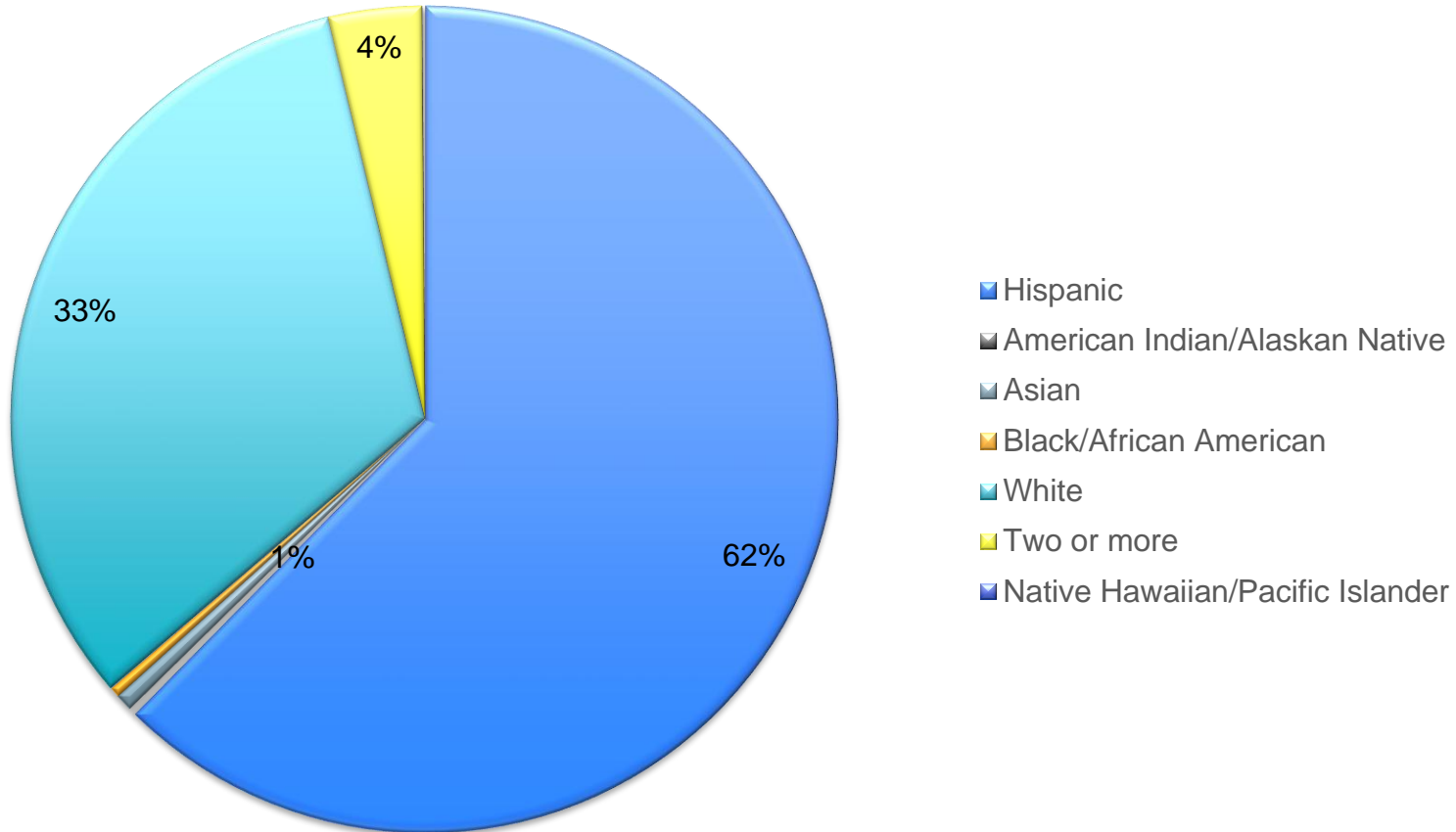

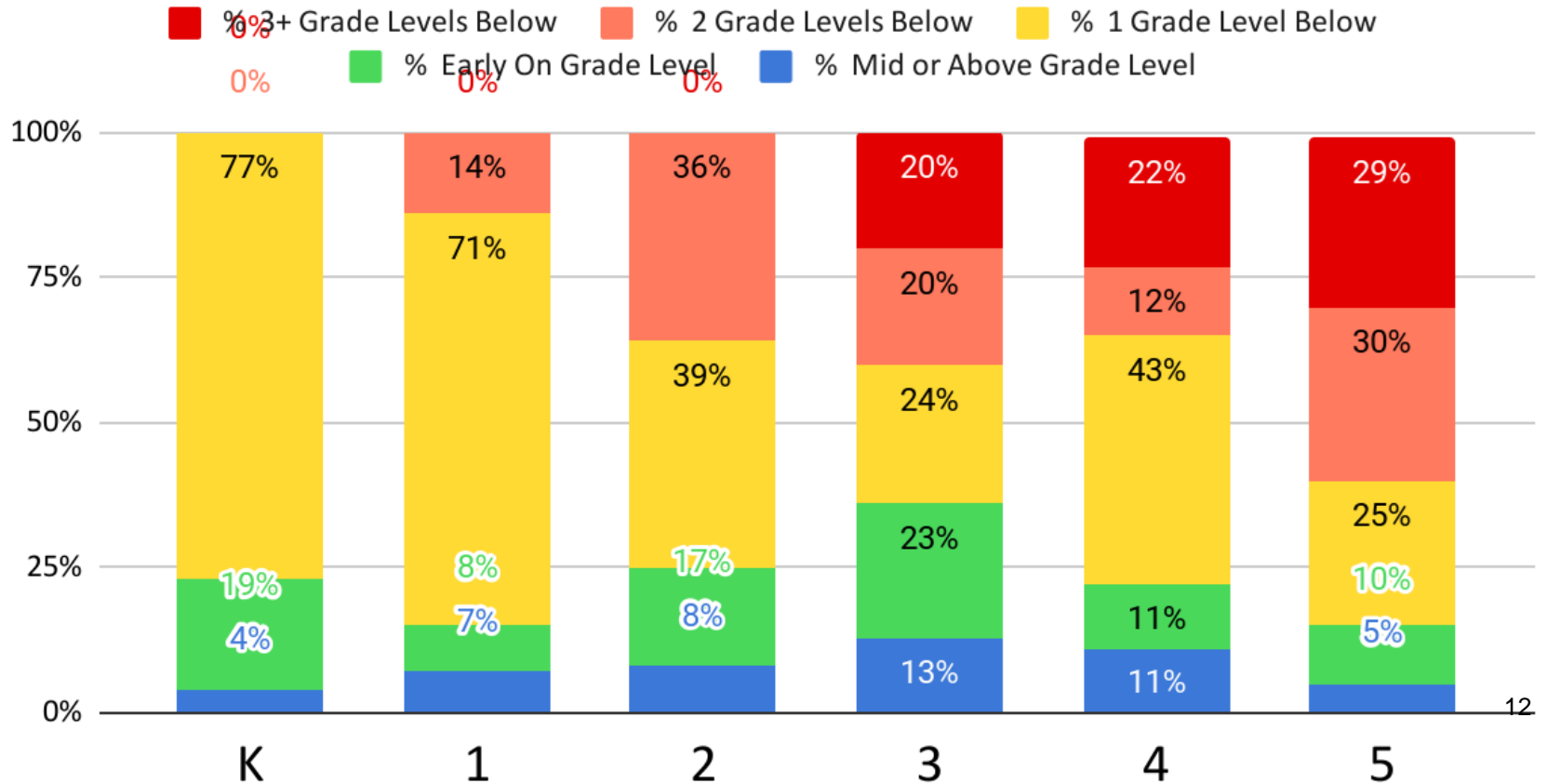

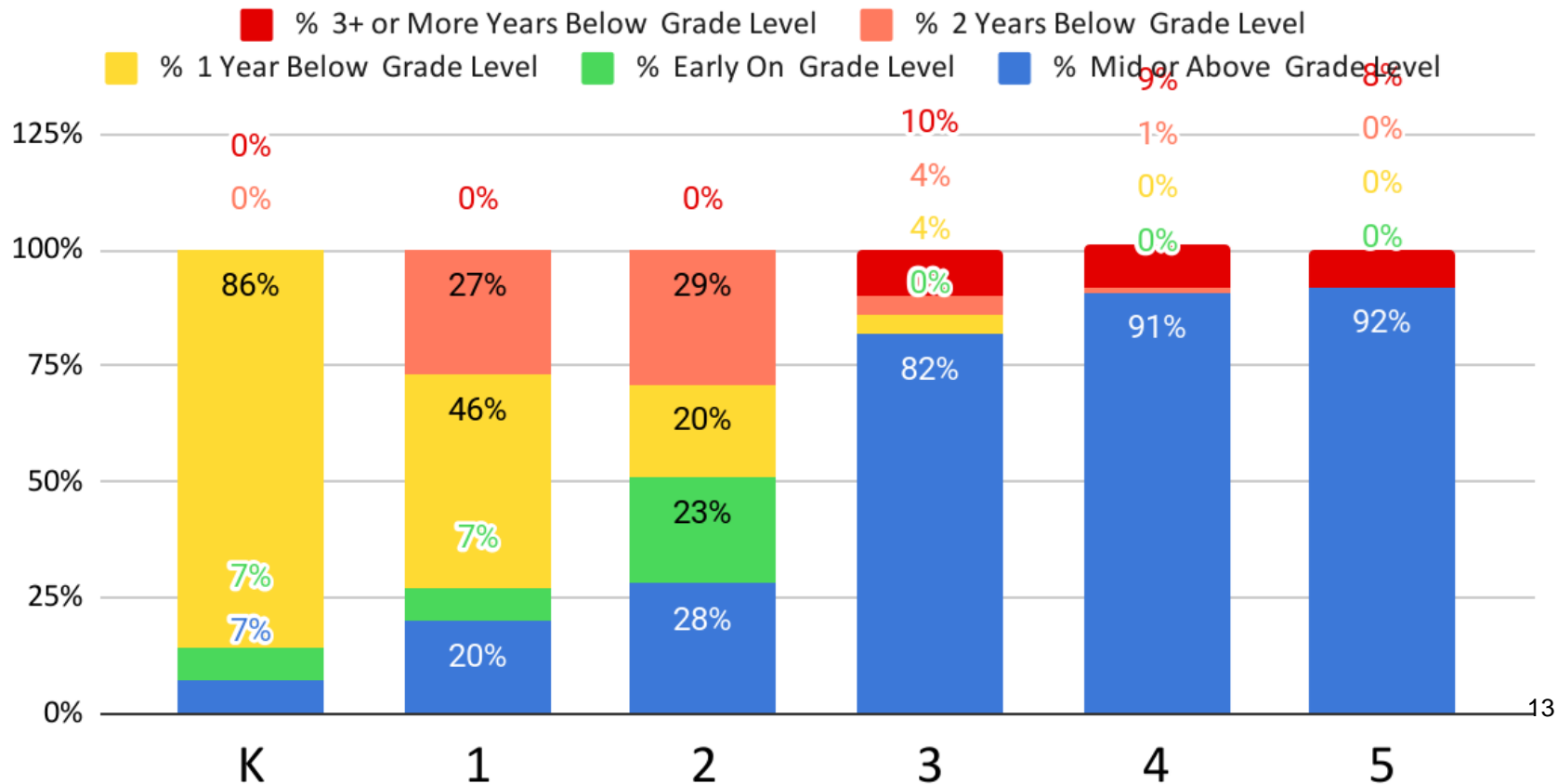

HSD - ELA iReady Overall Performance

