Motion unanimously carried.

Luan Thomas-Brunkhorst presented the board with improvements needed to the outdoor skating rink which is on property owned by the school and leased to the City of Long Prairie. She gave a list of necessary improvements including leveling the ground for the rink and a few other improvements needed as well. A motion was made by Hollenkamp and seconded by Zastrow to postpone any decisions with Soldiers Field until the next meeting so information could be gathered and make sure that no school related activities will be happening there.

Business Manager, Sherri Evenson, shared that the school received the grant for AED's and will be upgrading equipment and providing training for staff.

Mr. Ludvigson reported on behalf of the Health Service Office stating that we had reached the threshold of 10% of students being out.

Tammy Cebulla and Barton Rud commented on Snow Days Royalty and activities. It was also discussed that the attendance after the presence of ICE in Long Prairie has started to quiet down and return back to normal. A huge "Thank you" to the staff for taking care of the students and families throughout the chaos. Pillars of Excellence were also recognized, Karen Holt, Mary Miklavcich, Jennefer Ramos and Ashley Pesta.

Mrs. Cebulla also recognized the One Act Play who took 1st place in the competition and were now moving onto subsections. She wanted to especially congratulate Cassie Zimmer, director of the play as she also wrote the entire play script especially for this set of actors.

Superintendent Ludvigson gave the enrollment report. He also stated that negotiations were underway and moving forward.

Board Highlight – The Board attended the MSBA Conference. Linda Gohman was recognized for being selected “All-State School Board. Thomas Zastrow and Lori Hollenkamp were recognized for completing Phase 1-4 in their first year of service. There were a lot of good sessions attended with Levin attending the session on Paid Leave, the newest state program.

The Purchase agreement for the sale of the parcel of land was presented to the board. A motion by Zastrow and seconded by Zahnow to accept this agreement and continue with the necessary paperwork for the sale of the land. Motion unanimously carried.

Policy 521

521 STUDENT DISABILITY NONDISCRIMINATION

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to protect students with disabilities from discrimination on the basis of disability and to identify and evaluate learners who, within the intent of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), need services, accommodations, or programs in order that such learners may receive a free appropriate public education.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Students with disabilities who meet the criteria of Paragraph C. below are protected from discrimination on the basis of a disability.
- B. The responsibility of the school district is to identify and evaluate learners who, within the intent of Section 504, need services, accommodations, or programs in order that such learners may receive a free appropriate public education.
- C. For this policy, a learner who is protected under Section 504 is one who:
 - 1. has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more of such person's major life activities; or
 - 2. has a record of such an impairment;
 - 3. is regarded as having such an impairment; or
 - 4. has an impairment that is episodic or in remission and would materially limit a major life activity when active.

[NOTE: The 2024 Minnesota legislature revised the definition of 'disability' in Minnesota Statutes, section 363A.03, subdivision 12]

- D. Learners may be protected from disability discrimination and be eligible for services, accommodations, or programs under the provisions of Section 504 even though they are not eligible for special education pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

III. COORDINATOR

This person is the school district's Americans with Disabilities Act/Section 504 coordinator. Persons who wish to make a complaint regarding a disability discrimination matter may use the accompanying Student Disability Discrimination Grievance Report Form. The form should be given to the ADA/Section 504 coordinator.

- We are currently in Winter programming mode, and I am happy to report that our participation has been outstanding. We have served over 260 kids within our programs, which include everything from Tie-Blanket Making to youth sports. Thanks to all of our excellent volunteers and instructors.
- VPK- At the bottom of this page I have written a summary of our proposal that was sent to the Minnesota Department of Education for our proposed enrollment in the Minnesota Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten program. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
- We are preparing for the Preschool Open House on March 10, 2026. This event is an opportunity for parents and preschoolers to tour the Early Childhood facilities and meet our teachers. That night, parents can register their children for next year's preschool classes. The Open House runs from 4:00-6:30 pm.
- I am currently working on the 2026 Summer Brochure, which will be released at the beginning of April. If you know of anyone who has a unique summertime activity that they would like to share with our Long Prairie and Grey Eagle schools and community, please let me know as we strive to include as many summertime activities as possible in our Summer Community Education Editions. Our goal is to get as many people as possible involved with all of our wonderful summertime activities that take place in our two communities.

