# COVID -19 Procedures

With the safety and well being of our athletes, families and fans paramount, we are diligently following the Illinois Department of Health guidelines and the Illinois High School Associations recommendations for Covid 19.

Coaches are monitoring and evaluating team members before the start of practices/open gyms by -

- Verifying that athletes have checked in on powerschool and have received the green check mark for their self-certification
- Scanning for temperatures
- Keeping Daily Attendance sheets for contact tracing

The Athletic Department is working with the Dean's and Nurse's Offices to identify athletes who are under quarantine by cross matching the athletes to the Self-Certification spreadsheet supplied by the Dean's Office.

Once an athlete is identified -

The Athletic Trainer -

- Works with the Nurse's Offices to evaluate the athlete's condition,
- And follows up with the coaches in contact tracing.

The athlete's name and last date of quarantine are listed on a roster spreadsheet of each team for the Head Coaches as a reminder of the athlete's return date.

# Winter Sports

On November 18, 2020 all winter sports were paused by the State of Illinois and the Illinois High School Association. Governor Pritzker moved Region 2, our region, to Tier 1 in Phase 4 on January 16, 2021. In Tier 1, we are allowed the following sports participation -

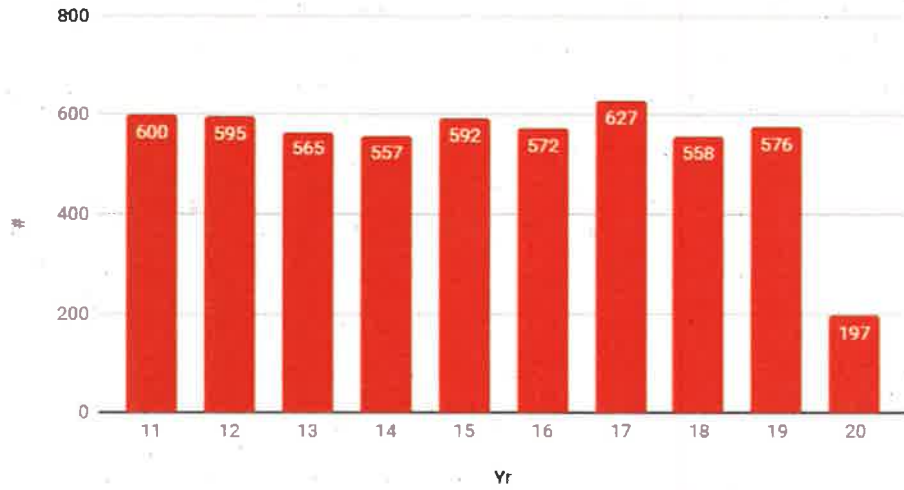
All teams must maintain social distancing, wear masks and sanitize frequently. All athletes are advised to bring their own water bottles.

