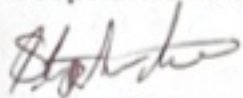

The project scope includes full replacement of the roof membrane and insulation in the areas designated on Attachment A of the proposal. For the most part, the projects in the proposal align with the Senior High work outlined in the Facility Needs Plan presented to the Board in October 2020. The only exception is that replacement of the roof over the south gym and receiving area has been moved forward two years to take advantage of economies of scale in performing the work.

The scope of services laid out in the proposal involves planning, design, management and coordination of the projects. The Architects will proceed with design and developing the construction documents and bid packages upon the Board’s approval of the proposal.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: For the scope of services described in the proposal, Perkins+Will is stipulating a fee of \$53,600. The cost of these services will be included in the FY2021 and FY2022 budgets and allocated to the Capital Projects Fund. As noted in the proposal, the anticipated construction budget is between \$595,800 and \$744,750 depending on the cost per square foot.

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the proposal from Perkins+Will.

Budget

Based upon the cost of the roofing at Lisle Elementary School, taking into account escalation over the last two years and adding in the demolition of the existing roof for this project, we estimate \$20 - \$25 per square foot for the roofing to be replaced. This would place the construction budget at \$595,800 - \$744,750. We recommend the District budget an additional 10% contingency beyond the estimated construction cost.

