RE: Financial Report

Background: Administration monitors revenues and expenditures on an ongoing basis and provides the Board with monthly financial updates. The following reflects the financial position as of August 31, 2026.

Discussion:

Revenue:

As of August 31, total revenue received is approximately \$11,450,637.64, or 58.2% of the FY27 adopted budget. Tuition revenue totals approximately \$11.07 million, or 63.7% of budget, reflecting district tuition collections and O&M tuition received early in the fiscal year. Other local revenue totals approximately \$10,478, or 7.2% of budget. State and federal revenue totals approximately \$367,365, or 17.2% of budget.

Revenue collections remain strong and are primarily supported by tuition receipts. Federal reimbursements above the annual budget represent a favorable variance and will continue to be monitored as additional receipts are recorded. At this time, there are no areas of concern within the revenue budget.

Expenditures:

Total expenditures through August 31 are approximately \$1,641,853.75, or 8.2% of the annual budget. Instructional expenses total approximately \$1.06 million, or 6.1% of budget, demonstrating a controlled pace of spending early in the fiscal year. Administration and Board expenses total approximately \$472,146, or 22.3% of budget, reflecting the timing of early-year administrative and board-related costs. Operations and Maintenance expenses total approximately \$108,487, or 25.2% of budget, reflecting initial facility and operational expenditures for FY27.

Overall, spending across instructional and support service areas remains stable, with no significant variances noted. Expended and encumbered amounts total approximately \$15.09 million, or 75.4% of the expenditure budget, indicating that a significant portion of annual staffing and other obligations has already been committed. The Cooperative continues to maintain a solid financial position, supported by strong tuition collections and controlled expenditure activity.

As of August 31, 2026, the Cooperative's cash balance is approximately \$12.51 million and remains sufficient to meet current operational needs.

Recommendation: Administration recommends that the Board accept the Mid-Valley Financial Report as presented.