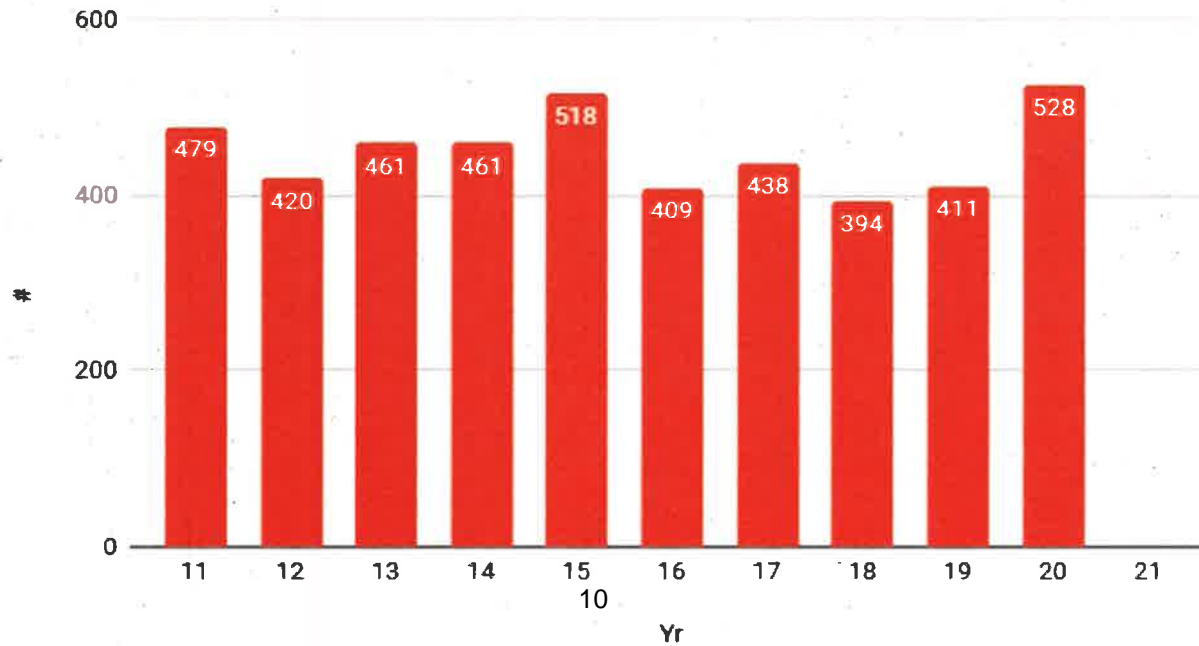
### Fall Athletes



### Winter Athletes



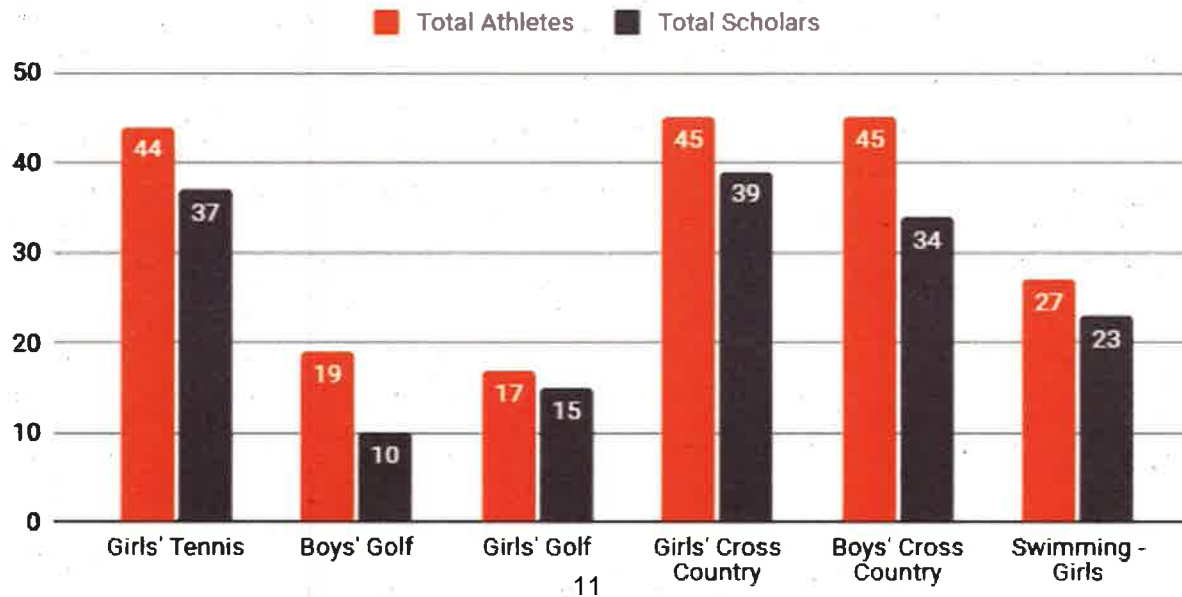