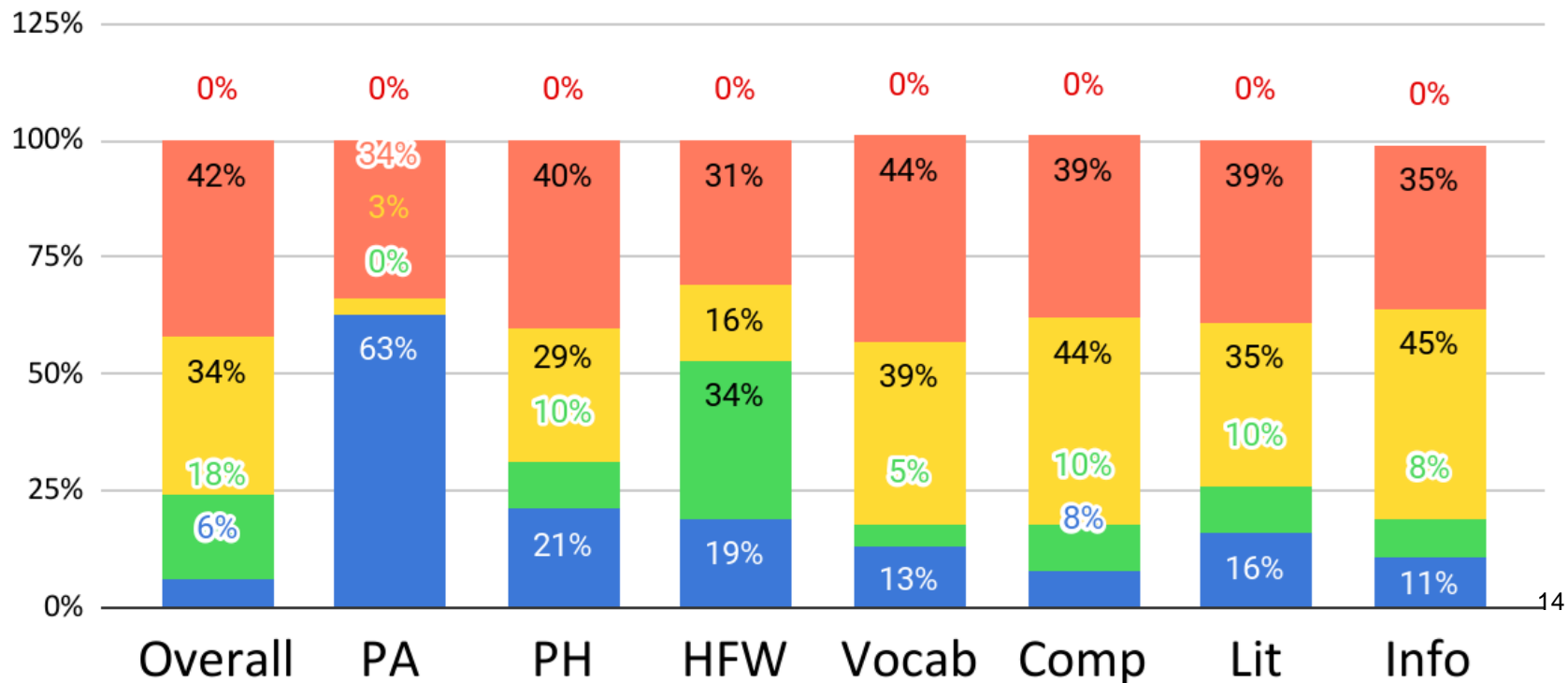


HSD - HFW Performance

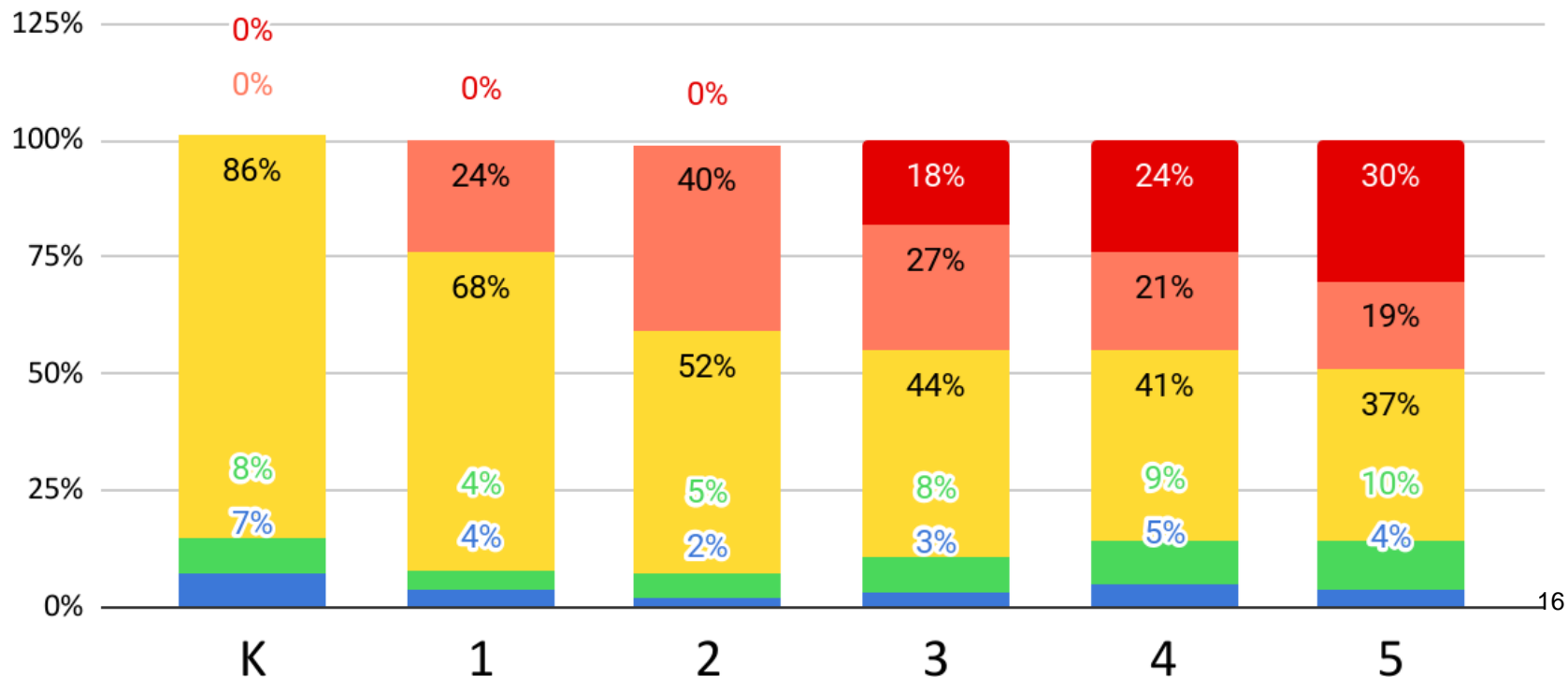

The on-track percentage is based on the number of credits students in that class have earned as of the end of the 2023-2024 school year. The reason the freshman class is not included is because none of them will have earned enough high school credits to be on track until the end of the first semester.

These cohorts are based on the students we have enrolled in that class at the beginning of October. The % on-track assumes that there are no other students that are a part of the cohort that have yet to enter or have left and not enrolled in another school district.