Federal Programs and Achievement and Integration

- I am currently working on writing the grant proposal for the three-year plan for the Achievement and Integration Grant. If accepted, this grant will have an award amount of approximately \$700,000 over its three-year duration. The state-funded grant, administered by the Minnesota Department of Education, is designed to support districts in promoting racial and economic integration, improving student academic achievement, expanding equitable access to educational opportunities, and reducing persistent academic disparities among student groups. At LPGE, A&I funding supports several key initiatives, including salaries for ESL paraprofessionals, targeted professional development for staff, and student success activities such as the Academic and
- Career Fair. These efforts align with the grant's overarching goal of ensuring that all students have access to inclusive, high-quality learning experiences that prepare them for college, career, and community success.
- The 3rd Annual LPGE Career and College Fair will be held on Friday, March 2, 2025. This event is funded through our Achievement and Integration Grant and will feature more than 35 career pathways, with presentations from professionals currently working in each field. The college portion of the fair will include representatives from over 10 colleges and universities, who will



provide information on admissions processes, academic programs, and financial aid opportunities. We extend our sincere thanks to Lu at the Long Prairie Chamber for co-sponsoring this valuable opportunity for our students. The LPGE Career Fair planning team includes Luan Thomas-Brunkhorst, Jonathan Young, Audrey Morrill, Stacey Custer, Barton Rud, and me.

- I am currently making amendments to the Title Grants that we receive. The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) grant requires us to update our school year information through the Minnesota Department of Education, which must be completed by **April 30, 2026 at 3:00 p.m.** The information that is entered in this timeline will represent the final opportunity to revise the approved SFY26 ESEA Consolidated Application in the Minnesota Education Grants System (MEGS). During this Spring Amendment window, local educational agencies may make allowable adjustments to their accepted work plans—such as updating budgets, finance/object codes, and programmatic activities—so that expenditures and implementation accurately reflect current needs and final federal allocations. After the deadline, no further amendments can be submitted, and reimbursement requests are limited to approved codes and budgets, making timely submission essential for compliance, fiscal accuracy, and alignment of Title I–IV programming with district priorities and federal requirements.

Long Prairie–Grey Eagle Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) Program Proposal

Program Overview

Long Prairie–Grey Eagle (LPGE) Schools is seeking funding to continue and expand its Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) program, a free, high-quality early learning opportunity for eligible four-year-old children in our district. VPK is designed to prepare students for a successful transition into kindergarten by strengthening early literacy, language, mathematics, social-emotional, and executive-function skills through developmentally appropriate, play-based instruction aligned to Minnesota’s Early Learning Standards.

At LPGE, VPK is embedded within the elementary school environment, allowing children to become familiar with school routines, expectations, and settings prior to kindergarten entry. Classrooms are led by licensed early childhood teachers and supported by paraprofessionals to ensure small-group instruction and individualized support. The program uses research-based curriculum and ongoing formative assessment to guide instruction and monitor student growth.

Need for the Program

Early learning access remains critical in our rural community, where many children enter kindergarten with limited prior preschool experience and varying levels of readiness. Multilingual learners, students from economically disadvantaged households, and children with developmental or academic risk factors particularly benefit from structured early learning opportunities. LPGE’s VPK program directly supports school readiness, helps close opportunity gaps, and promotes equitable access to high-quality early education within the public school system.

Proposed Program Design

LPGE is seeking funding to provide flexible participation options to better meet the needs of families while maintaining high-quality instructional time. The proposed VPK model will offer:

- **Four full days per week** (school-day schedule aligned to the elementary calendar), **or**
- **Three half-days per week**, with each session lasting **three hours**

Both options will deliver standards-aligned instruction, play-based learning experiences, and targeted skill development to prepare students for kindergarten success.



Target Population and Enrollment

Enrollment priority will be given to children who are four years old by September 1 and who may benefit most from early learning opportunities, including:

- Multilingual learners
- Children from low-income households
- Students identified through Early Childhood Screening with developmental or learning risk factors
- Children with limited prior early childhood education experience

LPGE coordinates VPK enrollment and services with Early Childhood Screening, Early Childhood Special Education, and kindergarten programming to ensure smooth transitions and aligned instructional practices.

