Re: Approval of Summer 2023 Bond Renovations Bid Package – 2021 Bond

I would like an opportunity to share with the Board of Education information on bid pack #1 for the summer 2023 Interior Renovations projects at Cleveland Elementary, Rosedale Elementary, Riley Upper Elementary, Frost Middle School and Franklin High School. Additionally, this bid pack includes installation of air conditioning at Roosevelt Elementary, Webster Elementary, and Stevenson High School.

Bids for this project were due and opened on October 25, 2022. The Bond Team has reviewed the information and interviewed bidders. The recommended bidders are detailed in Clark Construction's recommendation letter, which accompanies this memo. Additionally, recommendation letters from the District's owner's representative, Plante Moran Cresa, and construction manager, Clark Construction, are attached.

The total project cost for the summer 2023 hard construction is \$21,193,422.00, plus a 7% contingency of \$1,483,540.00 and fees of \$877,408.00, for a project total of \$23,554,369.00. Please note, this includes acceptance of all alternate bids.

Dear Mr. Francis:

This letter transmits an update from Plante Moran Cresa (PMC) as it relates to the assignment to assist and advise Livonia Public Schools (LPS) in its selection of Prime Contractors for the Project listed above. This update represents the mutual efforts of PMC, Clark Construction Co., French Associates, and LPS administration and staff (the Bond Team) to present a framework in order to identify, evaluate and recommend Prime Contractors for this Project.

On October 5, 2022, Construction Documents were formally issued and made available. An advertisement for bids was published in a local newspaper, posted to the required State of Michigan websites and forwarded to multiple construction bidding websites.

On October 25, 2022, 45 bid proposals were received, and over the next several days were reviewed to determine the budget implications. Interviews were also held during this time and were attended by various members of the Bond Team.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after subsequent clarifications and discussions, the Bond Team is recommending the firms listed in Clark Construction Co.'s Award Recommendation Letter dated November 2, 2022 for contract award.

The recommendation includes the acceptance of multiple Alternates as further detailed in Clark's recommendation letter.

Including hard construction of \$21,193,422.00, CM costs and fees of \$877,408.00, and construction contingency of \$1,483,540.00, this Project award recommendation equals **\$23,554,369.00**

For the Prime Contractors, the costs for this work will be detailed in AIA Contract A132 – 2019 Standard Form of Agreements between Owner and Contractor pending final review and approval of terms by district legal counsel.

Dear Mr. Francis,

Bids for Summer 2023 Renovations & A/C Upgrades were received on October 25th, 2022. Bids were based on plans and specifications issued by French Associates dated 9/28/202 including Addendums 1, 2, & 3. Clark Construction Company, French Associates, Unified Building System Engineering, Plante Moran Cresa and Livonia Public Schools have conducted post bid interview meetings with the low qualified recommended bidders. Bidders have submitted information in Clark Construction pre-qualification data base. The pre-qualification database includes trade contractors past financials', bonding capacity, safety rating, labor capacity during the project schedule and reference calls regarding past projects. Each Contractor has committed to meet the requirements in the Contract Documents.

In addition to the direct Trade Contractor costs, Clark Construction Company recommends including a Construction Contingency budget of 7% for any unforeseen issues and a General Condition budget of 2% related to items such as building permits, security and safety requirements, temporary utilities, etc. No costs will be committed without prior approval of the District Administration for each item. Clark Construction, Construction Manager's Fee of 2% based on the Trade Contract cost and Construction Contingency. Any unused Contingency and associated CM Fee's will be returned to Livonia Public Schools.

Clark Construction Company recommends Livonia Public Schools enter contracts with each of the Trade Contractors for the listed amounts below. The recommended Trade Contractors provided the lowest qualified bid for the work.

Re: Stormwater Management Plan Discussion

We would like to discuss the School District's Stormwater Management Plan at the next Committee of the Whole meeting on Monday, November 7, 2022.

Livonia Public Schools is a part of the Detroit metropolitan area that discharges stormwater through a separate storm sewer system. The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) administers storm water regulations and maintains oversight and regulatory authority of the systems. The MDEQ requires school districts (and other governmental agencies) to obtain permits for storm water discharge. As part of the permit process, the District maintains a Storm Water Management Program Plan (SWMP). We work with Arch Environmental to maintain an up-to-date plan and to renew our permit with MDEQ every five years.

