**Differences between the OCA / OCTECHS Calendar**  
**& the regular ECISD Calendar:**

- First day of school is Wednesday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, for all ECISD schools
- Oct 12<sup>th</sup> will be a regular school day for OCA / OCTECHS
- The Oct 12<sup>th</sup> Columbus Holiday for the regular ECISD calendar is moved to Oct 16<sup>th</sup> for OCA and OCTECHS
- PSAT & SAT Day is Oct 14<sup>th</sup>. Only select 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students taking these tests will be at school. All other students will be home taking classes virtually.
- November 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> COVID-19 Make-Up Days will only be used if we have to shut down school a day or two before those dates occur due to COVID-19 illnesses on campus. They will be a school holiday if we do not need to use them.
- OC Fall Graduation is on Dec 12<sup>th</sup>
- NEW – December 17<sup>th</sup> will be an Early Release Day at 12:00 pm for OCA & OCTECHS
- NEW – February 12<sup>th</sup> will be an Early Release Day at 12:00 pm for OCA & OCTECHS
- Feb 15<sup>th</sup> will be a regular school day for OCA / OCTECHS
- The Feb 15<sup>th</sup> Bad Weather / COVID-19 Make-Up Day for the regular ECISD calendar is moved to Feb 19<sup>th</sup> for OCA and OCTECHS
- NEW – March 5<sup>th</sup> will be an Early Release Day at 12:00 pm for OCA & OCTECHS
- OC Spring Graduations is on May 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>
  - their type of associate degree determines what day they graduate with OC

  - with OCA at 6:00 pm and OCTECHS at 8:00 pm / Both at the OC Sports Center
- 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, & 11<sup>th</sup> Grade students will continue school until May 27<sup>th</sup>, like ECISD
- Last day of school is Thursday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, for all ECISD schools
- June and July shaded in purple and green stripes are for elementary summer enrichment programs (voluntary)

- College 8 week sessions (begin & end dates) are noted by brackets on the calendar
- **These changes for the OCA and OCTECHS calendar are necessary so our students do not miss their college classes Monday – Thursday each week.**
