SPECIAL EDUCATION UPDATE

Kristin Sanders, Assistant Superintendent for Pupil/Personnel Services and Special Education, along with Leia Peterson, Coordinator of Special Education Services, presented a special education and support services update. Ms. Sanders stated the focus of special services this year has been special education compliance, special education instruction, and social emotional learning supports. A new program, AIM, which stands for Accept – Identify – Move, is being implemented for students with Emotional Disabilities (ED). Authored by Mark Dixon and Dana Paliliunas, this K-12 curriculum will help students academically as well as socially and emotionally. This curriculum is now fully implemented in both middle schools. Washington Elementary has three sections of ED classrooms and is receiving district training this semester. Moving forward, MHS/Coolidge will be trained the first semester of the 2021-2022 school year and AIM will be implemented the second semester of the 2021-2022 school year. District social emotional learning supports in the area of counseling and discipline were also reviewed.
