SUBJECT: Engage Services - Athletic Training Services

Reason for Board Consideration: Board of Education approval is required.

Action Necessary: Board of Education approval for engage services is requested.

Facts: Rock Valley Physical Therapy has satisfactorily performed the athletic training services for the District since the mid-1980's. Unfortunately, due to the turnover in our Athletic Director position, we are too late in the process for Rock Valley to allocate staff to provide the services for the upcoming school year. The District requested and received proposals from other companies to provide athletic training services for our student athletes.

After review of various options, Genesis Physical Therapy can provide physical therapy similar to what the District has had in the past. Genesis Physical Therapy has provided successful services to surrounding districts over the past years. Therefore, it is the recommendation of the administration that the Board approves engaging the services of Genesis Physical Therapy to perform the athletic training services for the school year 2022-2023.

Cost: The service agreement cost is \$20,000.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Education engage the services of Genesis Physical Therapy, Moline, Illinois to perform the athletic training services for the 2022-2023 school year for a cost of \$20,000.
