What does it mean for BHSD?

Policies come to the board for revision based on our subscription for Policy Plus with OSBA. Their team examines how our current policies are impacted by new legislation and state rules. Or, secondly, based on the recommendation of our staff or board members to review a policy for changes or ensure current district operations match filed policies. The policies here, are all from OSBA Policy Plus.

While this “batch” of policies from OSBA is a large number, many of the changes are due to small changes impacting multiple policies and efforts by OSBA to delete multiple similar policies and introduce a new streamlined policy that incorporates all required pieces.

Draft policy changes go next to related administrators, staff specialists for review. Will return to the Board likely in August 2024 for “First Read

- House Bill 2281
- District must designate one or more coordinators
- Can be ESD staff
- Awaiting rules

Policy AC- Nondiscrimination

Sexual Harassment

- House Bill 2280
- Revised definition of sexual harassment
- New description of “without consent”

Policy GBN/JBA - Sexual Harassment

Compulsory Attendance

- Senate Bill 817 Revised rules
- Citations for compulsory attendance violations removed
- Still an option to cite for ORS 339.035

Policy JEA - Compulsory Attendance and it's Administrative Rule (AR)

Public Records

- HB 2112
- Changed definition of what constitutes public record
- Now uses terms like “audio or video technology; audio and video recording” rather than “video tape”
- “...filed so as to facilitate access and retrieval ...”

KBA-AR - Public Records (No changes to policy)

Make available a written procedure to the public that includes the procedures and costs for public records, including how fees calculated. I.e. Clerical time (\$40/hr), Administrator time (\$90/hr), Attorney time (\$300/hr), Printing (\$0.25 per page).

Procurement

- If it's for goods and services and its under \$25,000 that is considered small procurements
- Intermediate procurement requires 3 quotes
- Above \$250,000 is full or regular procurement, requirements for bids etc.
- OSBA is deleting and combining multiple related policies and ARs
- New DJC-AR, streamlined, but still provides guidance for procurements that may be exempt from competitive bidding or special procurements.

FAPE (Free Appropriate Public Education under Section 504)

IGBAF & AR

- SB756 (2023), district employees assigned to work with students on IEP or 504 Plan are to be invited to IEP or 504 meetings.
- Removed COVID-19 Recovery section since it has sunset.
- Added section on abbreviated school day.

IGBAG

- SB 758 (2023), added to the Independent Educational Evaluations section stating parents are entitled to examine their students records

Safety threats

- SB 35 (2023), requires districts to adopt policy language about using electronic communication to notify parents, guardians and employees within 24 hours of a safety threat action, that was not a drill.
- Message MUST include a description of what happened, the duration, what actions the school or district took, and how that action was resolved.
- Several policies were affected, in part due to this SB, and from a rewrite of the Health Services OAR by ODE, resulting in a recommendation to reorganize several policies ... EBC/EBCA Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans (delete) replace with EBC - Emergency Plan and First Aid (highly recommended). EBCA Safety Threats, required (new), EBCB - Emergency Procedure Drills and Instruction, highly recommended (revised).

Health services plan

- Restructuring of OAR 581-022-222- Health Services
- No requirement now for policy on communicable diseases or HIV/AIDS/HBV
- Created new requirement for a Health Services Plan
- Outlines several new requirements for inclusion in the plan

Includes, but not limited to:

- Plan for health care space
- Communicable disease prevention, communication strategies
- Health Screenings, vision and dental screenings

Delete

- EBBA - First Aid
- EBBA - AR First Aid-Infection Control
- GBEBA - HIV/AIDS
- JHC - Student Health Services
- JHCC and JHCC-AR - Communicable Diseases
- JHCCA - HIV/AIDS

Add

- EBBA - Student Health Services, highly recommended, New

Update

- EBBB - Injury or Illness Reports, required
- GBEB and its AR - Communicable Disease in Schools, highly recommended

School Sports Participation

Revision of OAR 581-021-0041

- Rules modified how some terms are used
- Forms are allowed to be hard copy or electronic
- Forms may be generated by a medical provider if it meets the requirements
- Removed vision and dental screenings from policy, b/c now a requirement of the Health Services Plan

Policy JHCA/JHCB - Immunization and School Sports Participation**
optional

- Added concussion language from statute

Restraint & Seclusion

Revision of OAR 581-021-0556 (Procedures) and new SB 1024

- Creates new rules for record keeping
- New requirement to review any video or audio at the debriefing meeting
- Requires records to be preserved in the original format with alteration
- Requirement to disclose records if ODE is investigating a possible abuse case.

JGAB - Use of Restraint or Seclusion** (required policy)

JGAB-AR - Use of Restraint or Seclusion, required

Also changes to JGA - Corporal Punishment, optional (SB 577)

Student representatives on the school board

- Not mandated by the State
- Decision to add a Student Representative is a local decision
- BCBA - Student Representative(s) on the Board and an accompanying administrative regulation, BCBA - Student Representative(s) on the Board, both are option.

UP TO LOCAL CONTROL and BHSD already maintains a regular rep appointed by high school student government.

Other updates

- Head lice
- Updated policy language for abuse reporting to DHS
- Policy language for superintendent or administrator contracts; compare contracts and revise policy as needed
- Criminal records checks/fingerprinting