Expected Outcomes

The LPGE VPK program is expected to:

- Increase kindergarten readiness across developmental domains
- Improve early literacy and language development
- Strengthen social-emotional and executive-function skills
- Reduce readiness and achievement gaps among student groups
- Support successful transitions into kindergarten

Conclusion

LPGE's Voluntary Prekindergarten program is a critical component of the district's early learning continuum. By providing accessible, high-quality preschool within the public school setting and offering flexible scheduling options for families, LPGE ensures that all children enter kindergarten ready to learn and succeed. Funding for this proposal will allow LPGE to sustain and expand equitable early learning access for our youngest learners and strengthen long-term academic outcomes across the district.

LPGE Technology Board Report February 23rd, 2026

Update for February:

Skyward: We are still moving along. Our next deadline is March 1st. Speaking with our Skyward representative, she has praised our team for being so proactive. The team has also been attending weekly sessions hosted by Skyward.

I've filed Erate for this year. We were looking at updating our network switch infrastructure and wireless access points. We had 6-7 vendors bid on each project. The total of the project will be around \$180,000. With Erate funds, we will end up paying \$32,000. This is a well needed project as it's been over 10 years since we updated our network infrastructure. Because the bids came in under budget we will have money left to do more upgrades over the next 4 years.

Vape detectors have been ordered for the Secondary. We hope to get those installed soon in each bathroom. Mr. Rud can give you more information on that if you have questions.

We are still evaluating security software for the district. The cost has been higher than expected. We have the money this year in the grant, but going forward I want to make sure it's in the budget to continue. I'm working with Mr. Ludvigson and Ms. Evenson on the budget for this.

Phase one of the auditorium lighting project has been completed. We have upgraded the computer controller system for all the lights. They have installed a new light board and controls in the sound booth. We have plans to start replacing all the lights now and upgrade them to LED. We are working on the budget for this as it's one of the most expensive parts of the project.

We have had our first onboarding meeting with Parchment. The District Office is starting a new document management system. Because of the state requirements for document retention, we have not had a good place to store permanent documents. This will make record retention simpler and more efficient.

Since the last board meeting, I have spent time with fellow staff members on our security team training at Sourcewell on our reunification plans, specifically for special ed and table top exercises for our district-wide plan. I will be involved in another training on February 25th with Vanessa Wielenberg and Nicole Cuchna where we will have an opportunity to learn “Train the Trainer” information. I anticipate this will give further information to enhance the presentation I gave to our staff and entities such as Aksamit Transportation, Law Enforcement, etc. on our PD Day in January. By having Vanessa and Nicole train with me, we will be able to continue to serve our staff and students going forward.

Another item of priority in our office is putting together ACA information on all of our payroll staff. When I asked Cindy to give me a synopsis of what she is working on, here was her response:

Google definition - ACA stands for the [Affordable Care Act](#) (often called "Obamacare"), a comprehensive 2010 U.S. health care reform law. It aims to make affordable health insurance available to more people, expand Medicaid, and support innovative medical care delivery methods.

I have to enter data with what we offer employees for insurance and what the rates are to make sure we offer affordable rates to our employees. We have to create the 1095 reports that are given to the state to show who has coverage, who waived coverage and any cobra coverage we carry.

Working with benefits is definitely an area where accuracy and timeliness are top priority!