The District is dedicated to good environmental practices and we continue to work with MDEQ to improve and update our practices and continue to educate the Livonia Public Schools community.

As part of our good practices and requirements of MDEQ, we would ask the Board of Education to adopt a resolution in support of the District's stormwater management plan (draft copy attached). As always, please let me know if there are any additional questions.

Dear Mr. Harry Lau:

In 2019, individual permit number MI0060044 was issued to Livonia Public Schools for the reauthorization to discharge water through the districts municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to waters of the state.

To retain the authorization to discharge, the district was required to submit a new application by April 1, 2022. To fulfill the application requirements for the ordinance or regulatory mechanism that prohibits non-storm water discharges into the applicant's MS4 and the ordinance or other regulatory mechanism to address post-construction storm water runoff from new development and redevelopment projects, including preventing or minimizing water quality impacts, a Stormwater Board Resolution is required. The Stormwater Board Resolution is used in place of an ordinance and includes specific language for preventing illicit discharges and implementing the post-construction requirements. Please have the school board review the Stormwater Board Resolution and return the passed resolution to Arch Environmental Group for submission to the EGLE.

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools owns and operates facilities within the boundaries of the “Detroit” urbanized area which discharges stormwater through a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) to surface waters of the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy maintains oversight and regulatory authority for compliance with the terms and conditions of the NPDES Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System discharge permit; and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools has applied for and received permit coverage to discharge stormwater from Livonia Public Schools facilities to the MS4; and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to comply with the NPDES Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System discharge permit requirements, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools has developed a Stormwater Management Program Plan (SWMP) outlining the policies, procedures, and best management practices to be employed by the district to comply with the permit requirements, and

WHEREAS the conditions of the NPDES Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System discharge permit require Livonia Public Schools to develop policies and procedures that prohibit illicit discharges to their stormwater system and to implement appropriate enforcement procedures and actions to detect and eliminate such illicit discharges, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to prohibit the discharge of non-stormwater discharges into the storm drain system, including but not limited to pollutants or waters containing any pollutants, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to eliminate illicit discharges and illicit connections, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to prohibit the construction, use, maintenance or continued existence of illicit connections to the storm drain system. This prohibition expressly includes, without limitation, illicit connections made in the past, regardless of whether the connection was permissible under law or practices applicable or prevailing at the time of connection, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to obtain a Part 91 permit from the appropriate state, county, or local governmental soil erosion permitting agency for new development and redevelopment projects that disturb one or more acres, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to obtain a construction site permit from the local municipality or other governing unit for new development and redevelopment projects that disturb one or more acres, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to inspect, operate, and maintain structural controls for the purpose of reducing pollutant contribution, control runoff, and decrease or eliminate stream bank erosion due to stormwater runoff, and

WHEREAS Livonia Public Schools agrees to comply with the requirements of the State of Michigan Permit (Rule 323.2190) for stormwater discharge from construction activity.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Livonia Public Schools Board of Education is highly committed to practicing sound environmental principals including the reduction of pollutants to surface waters through discharges of stormwater. The Board hereby approves and instructs the district Superintendent to enforce the above listed policies and procedures for illicit discharge elimination, control of stormwater runoff and long-term operation and maintenance of structural controls as part of the overall Livonia Public Schools Stormwater Management Program Plan.

Re: SACC Furniture and Materials – Child Care Stabilization Grant

Our district has been awarded two rounds of funding from the Child Care Stabilization Grant. The Child Care Stabilization Grant is a \$700 million investment in child care providers across Michigan. The Stabilization Grant is a non-competitive grant, although providers must apply to receive the funds, for child care providers to help stabilize operations and support the health and safety of children and staff.

With funds from the first round of grant funding, individual orders were placed for many of the SACC (School Age Child Care) sites to update their furniture. Not all SACC sites received new furniture. We would like to use a portion of the grant funds from the second round of funding to update some of the furniture in those SACC classrooms that didn't receive furniture in the spring. Items to be purchased include tables, chairs, storage units, classroom manipulatives, STEM mobile stations, light tables, area rugs, and books bins. The purchase would be made via the OMNIA Partners cooperative purchasing program through Lakeshore Learning, for a total cost of \$35,400.87.