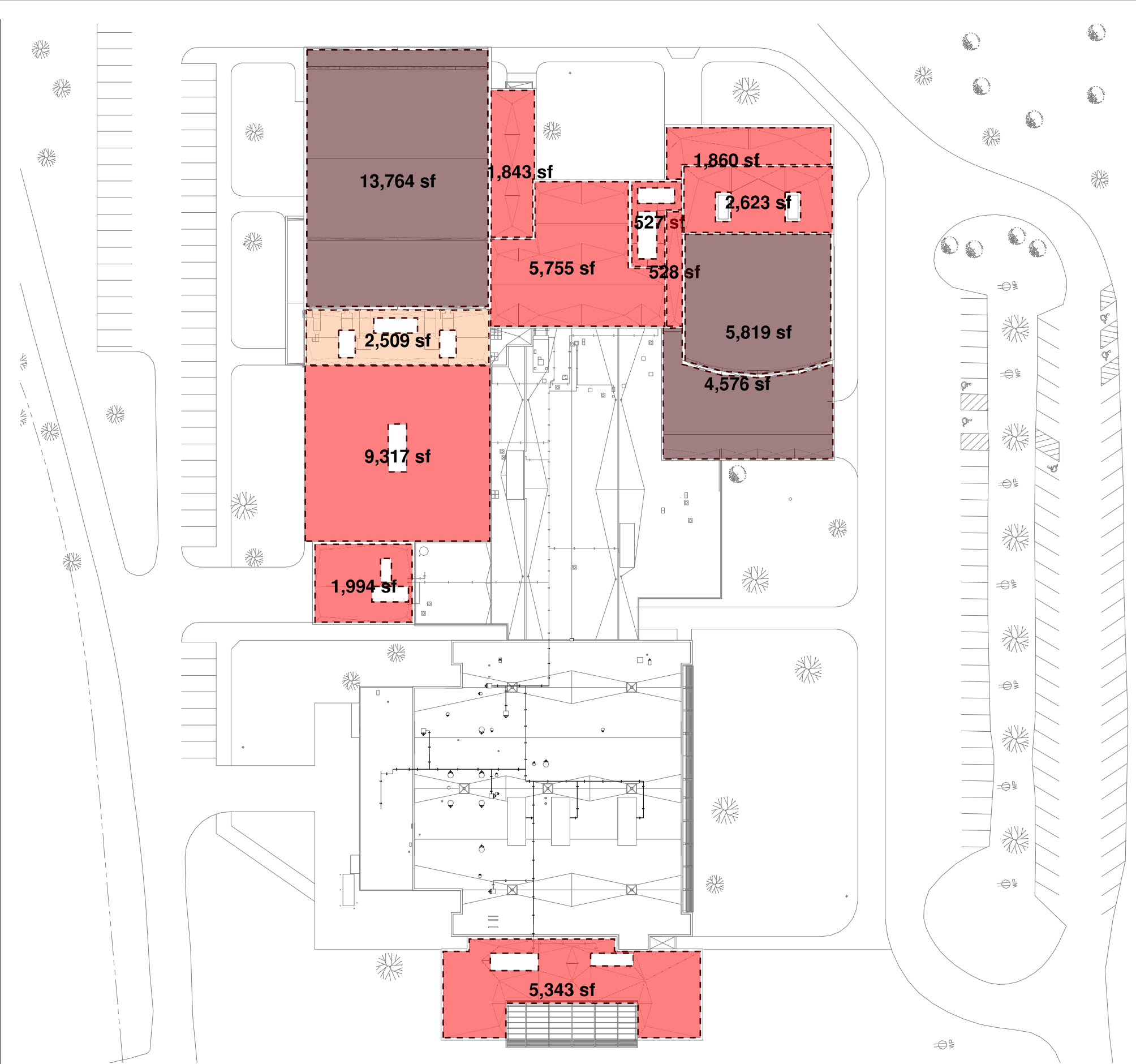

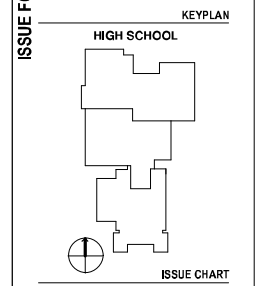

SUBJECT: Multi-Function School Activity Bus Purchase

BACKGROUND DATA: The District currently owns two (2) 1998 Ford Club Wagon 8-Passenger vans. The vans are used primarily to transport smaller teams and individuals for interscholastic activities. For the most part, the vans have not had any major maintenance issues. Mileage on the vans is relatively low for their age at approximately 80,000 miles each. Both vans are inspected at an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) inspection lane every 6 months.

While the vans are still running well, most schools in the area have moved away from vans for interscholastic trips. In July 2003, the National Highway Traffic and Safety Administration (NHTSA) defined a new vehicle type, the "Multifunction School Activity Bus" (MFSAB) which was defined as a vehicle that is sold for purposes that do not include transportation between home and school for pupils from kindergarten through Grade 12. NHTSA promoted this vehicle to serve as a safe choice for institutions, including school districts that have a need to transport groups of people. A particular safety benefit was that the MFSAB was a safer alternative to transporting 11 to 15 passengers instead of the 15 passenger vans that had been used in the past. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), National Association for Pupil Transportation (NAPT) and the National Association of State Directors of Pupil Transportation Services (NASDPTS) believe that school buses may be more expensive than other types of vehicles, but the increased level of safety justifies a higher cost

It should be noted that for non-curriculum activities, the buses can be operated by anyone with a valid driver's license. Curriculum related events (home to school and school to home prohibited) would require a school bus driver permit (CDL) or restricted school bus driver permit (Non-CDL).

With safety in mind, the Administration would like to purchase two multi-function school activity buses via the State of Illinois bid. The cost of a 2020 Chevy 14 passenger TransTech MFSAB with the most popular options is \$55,493. The 14 passenger MFSAB's can be delivered in February 2021.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Based on activities/events where the vans have been used in the past, the cost to transport these students utilizing Westway Coach would be approximately \$20,000 to \$25,000 each year. Thus the break even on purchasing the buses for \$110,986 is a little more than four years. The FY2021 Transportation Fund budget includes a \$100,000 line item for the purchase of two MFSAB's.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approve the purchase of two MFSAB's utilizing the State of Illinois Bid.

SUGGESTED MOTION: That the Board of Education approve the purchase of two multifunction school activity buses from Southern Bus & Mobility at a cost of \$55,493 each as presented on the attached proposal.

BACKGROUND DATA:

The proposed 2021-2022 School Calendar reflects a student start date of Wednesday, August 17, 2022 with the tentative closing of the school year on Friday, May 26, 2023. When viewing this draft calendar please note the following:

- Institute Days and School Improvement/early release days follow a similar schedule and frequency (4 each) as the past few years.
- The Parent Teacher Conference schedule remains unchanged from the past few years.
- Winter break will begin on Monday, December 26th and will conclude on Friday, January 6th. This schedule helps balance student attendance days with 86 days in the first semester and 90 days in the second semester. This balance is a priority for students and staff, especially at the high school.
- Spring break falls in the last week of March with the “spring holiday” scheduled for Friday, April 7th.