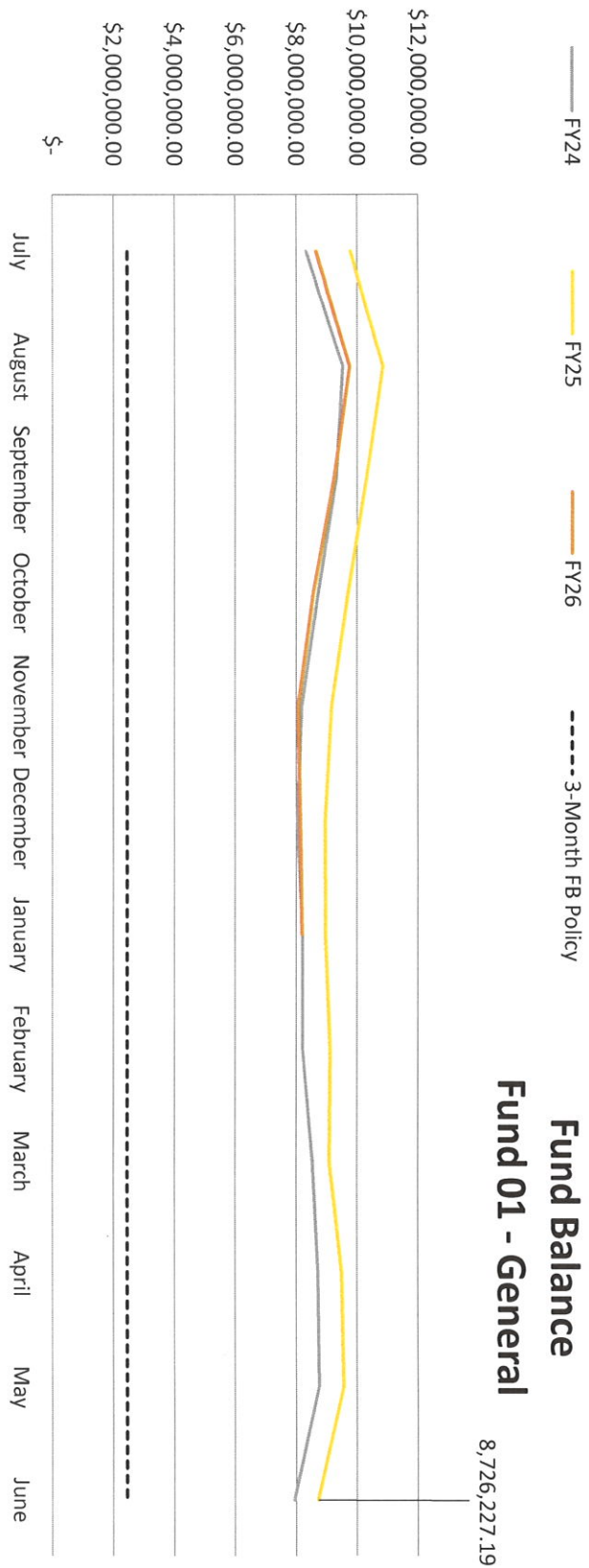

Overview

This report provides a summary of student health services, trends, and activities for the reporting period. Health services continue to play a critical role in student safety, attendance, academic readiness, and regulatory compliance across both buildings.

Health Office Activity

Approximate number of student visits September 2nd, 2025 - February 18th, 2026: 7,760. This averages approximately 75 student visits per school day.



Top common reasons for visits:

- Illness/symptoms-
 - Congestion- 159
 - Cramps- 181
 - Headache- 647
 - Stomach ache- 603

- Head Injury- 638
- Chronic condition support-
 - Asthma- 206
 - Diabetes- 630

Notable trends or changes observed:

In recent months, we have seen a large uptick in illness. On January 11th, 2026, a report was submitted to the state regarding this influx at our Elementary location, as 10% of students were absent due to illness. We had a total of 7 students with confirmed influenza and 1 student with confirmed RSV. We are currently seeing this continue at the Elementary level, but at a lower percentage. Recently, we have had reports of confirmed COVID-19, Strep Throat, and, a few weeks ago, a suspected Varicella (Chickenpox) case.

Illness & Communicable Disease Monitoring

Common illnesses observed this month:

Influenza A, COVID-19, Strep Throat, and Varicella (Chickenpox).

Confirmed or monitored communicable diseases (per MDH guidance):

- **Varicella (Chickenpox)**

Exclusion guidance and return-to-school protocols were followed as required.

On January 28, 2026, a notification letter regarding a suspected Varicella case was distributed to all Kindergarten families and staff via ParentSquare. A total of 132 individuals were notified. The letter was provided in English, Spanish, and Haitian Creole to ensure accessibility for all families. In addition, a printed copy of the letter was sent home with students in the classroom where the suspected exposure occurred.

Chronic Health Conditions & Care Management

Students with health care plans (e.g., asthma, diabetes, seizures, allergies):

Emergency Action Plans / Individual Health Plans:

- Asthma- 47
- Food Allergies- 46
- Insect Stings- 14
- Epilepsy/Seizure Disorder- 5
- Diabetes- 2

Medications administered per provider orders:

- All Medication types- 1,677

Staff training provided:

Three LPGE staff members and two St. Mary's staff members successfully completed the Medication Administration for School Personnel training through Workforce Development Solutions. Participants completed a four-hour virtual course and fulfilled the Minnesota State Community and Technical College Skills Checklist under the supervision of the Licensed School Nurse, in accordance with state requirements.

