for hard-to-fill positions, development of internal talent pipelines, strong onboarding and mentoring for early-career educators, and retention of high-quality employees.

These efforts will help ensure that D.C. Everest remains positioned to attract, develop, and retain the staff necessary to create high-quality educational experiences for all learners.

SUBJECT: Summer 2026 Professional Development

Our staff focused on their own professional development over the summer to ensure continued growth in their practice. We had 143 staff members log 2,157 hours of PD over the course of the summer. In addition to content-specific PD, CPI, and CPR, our staff also focused on literacy, tech integration, special education, suicide prevention, 7 Mindsets, high ropes certification, and certification in the cooperating teacher role to support the next generation of teachers.

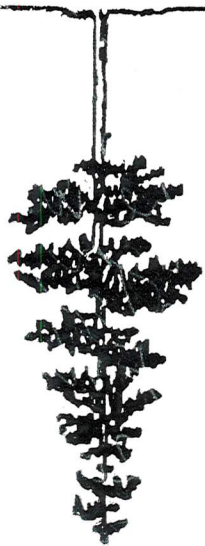
An additional focus over the summer was around ensuring safe and predictable learning spaces for our students. With the support of grant dollars, we have continued an implementation rollout of Responsive Classroom. Just over 50 of our staff attended Responsive Classroom training over the summer, in addition to a number of staff trained last summer. We are consistently hearing about the impact it is having on our classrooms with staff who have received specific strategies that help establish high-functioning classroom environments.

Our professional development over the course of the 26-27 school year will continue to focus on two high-impact strategic actions we believe will move the needle for students: enhancing our Professional Learning Communities (PLC's) to impact both academic and behavioral growth, and goal-aligned professional development.

Ultimately, our leaders and staff will continue learning together to strengthen teaching, learning, and leadership here at D.C. Everest. A huge thank you goes to our staff as they increase skills and impact learning.