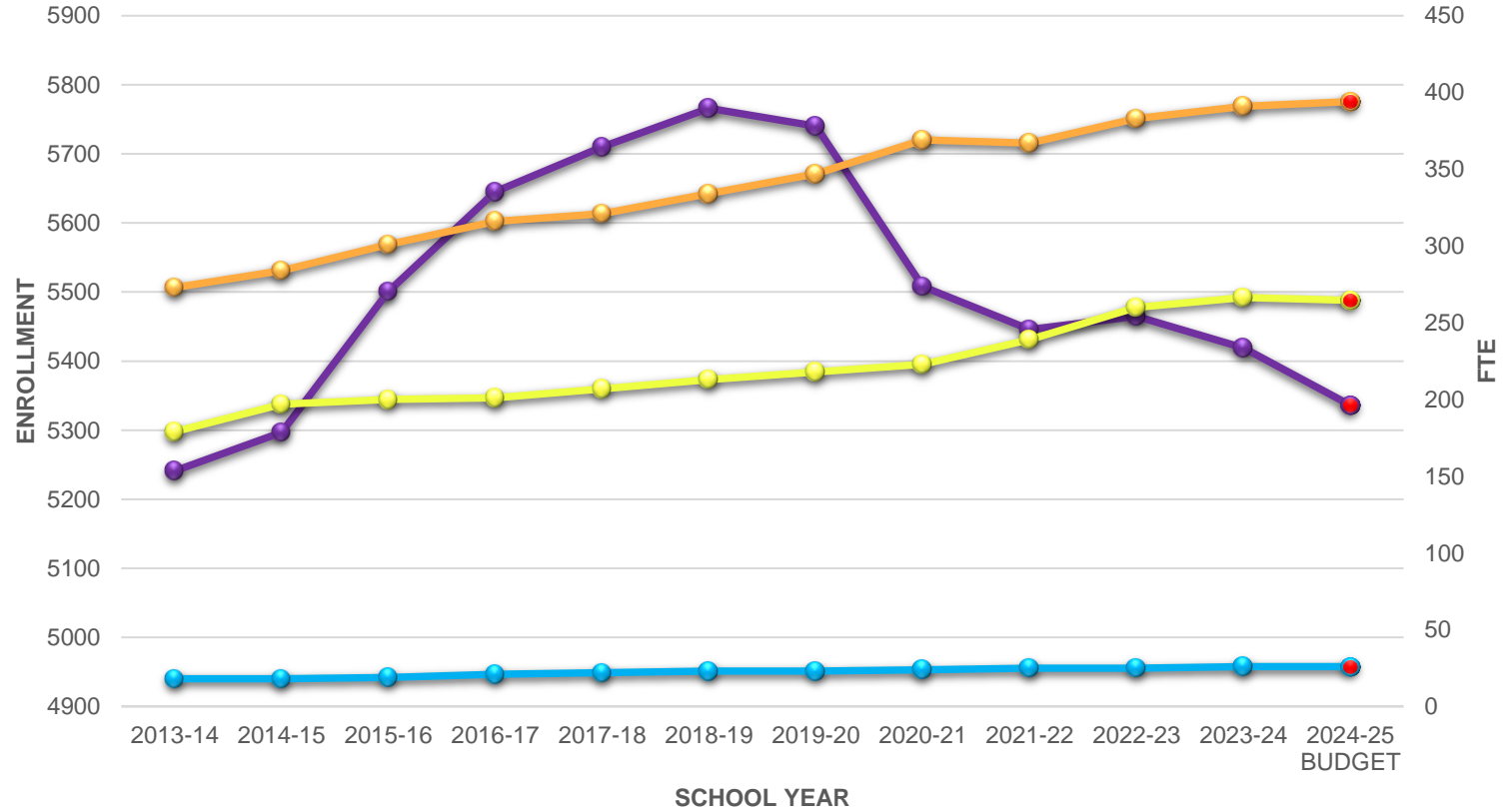
For each class 1% is equal to 4 or 5 students.
