Reason for Board Consideration: Board of Education approval is required.


Action Necessary: Board of Education approval is requested.

Facts: For the last few years, the District has prioritized using available federal and state funds to enhance the quality of our educational facilities and support one-time expenditures. The goal has been to maximize traditional funding carryover for future sustainability. This year, the District will use carryover Title funds to support the replacement of outdated desks and chairs in the elementary and secondary buildings. This initiative will provide 452 new student desks and chairs, creating a more comfortable and conducive learning environment that supports student engagement and success.

The number of items allocated to each school will vary based on the Title funds allocated per the grant requirements. It is hoped that, if future funds become available, the District can continue this process next year. Therefore, the administration recommends the Board of Education approve the purchase and delivery of tables, student desks, and chairs for all elementary and secondary schools from Paragon Commercial Interiors Inc., Davenport, Iowa, for a cost not to exceed \$130,609.11.

Cost: That the Board of Education approve the purchase of student desks and chairs from Paragon Commercial Interiors Inc., Davenport, Iowa. The total cost for the furniture, delivery, and installation for the various buildings will not exceed \$130,609.11.

Action Necessary: Board of Education approval is requested.


Facts: Specifications were prepared and issued by Moline-Coal Valley School District, Moline, Illinois, for the sealcoating of Playgrounds and Parking Lot surfaces as well as striping of the park lots for (9) Elementary (Butterworths Parking was installed new 2023) and (2) Middels schools. This project consists of seal coating of the Blacktop Playgrounds and repaint of the lines. The seal coating all of the Blacktop Parking areas and restriping of both Blacktop and Concrete parking surfaces. The bids were received on July 11, 2024, and are shown in the attached tabulation.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the administration that the Board of Education award the contract for the 2024 Playground and Parking Sealcoating & Striping Projects to the lowest qualified bidder, as identified in the attached bid tab.

Cost: The total base bid cost is \$119,030. The alternate one cost is \$3,610 for a total cost of \$122,640 will be supported with Capital Projects (Fund 6).

Reason for Board Consideration: Board of Education approval is required.

Action Necessary: Board of Education approval is requested.


Facts: Specifications were prepared and issued by Moline-Coal Valley School District, Moline, Illinois, for the UV Window Film Project 2024. This project includes the installation of Energy Savings UV Film on the Eastern and Southern exposure of Butterworth School. Southern exposures for Jane Adams and MHS 2nd & 3rd floors of B and J wings schools. The installation of the UV Film will reduce and reject the sun's UV Rays and heat. As a result, it acts as a natural insulator against extreme temperatures in summer. A test was performed on 6 different classroom windows at MHS (The installation of the UV Film was completed over spring break) which has made a significant reduction of the solar gain and reduced the cooling load with increased comfort to the students. The bids were received on July 11, 2024, and are shown in the attached tabulation.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the administration that the Board of Education award the contract for the installation of the Energy Savings UV Film at Butterworth, Jane Adams and the Moline High School to the lowest qualified bidder, as identified in the attached bid tab.

Cost: The total base bid cost is \$85,010.07 and will be supported with Capital Projects (Fund 6).

Recommended Motion: That the Board of Education award the bid for the Moline-Coal Valley School District 2024 UV Window Film project to Wolking Window Tinting LLC, Bettendorf, Iowa, in the amount of \$85,010.07.

Reason for Board Consideration: Board of Education approval is required.

Action Necessary: Board of Education approval is requested.


Facts: Specifications were prepared and issued by Moline-Coal Valley School District, Moline, Illinois, for the 2024 Water Heater Project. This project includes the replacement of the Electric Water Heaters at both Bicentennial Elementary School and Wilson Middle School. Bicentennial's water heater has become limed up due to the hard water and 16 years of operation. Wilson's water heater is a tandem style that is leaking and requires both units to replace a single water heater system. This water heater has been installed since 2008 and has lasted its normal life expectancy. The bids were received on July 11, 2024, and are shown in the attached tabulation.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the administration that the Board of Education award the contract for the Water Heater replacement for both Bicentennial and Wilson Schools to the lowest qualified bidder, as identified in the attached bid tab.

Cost: The total base bid cost is \$57,710 and will be supported with Capital Projects (Fund 6).

Recommended Motion: That the Board of Education award the bid for the Moline-Coal Valley School District 2024 Water Heater project to Erickson Plumbing & Heating, Inc., Moline, Illinois, in the amount of \$57,710.
