Title: Office of Student Wellbeing

Background:

Dr. Frazee and members of her team presented information to the board of directors originally, at a work session on April 17, 2024. This work session is a continuation of that April 17 meeting, and provide time to gain a deeper understanding of services provided by the Office of Student Wellbeing.

At the previous work session, Dr. Frazee provided an overview of the education, prevention, and postvention services their team provides to support student mental health, suicide prevention, and suicide response provided by the Office of Student Wellbeing.

The Office of Student Wellbeing, prevention services has been working diligently over the past year in collaboration with community partners such as Lane County Mental Health and national programs such as the JED Foundation to review existing offerings and identify ways in which we can enhance and strengthen the mental health resources available to students and families in Eugene 4J.