Re: Administrative Procedure DJE - Purchasing

Sections 1267 and 1274 (MCL 380.1267 and 380.1274) of Michigan's Revised School Code establish a base above which competitive bids must be obtained for school construction projects (including renovation, repair, or remodeling) and procurement of supplies, materials, and equipment. The laws also provide for an increase in the base amount corresponding to increases in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). The fiscal year 2021-2022 base of \$26,046 for Section 623a, 1267, and 1274 items has increased by \$2,002 to \$28,048 for fiscal year 2022- 2023 based on the Consumer Price Index.

Administrative Procedure DJE outlines the procedures that must be followed in the procurement of all supplies, materials, equipment, and services paid for by the district. Historically the bid threshold and school board approval threshold outlined in the district's administrative procedures closely align with the amount established by the Revised School Code. Therefore, I am recommending the current references to \$26,000 in the administrative procedures be adjusted to \$28,000. I am also suggesting we replace the word "sealed" with "competitive" in section 4 based on consultation with our legal counsel and to align the administrative procedure more closely with requirements of the Revised School Code.

FISCAL MANAGEMENT PURCHASING

OCTOBER 4, 2021

Procurement of all supplies, materials, equipment, and services paid for by the District shall be made in accordance with all applicable Federal, State, and local statutes, Board policies, and administrative procedures. Specifically, purchases made with Federal grant funds will be made in accordance with the USDOE requirements (2 CFR 200.317-.326) for the administration and management of Federal grants and Federally-funded programs. All District employees, officers, and agents who have purchasing authority shall abide by standards of conduct covering conflicts of interest as established in Board Policy GAG as well as the following regulations:

1. All purchases require the approval of the building principal/administrator or the assistant business principal.
2. All purchases over \$2,000 require the approval of the building principal/administrator or the assistant business principal along with approval of the designated central office administrator.
3. All purchases \$10,000 - ~~\$26,000~~ \$28,000 may be awarded after receipt of written quotations, which will be attached to the purchase order. An attempt will be made to obtain at least three written quotes.
4. All purchases pertaining to procurement of supplies, materials, equipment, or pertaining to construction, renovation, repair, or remodeling over ~~\$26,000~~ \$28,000 will be awarded after receipt of ~~sealed~~ competitive bids to be solicited by the purchasing supervisor and with the approval of the School Board. An attempt will be made to obtain at least three quotations from competitive bids. Awards will be made to the lowest responsible qualified vendor meeting specifications, taking into consideration the quality of materials or services desired and their contribution to program needs. However, the Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept that bid which appears to be in the best interest of the district.

The following items are exempt from competitive bidding:

- Professional services
 - Purchases made through governmental entities or purchasing consortiums
 - Magazines, textbooks, books, or periodicals; software licensing and upgrades
5. Emergency purchases may be made with appropriate central office authorization without utilizing the quotation or bidding process. A public emergency may arise as a result of an accident or other unforeseen occurrence which could affect the life, health, or safety of children, and where immediate action cannot await competitive bidding. Fire or damage by the elements to electrical systems, heating, or school plumbing also fall under this heading. All emergency orders will be placed with the vendor by the Purchasing Department.

6. To ensure proper inventory tagging and prompt payment, all equipment requisitions will be processed for delivery to the central warehouse.

The Director of Finance is authorized, on a limited basis, to purchase products which are regularly purchased by the district and that are being offered at a special limited price that requires action prior to normal Board committee review and approval process. The district will secure other competitive bids to confirm that the special price cannot be duplicated under the regular Board approval process.

On occasion, because of a need to maintain conformity or compatibility, or to satisfy certain technical requirements, it may be appropriate to seek a product or service from a single source. Any deviations from the bidding requirements of this regulation must be authorized by the director of finance.

Purchase requisitions cannot be processed until all of the above criteria have been met. Requisition procedures are designed to meet the needs of the various operating units within the district and must also follow the purchasing policies as approved by the Board of Education.