Congratulations to Christy Kuhl, Audrey Morrill, Amy Langford, Jessica Elmer, and Linda Dinkel on earning their certificates of completion. They are now authorized to administer medications within the school setting in compliance with established guidelines.

Mental Health & Social-Emotional Observations

General trends observed (non-identifying):

On a weekly basis, we encounter students who present with physical symptoms that are ultimately related to underlying mental health concerns. Many students may not recognize or may be reluctant to acknowledge that anxiety or emotional stress is contributing to their physical discomfort.

Through careful assessment, targeted questioning, and elimination, we identify potential mental health factors and collaborate with school social workers and counselors when appropriate. While some students may initially decline formal support services, health office staff strive to meet students where they are by providing a supportive, nonjudgmental environment and a listening ear.

Collaboration with counseling/support staff as needed:

From September 2nd, 2025, to February 18th, 2026, 49 students were referred for counseling/social work services after presenting to the health office with physical symptoms that were determined to be mental health-related.

Safety & Injury Prevention

Common injury types or safety concerns:

Head injuries remain our primary injury concern. To date, we have documented 686 head injury office visits during this school year. This represents approximately 8.8% of all office visits this school year.

Each head injury is treated with the utmost caution and care. Students are evaluated using established school-based concussion screening protocols. In most cases, this involves approximately four separate office assessments throughout the school day to ensure the student remains free of concussion-related symptoms prior to dismissal.

If a student exhibits ongoing or worsening symptoms, families are promptly contacted and advised to seek medical evaluation for further assessment.

The majority of these injuries occur during playground activities or physical education classes.

Follow-up actions or prevention efforts:

Recently, we contacted custodial services to address concerns regarding icy conditions near the main playground entrance. Custodial staff assessed the area and applied salt to mitigate the hazard. This proactive response helped reduce the risk of injuries associated with the significant ice accumulation along the entrance pathway and leading into the playground area.

Screenings & Preventive Care

Vision Screenings (573 Total)

- Passed: 436
- Rechecked: 84
- Referrals: 48
- Unable to participate: 5

Hearing Screenings (588 Total)

- Passed: 472
- Rechecked: 102
- Referrals: 8
- Unable to participate: 6

Vision and hearing screenings are conducted throughout the school year. Screenings are performed upon request when concerns arise, as well as for students referred through the BLAST team or those undergoing evaluation for IEP consideration.

Any student who does not meet established screening criteria receives a rescreening to confirm results. If the student does not pass the rescreening, a formal referral letter is sent to the family recommending further evaluation by an appropriate healthcare provider.

Immunization compliance monitored:

At this time, all students are in compliance with Minnesota school immunization requirements. Compliance is defined as having received the required immunizations, or having a properly completed medical exemption signed by a licensed healthcare provider, or a notarized conscientious exemption on file.

One student is currently within the allowable waiting period for a scheduled immunization. A notification letter outlining the compliance deadline has been sent to the family.

Health Lessons

On February 19, 2026, the dental health unit was delivered to all first-grade classrooms as part of our ongoing student wellness initiatives. Students received instruction on proper brushing and flossing techniques and learned strategies to prevent cavities and tooth decay.

Through Delta Dental's *Smiles@School* program, each student received a toothbrush, toothpaste, and additional donated oral health materials to support healthy habits at home. This initiative reinforces preventive health education and promotes lifelong oral health practices.

Cardiac Emergency Response Planning Update

Work continues on developing a comprehensive Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP) for the district. This ongoing initiative focuses on strengthening preparedness and ensuring an effective response to cardiac emergencies in our schools.

As you know, the district was awarded the state CERP Assistance Grant in the amount of **\$23,168.15**. To align with the awarded amount, we reduced projected expenditures by approximately \$2,500. We recently met with Leah Bancroft from the Minnesota Department of Education, who is overseeing the grant, and submitted an updated budget document on February 20, 2026.

Grant funds will support key components of implementation, including:

- CPR and First Aid training supplies
- Purchase of additional AED units
- Weather-resistant outdoor AED cabinets
- Certification costs
- Employee training stipends

In addition, we have partnered with Project ADAM to guide the planning process. RedCaps have been entered with detailed information on our designated Emergency Response Teams ("Red Teams") and team members across the district.

The next phase involves using the Project ADAM sample CERP framework to develop a district-specific plan, with the goal of implementation by the start of the next school year. We will also work with Project ADAM to provide hands-only CPR training to staff district-wide, while Red Team members will continue to maintain full CPR/AED and First Aid certification.

