







- **Manually managing updates for approximately 20% of current fleet.**
 - 100 iPads per building have less than 4 GB left of storage.
 - Building Level Technical Aides (BLTAs) are on a rotating schedule.

- Familiarity with and utilization of a keyboard is a requirement for both our District and State standards.


