 - a. Timelines are the same for both Outdoor Learning Areas and Tennis and Turf project
 - i. Plan is to have RFP out mid-January
 - ii. Info to Board ASAP due to tight timeline

 - i. Dori, Glenn, and GMB met with Elementary principals to discuss their priorities

 1. Looking at layout and fibers for turf

2. Haslett had turf style we like for multipurpose
 3. Our goal is to have lines sewn in – not painted on
 4. Electricity under turf—four corners and center
 5. Press box and concrete will be included in RFP
- iii. Main issue with tennis courts we are trying to work out is width of center aisle
 1. We like the basic layout we have been working with through this process
 2. Sheds and electricity are likely to be included in tennis court plans
 - iv. Timelines for RFPs—small bond and turf tennis meeting together to ensure that these projects move at the same time
- d. Eastminster Parking Lot – no update
 - e. Elementary air filters ordered last week – Red Cedar does not need them because they have dynamic air cleaners and individual units.
 - i. 38-40 units ordered. They will be distributed to buildings/rooms with highest need first