This initiative reflects the district's proactive commitment to student and staff safety, emergency preparedness, and compliance with state guidance.

Wellness Committee Update

The LPGE Wellness Committee continues to meet quarterly. Meeting notes are distributed to all staff via email and are also posted on the LPGE website to ensure transparency and accessibility.

In recognition of February as Heart Health Month, the committee is promoting heart-healthy wellness initiatives district-wide. On the first Friday of the month, staff participated in “Wear Red Day” to raise awareness of heart health. The committee is also developing a digital heart-healthy cookbook and is inviting staff to submit recipes to support healthy lifestyle habits.

The Licensed School Nurse recently met with Jerrod Tarman from HealthSource Solutions for the Quarter 1 one-to-one meeting. Discussion included promotion of Quarter 1 wellness challenges and the requirement to submit the district’s annual wellness plan and goals calendar by March 1, 2026, in order to remain eligible for future grant funding.

The Wellness Committee remains committed to fostering a culture of health and well-being among staff and supporting district-wide wellness initiatives.

Health Services Facilities Update

As always, I would like to thank the Board for its continued support of health services within our district.

I remain interested in engaging the Board in ongoing discussion regarding needed updates to our health services spaces. Previously, our LPN and I presented to the Board, outlining concerns about our current facilities. Specifically, the Elementary health office restroom does not meet ADA compliance standards, and the Secondary health office was designed for a much smaller and older student population and is no longer adequate for current needs.

With increasing student enrollment, rising office visit numbers, and the growing complexity of student health conditions, our current spaces are becoming increasingly challenging to utilize effectively and safely.

I respectfully invite Board members to tour our health services spaces and meet with me personally to better understand our current limitations and future needs. I would appreciate consideration of health services facility improvements in any upcoming discussions on construction or renovation planning.

Thank you again for your continued partnership and support of student health and safety. I welcome any questions or requests for additional data.

 - a. During the morning, the staff focused on vocabulary. Discussions were held regarding effective teaching strategies for vocabulary followed by high impact tier 2 word list development. Staff also created common definitions that will be put into an alignment document.
 - b. During the afternoon, staff broke into groups to work on curriculum review, relicensure, WIZER trainings, MCA trainings, teamwork, curriculum work, standards work and more.

 - a. This day is still in planning stages but will pull together the standards work, vertical teaming and vocabulary development that we have been working on this year. The afternoon will be dedicated to working on grades.

- a. One of the highlights were the four keynote speakers: Tom Murray, Dr. Gholdy Muhammad, LaVonna Roth and Phil Januszewski. All were inspiring, full of energy and provided applicable information and skills to make me a better leader.
 - b. The breakout sessions were fantastic. I learned about MnMTSS, making an impact, creating a supportive culture, and supporting diverse learners.
 - c. One of the biggest benefits of attending was the networking and learning from other school leaders.

Secondary School

1. Knowledge Bowl
- a. Mrs. Peterson:

2. FACS - CTE

a. Ms. Hanson

- i. The Career and Technical Instructors have been busy this fall and winter with articulation agreements, which are formal agreement

between high schools and colleges that allows students to earn college credit for approved high school courses. These agreements help ensure coursework aligns with college standards, making the transition to postsecondary education smoother and more affordable for students. Each articulated credit saves the student about \$200. For example, a food student who obtains a B and has the food handler certification, industry certification, can receive 4 credits at Normdale Community College in Business or Hospitality Management - saving a student \$800 if they choose to attend that school. The same course at Hennepin Tech is worth 2 credits and at South Central College is worth 2 of 4 credits for Culinary Fundamentals. Articulation agreements and industry certifications are one way LPGE is aiding workforce development in the needed trades in our area.

3. Special Olympics- Mrs. Waldvogel

- a. "The LPGE Secondary Unified Special Olympics team went on a team bonding field trip to the 46th annual Winter Carnival that was held at Camp Confidence Learning Center in Brainerd, MN. There were over 700 Special Olympics athletes, unified partners, workers, and volunteers who made the day full of fun and new experiences. We had 16 LPGE students attend the field trip, and they all made memories to last a lifetime! Students were hesitant to try dog sledding, snowmobiling, side by side rides, and snow tubing; everyone had a blast and can't wait for next year!"