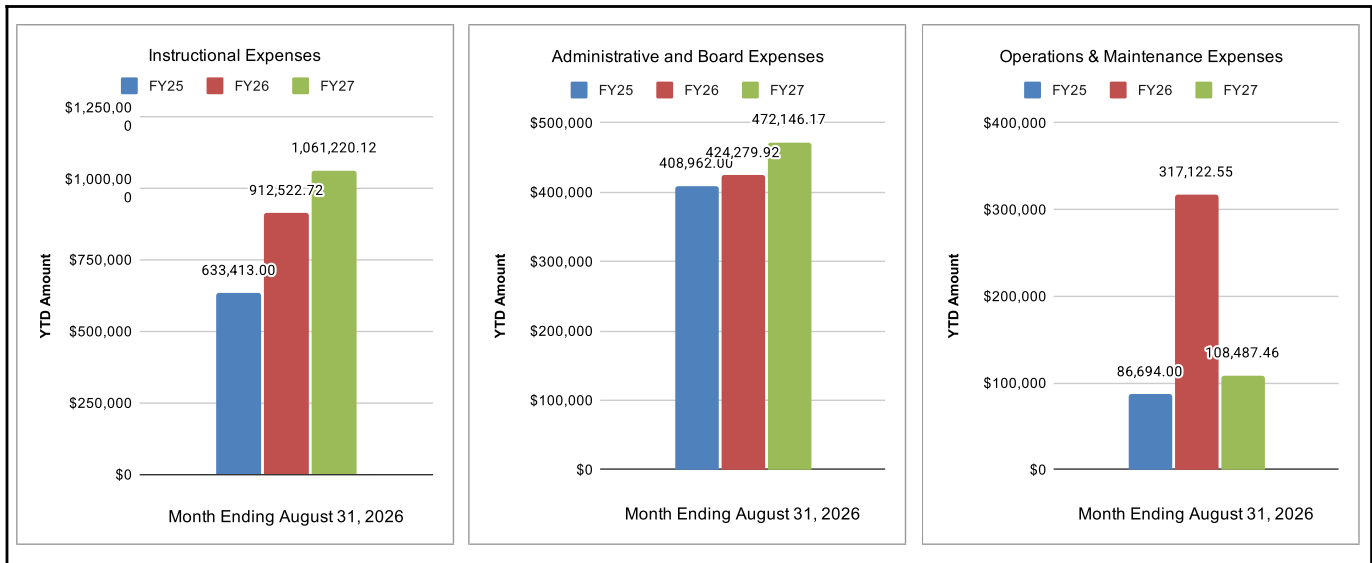

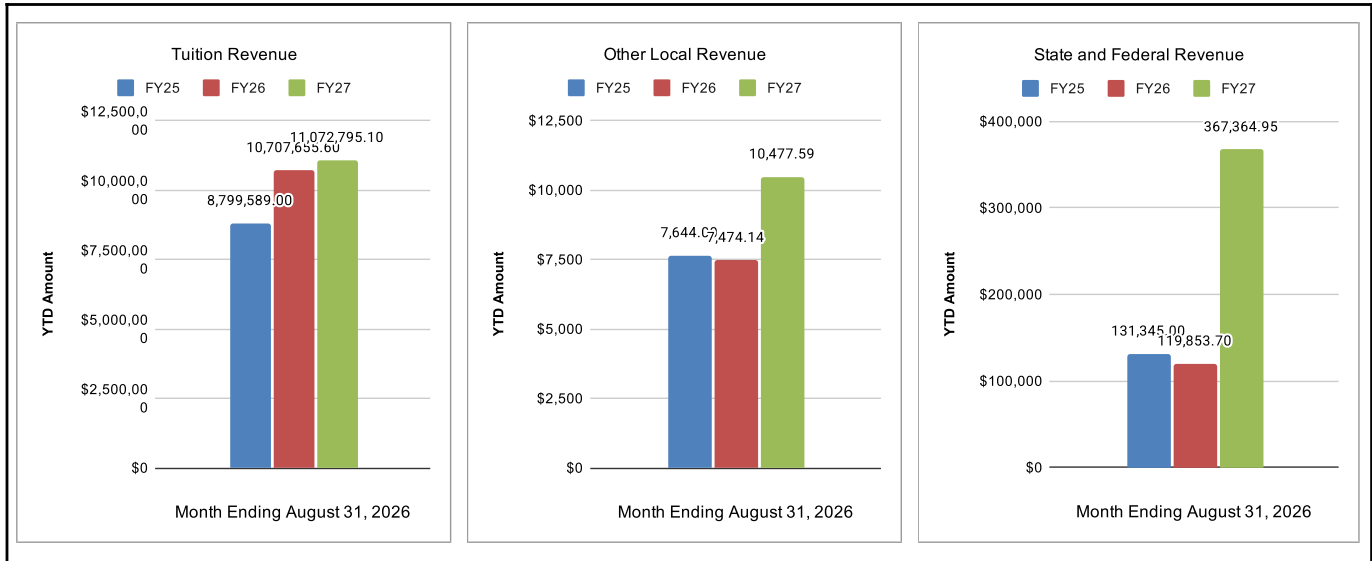
Expense Insight:

As of August 31, 2026, total YTD expenses are approximately \$1.64 million, or 8.2% of the annual budget. Instructional expenses total \$1.06 million (6.1%), while Administration and Board expenses are at \$472,146 (22.3%) and Operations & Maintenance expenses are at \$108,487 (25.2%), reflecting the timing of early-year administrative, board, and facility costs. Including encumbrances, 75.4% of the total expenditure budget is committed, primarily through staffing and other annual obligations. Overall, actual spending remains controlled and consistent with the early stage of FY27.

Revenue Insight:

As of August 31, 2026, total YTD revenue is approximately \$11.45 million, or 58.2% of the annual budget. Tuition revenue remains the primary driver at \$11.07 million (63.7% of budget), while Other Local Revenue totals \$10,478 (7.2%). State and Federal Revenue totals \$367,365 (17.2%), including \$323,312 in federal receipts; federal revenue is at 108.5% of budget, driven primarily by Medicaid fee-for-service reimbursements. Overall, revenue collections are strong and support the Cooperative's financial position entering the remainder of FY27.

Enrollment and Capacity Highlights

- FY27 enrollment totals 292 students: 285 confirmed district placements, three pending district placements, two SAFE School students, and two students receiving homebound services. The homebound students are included in total enrollment but excluded from classroom-capacity calculations.
- The roster identifies 29 students requiring 1:1 teacher-assistant support and three students requiring 1:1 nursing support.
- SAIL 1 exceeds recommended capacity by one student. Nine additional classrooms have no remaining opening after pending placements are considered.
- Openings remain specific to program, grade level, location, and student needs and are not interchangeable across classrooms.

Administrative Assessment and Next Steps

Administration will continue to monitor confirmed and pending placements, homebound services, classroom composition, and related 1:1 staffing needs. Any recommended staffing or classroom adjustments resulting from enrollment movement will be brought to the Executive Board as appropriate.

Purpose

This report summarizes the final 2026 ESY enrollment, program costs, district billing, and year-over-year trends. The reconciliation reflects actual program expenses and individualized student support costs following completion of the summer program.

Enrollment and Service Profile

ESY served 352 students, an increase of 36 students (11.4%) from 2025. District 303 accounted for the largest share, with 129 students (36.6% of enrollment).

Enrollment grew faster than total cost, reducing average cost per student by 1.8% while the full-day base rate remained essentially flat. The larger 2026 program therefore operated with improved per-student cost efficiency.

Reconciliation and Closeout

Payments received totaled \$538,121 versus final billing of \$526,821, a net difference of \$11,300 after all participating district balances. Business managers will determine the allocation of the savings.

Board Summary

The 2026 ESY program closed below budgetary projections while serving substantially more students than in 2025. The favorable variance and lower average cost per student indicate effective cost management. No Board action is requested.

Purpose

The attached FY26 summaries provide final enrollment and financial results for the 2025-26 school and operational year. Overall, enrollment and 1:1 support needs finished above invoiced projections, while Mid-Valley closed the year with a favorable financial result.

Enrollment Summary

Mid-Valley served approximately seven more students than projected based on days enrolled, with final program enrollment totaling **277.0 student FTE**. New Directions accounted for the largest increase at **8.4 FTE above projection**, partially offset by lower-than-projected enrollment in SAIL and SEA.

The most significant support variance was in 1:1 services: 1:1 teaching assistant support finished **10.2 FTE above projection** and 1:1 nursing support finished **1.0 FTE above projection**, for a combined increase of 11.2 FTE.

Revenue performance was driven primarily by higher Medicaid reimbursements and sustained interest earnings. Member-district daily-rate changes remained within the 10% threshold; actual rates ranged from 9.2% below budget for New Directions to 9.5% above budget for SEA.

Business officials will discuss management of the FY26 balance. The enrollment and support variances will also inform future projections and staffing assumptions.