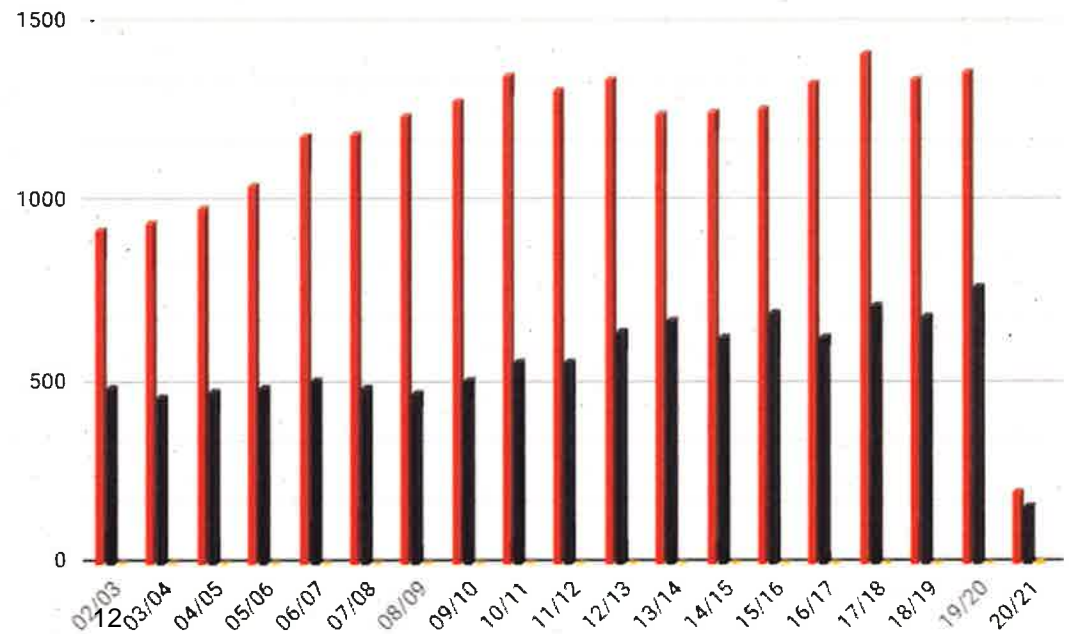
Total Athletes and Total Scholars

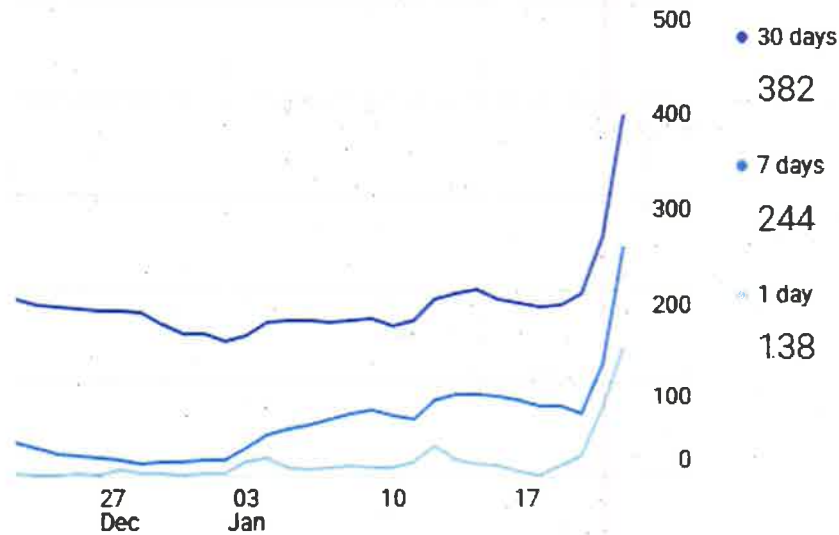

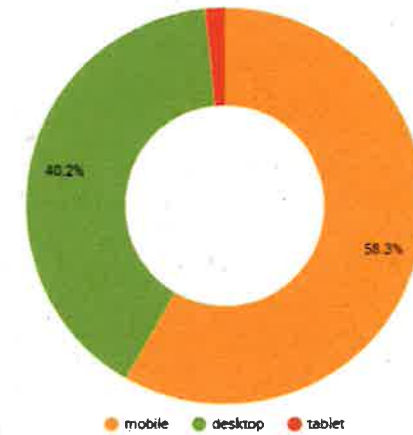