Superintendent's Report 02/17/2026

Budget

Compensatory aid for the current school year is projected at **\$1,791,480**, which matches the figures used in our current budget model. Preliminary projections for the 2026–27 school year show a potential **\$700,000 reduction** in compensatory aid. This projected decrease is largely tied to changes in how eligibility is calculated. Specifically, the shift away from paper applications for free and reduced lunch toward direct certification has impacted the count. Direct certification includes programs such as: SNAP, MFIP, FDPIR, Foster Care, Medical Assistance. These numbers are preliminary and not finalized. We will continue monitoring the formula and provide updates as more information becomes available.

Solar for Schools grant has entered another funding cycle. This round may allow awards of up to 100% of project costs. I have retained documentation and planning work from the previous two cycles and am again working with iDeal on the application. Prior analysis showed strong potential for placing a solar array over the geothermal pump system to work in conjunction with our current energy infrastructure. I will keep the board informed as the application progresses.

Enrollment: February is historically one of our lowest enrollment months. As of the end of February, enrollment stands at 984 students, compared to a high of 1,000 students at the end of September. The largest changes have occurred at the secondary level, most notably in grades 9 and 12. Historically, our final enrollment number tends to fall between the high and low points of the year. At this time, I anticipate ending the year with enrollment slightly higher than last year.

Surplus Auction: We are planning a surplus auction for items the district is not currently using but that still have value. I am working with custodial staff, administrators, and Career and Technical Education teachers to identify potential items. Lists of proposed items will be brought to the February and March board meetings for approval, as items must be board-approved before being sold. We are targeting June or July for the auction.

I have spoken with Mr. Gjerstad, and the FFA program has expressed interest in assisting with organizing the auction. In return, a portion of the net proceeds may support the FFA program. The goal is the responsible management of space and equipment that is no longer serving district needs.

Union Master Agreements: you will see agreements for the teacher, support, and clerical union

in your board packet. We adjusted the teacher salary schedule that makes the starting wage \$50,000 in 26-2. The overall impact on teacher salaries is 3.9% in the first year and 4.2% in the second year using current staffing. Insurance and salary packages stay under 10% total for the two years.

Clerical has a very similar package with movement towards more uniform insurance payments and increases on longevity. Support has a very similar package to what was offered to Clerical, the package ends up being slightly higher just because of the large number that gain a year of experience in year two. The salary increase built in for that year of experience adds to the overall package in the second year.

Contract Language Highlights

Teaching Contract

- Clarified definition of part-time status
- Longevity pay tied to years of service at LPGE
- Extra-curricular longevity pay added
- Limit of three teachers absent for personal leave on a single day
- Stipend increase for using fewer than 16 hours of leave; small stipend added for fewer than 24 hours
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) added regarding the Read Act
- Reimbursement for college coursework in hard-to-fill positions

Clerical and Support Contracts

- Credit for up to three prior years of district experience at hire
- Easter Monday added as a holiday (whether school is in session or not)
- Insurance contributions prorated based on days on paid status
- 403(b) language aligned with the teacher contract

- 144 contracted days actually worked (excluding protected leave) required for salary schedule advancement

Board Minute – Title IX 2026

Title IX is a federal civil rights law that says no one can be treated differently because of their sex in any school program that receives federal funding. This includes public schools like ours. “Sex discrimination” means unfair treatment because of someone’s sex. This can include harassment, unequal access to programs, unequal athletic opportunities, pregnancy discrimination, and retaliation for raising concerns. Federal interpretation of Title IX has changed over time and may continue to evolve regarding gender identity and sexual orientation. Regardless of federal interpretation, Minnesota state law prohibits harassment and discrimination based on these characteristics. School districts are required to follow applicable federal and state laws.

Under Title IX, schools must respond quickly and fairly to reports of sex discrimination. This starts when someone with “actual knowledge” of a possible violation reports it to the designated Title IX Coordinator. Schools must then take steps to stop discrimination, prevent it from happening again, and support anyone affected during the process. Support can include counseling, safety planning, schedule changes, or academic help while an investigation is underway.

A common part of Title IX is the requirement to address sexual harassment and assault. Harassment includes unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature that creates a hostile environment and makes it hard for a student to participate in school activities. If a complaint is made, the school must investigate fairly and promptly. Neutral investigators gather facts without bias, treat all parties with respect, and follow a written grievance process. Even a verbal complaint must be taken seriously and investigated.

