**REPORT TO CLEBURNE CITY COUNCIL AND  
CLEBURNE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
CANVASSING AUTHORITIES  
BY THE GENERAL CUSTODIAN OF ELECTION RECORDS**

In my capacity as the General Custodian of Election Records and served as the Early Voting Clerk under the Texas Election Laws, I have reviewed the precinct returns of the Joint General Election held on May 7, 2022 in the City of Cleburne, Texas and in the jurisdiction of the Cleburne Independent School District for the following elective places:

- Councilmember Single Member District 4
- School Board Trustee, Place 6
- School Board Trustee, Place 7

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My review and audit of election records in the No. 2 Envelope presented to me by the “**District 1/3**” Presiding Judge *confirms the unofficial tabulation results for Election Day* as posted on the City of Cleburne website on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

My review and audit of election records in the No. 2 Envelope presented to me by the “**District 2**” Presiding Judge *confirms the unofficial tabulation results for Election Day* as posted on the City of Cleburne website on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

My review and audit of election records in the No. 2 Envelope presented to me by the “**District 4**” Presiding Judge *confirms the unofficial tabulation results for candidates for Election Day* as posted on the City of Cleburne website on Saturday, May 7, 2022. The “Official Tabulation” spreadsheet reflects a correction to the voter turnout count to include three (not four) provisional voters, making the total voter turnout from 44 to 47.

My review and audit of election records in the No. 2 Envelopes presented to me by the Early Voting Ballot Board Judge in connection with the records generated by the Early Voting Clerk for mail ballots *confirms the unofficial tabulation results for Early Voting in Person and By Mail* as posted on the City of Cleburne website on Saturday, May 7, 2022.

The Early Voting Ballot Board re-convened on May 16, 2022 at 5:30 pm to process/count the following:

- Mail ballots that were timely received after May 7, 2022, but were postmarked no later than May 7<sup>th</sup> by the US Postal Service, and
- Mail ballots from voters with defective carrier envelopes that were received before May 7, 2022, and the Early Voting Ballot Board took corrective action to remedy said defects, and the defects were remedied by voters; and
- Provisional ballots cast during the early voting period or on Election Day that were reviewed by the Johnson County Voter Registrar on May 10, 2022.

My review and audit of election records in the No. 2 Envelope presented to me on May 16, 2022, by the Early Voting Ballot Board Judge in connection with the records generated by the Early Voting Clerk for mail ballots and provisional ballots *is consistent* with the number of ballots provided to the Early Voting Ballot Board for the re-reconvened meeting.

The Unofficial Tabulation that was posted on the City of Cleburne website on Saturday, May 7, 2022, has been updated to reflect votes cast and tabulated by the Early Voting Ballot Board at their re-convened meeting and is incorporated herein as part of this canvassing report known as: "EXHIBIT A", Cleburne City and Independent School District Joint General Election, Saturday, May 7, 2022 Official Tabulation.

## RESOLUTION

NO. RS05-2022-65

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEBURNE, TEXAS DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 7, 2022, CITY OF CLEBURNE AND CLEBURNE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT JOINT GENERAL ELECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Cleburne, Texas, is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5, of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 8, 2022, the City Council ordered a General Municipal Election by Ordinance No. OR02-2022-11, to be held in said City on May 7, 2022, to elect a Mayor and Council Members for Single Member Districts One and Four; and

**WHEREAS**, following the filing deadlines for applications for place on the ballot, the City Council approved Ordinance No. OR03-2022-22 at their meeting on March 8, 2022, accepting the Certificate of Unopposed Candidates, declaring the candidates listed below elected to office, and therefore, cancelling said races in the May 7, 2022 general election:

**Mayor – Scott Cain**

**Councilmember, Single Member District One – Derek Weathers; and**

**WHEREAS**, on January 18, 2022, the Cleburne Independent School District (CISD) Board of Trustees ordered a General Election to elect School Board Trustees for Places Six and Seven; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and CISD general elections are held on the same day in all or part of the same territory and pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Election Code, the elections were held as a joint election in order to maintain consistency and accessibility in voting practices, polling places and election procedures to best assist the voters of Cleburne, with the City being responsible for conducting said election on behalf of both entities; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2022, the City Council amended Election Order No. OR02-2022-11, by amending the designated voting districts (aka precincts) and determining their respective polling locations for the efficient administration of the joint general election; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Chapter 67 of the Texas Election Code, two members of the City Council serve as the Canvassing Authority and are responsible for reviewing the election records as provided by the General Custodian of Election Records between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> day after election day; and

**WHEREAS**, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the results thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, at a Special Council Meeting on May 17, 2022, the City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election for both the City's and CISD's General Election;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEBURNE, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION ONE.** The City Council of the City of Cleburne officially finds and determines that said election held on May 7, 2022 was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that said election was duly held for Council Member for Single Member District Four, and the Cleburne Independent School District Board of Trustees Places Six and Seven, that due returns of the results of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Order calling said elections.

**SECTION TWO.** The City Council officially finds and determines that the votes were cast for the persons as shown in the Official Tabulation as provided by the General Custodian of Election Records (i.e., City Secretary), which is attached hereto as **EXHIBIT "A"**, and such votes having been cast by qualified electors of territory of said City who voted in the elections.

**SECTION THREE.** The City Council of the City of Cleburne officially finds, determines and declares the results of the 2022 General Election to be:

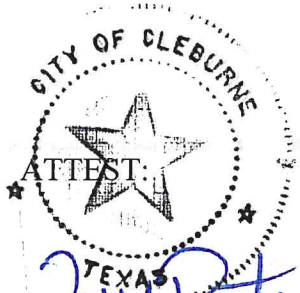

# Memorandum

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**Per AIA document A133-2019, the standard agreement between the owner and the construction manager as constructor, section 3.2 requires the construction manager to propose a “Guaranteed Maximum Price” for the owner to accept. The following are the option for your approval for the GMP for Lowell Smith Middle School.**

**Option “A” (Base Bid) includes the total demolition and reconstruction of the SPED area, enlargement of the cafetorium to serve 1450 students (3 lunches), slight remodel of all classrooms (paint and floor replacement), reconfiguration of the 5<sup>th</sup> grade science area, remove lockers and carpet on walls to install ceramic tile wainscot, change 8<sup>th</sup> grade boy’s athletics dressing room to robotics, reconfigure skills for living class room to academic classrooms, add 2<sup>nd</sup> floor gang restroom. Net add of 5 classrooms  
\$6,572,550**

**Option “B” Base Bid plus renovation of all gang restrooms, including new ceramic tile, new resinous flooring, new toilet partitions, new fixtures, new accessories. \$6,997,550**

**Option “C” Base Bid plus gang restrooms plus the removal and replacement of the administration area. \$7,697,550**

**Option “D” Base Bid plus the removal and replacement of the administration area. \$7,272,550.**

**The original construction cost approved by the voters in the May 2021 election is \$4,534,091 for Smith Middle School.**