Title IX also requires schools to provide equitable athletic opportunities. Schools must offer comparable benefits and opportunities in athletics, including equipment, coaching, practice time, travel, facilities, and other supports. Equality does not mean every team must receive identical treatment, but the overall athletic program must provide fair opportunities for participation. Compliance is evaluated by looking at factors such as the number of athletic opportunities offered, levels of student participation, and whether the district has a history of expanding opportunities when interest is demonstrated.

Title IX also addresses equal pay and fair treatment for employees regardless of sex. While compensation does not need to be identical for different positions, pay decisions must be based on experience, responsibilities, and qualifications. This is one reason districts complete regular pay equity reports.

Title IX is a broad law that affects many parts of education, not just sports and harassment. It also covers access to classes, counseling services, science and math programs, dress codes, parent-student protections, and more.

This summary is only a surface overview. More detailed information is found in our District Title IX policy. As a school system that receives federal funds, we are required to maintain a safe, fair, and nondiscriminatory environment for all students and staff. Individual contracts will be available for board review and approval. At this time, this is anticipated to include the Food Service Director, Onboarding Specialist, and Tech Assistant.

I.6. Auction – Approval of Items for Surplus Sale

A list of surplus items will be provided for board review and approval for sale. We will continue evaluating district inventory to identify additional items that may be appropriate for auction.

The district plans to work with the FFA department to organize and conduct the sale. In recognition of their assistance, the FFA department will receive a portion of the auction proceeds. The goal is to schedule the auction for June or July.

Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 123B.595, subd. 3 (Long-Term Facilities Maintenance Revenue) states:

subd. 3. Intermediate districts and other cooperative units.
(a) Upon approval through the adoption of a resolution by each member district school board of an intermediate district or other cooperative units under Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 123A.24, subd. 2, and the approval of the commissioner of education, a school district may include in its authority under this section a proportionate share of the Long-Term Facilities Maintenance (LTFM) costs of the intermediate district or cooperative unit. The cooperative unit may issue bonds to finance the project costs or levy for the costs, using LTFM revenue transferred from member districts to make debt service payments or pay project costs. Authority under this subd. is in addition to the authority for individual district projects under subd. 1. (b) The resolution adopted under paragraph (a) may specify which member districts will share the project costs under this subdivision, except that debt service payments for bonds issued by a cooperative unit or joint powers district to finance long-term maintenance project costs must be the responsibility of all member districts (Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 123A.24, subd. 1(b) and 123B.02, subd. 3).

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a School Board meeting of School District No.2753, State of Minnesota, was held on February 23, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose, in part, of approving the FY 28 Long-Term Facility Maintenance budget and authorizing the inclusion of a proportionate share of Intermediate School District's long-term facility maintenance projects and related debt service payments in the district's application for long term facility maintenance. _____ introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION APPROVING LONG-TERM FACILITY MAINTENANCE PROGRAM BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE INCLUSION OF A PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THOSE PROJECTS IN THE DISTRICT'S APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2028 LONG-TERM FACILITY MAINTENANCE REVENUE

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of, Long Prairie-Grey Eagle Public School, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. The Freshwater Education District School Board has approved a long-term facility maintenance program budget for its facilities for the 2027-2028 school year (FY 2028) in the amount of \$95,000 of which ISD 2753's proportionate share is \$7,941.90 for pay as you go projects. The various components of this program budget are attached as Exhibit A hereto and are incorporated herein by reference. Said budget is hereby approved. (Exhibit A)
2. Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 123B.53, subd. 1, as amended, provides that if an intermediate school district's long-term facility maintenance budget is approved by the school boards of each of the intermediate school district's member school districts, each member district may include its proportionate share of the costs of the intermediate school district program in its long-term facility maintenance revenue application.
3. The proportionate share of the costs of the intermediate school district's long-term facility maintenance program for each member school district to be included in its application shall be determined by multiplying the total cost of the intermediate school district long-term facility maintenance program times a three-year weighted average adjusted pupil units formula. For school year 2027-28 fiscal year 28), the long-term facility maintenance costs shall be funded through annual levy. The inclusion of this proportionate share in the district's long-term facility maintenance revenue application for FY 28 is hereby approved, subject to approval by the Commissioner of Education.