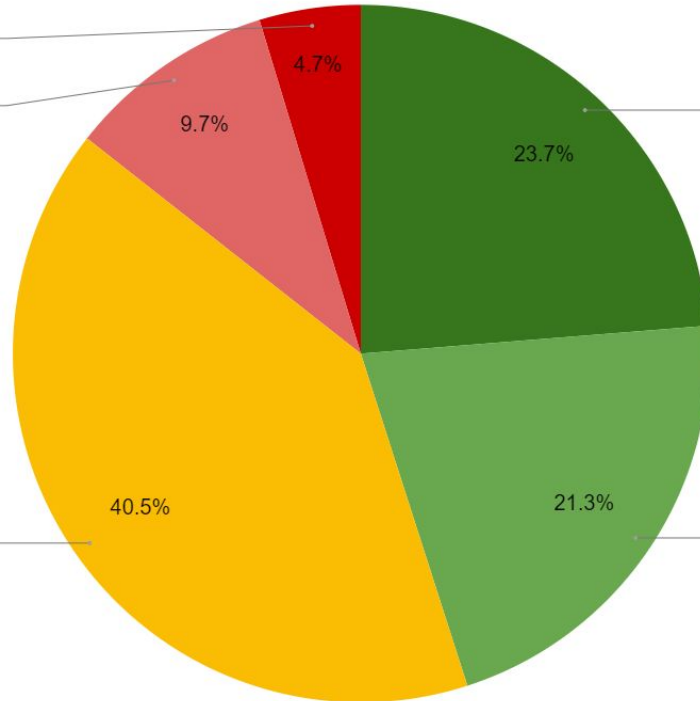

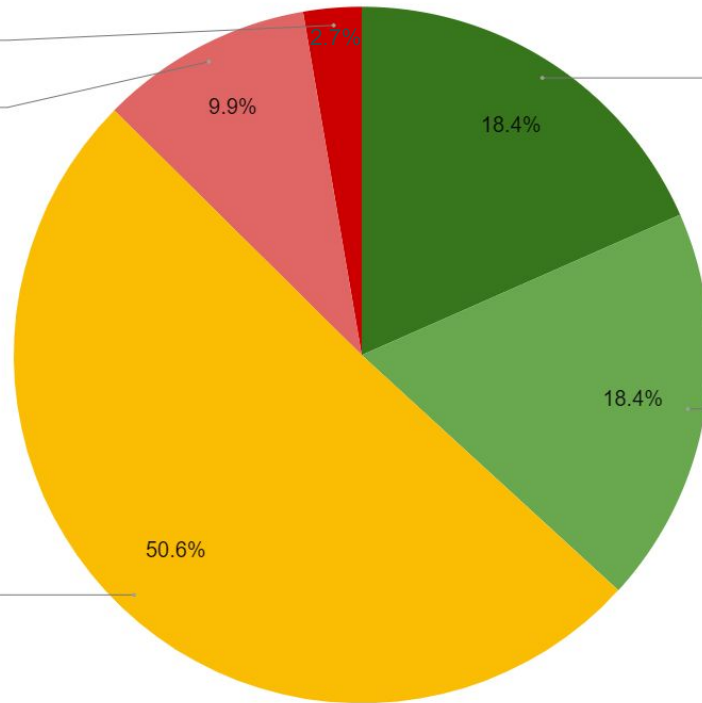

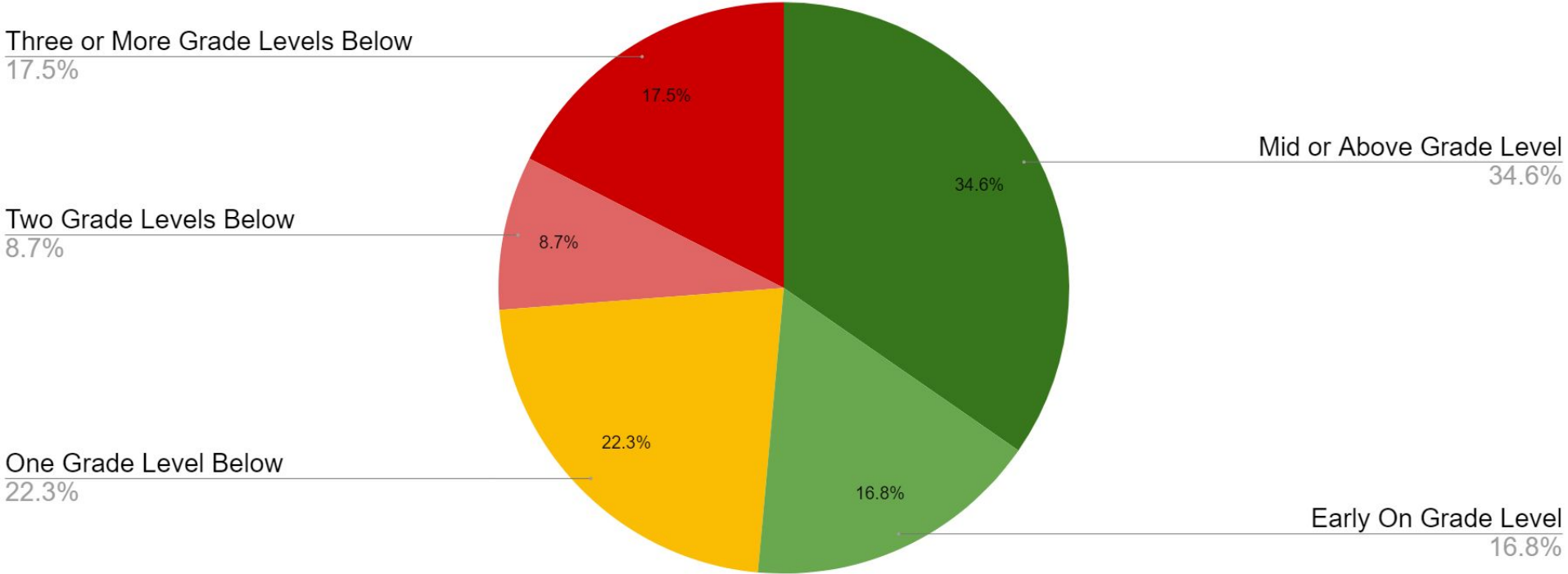

Percent of Students at Each Performance Level

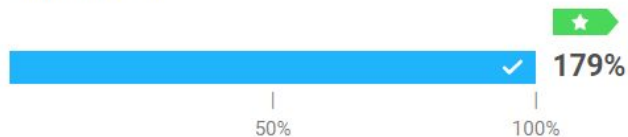

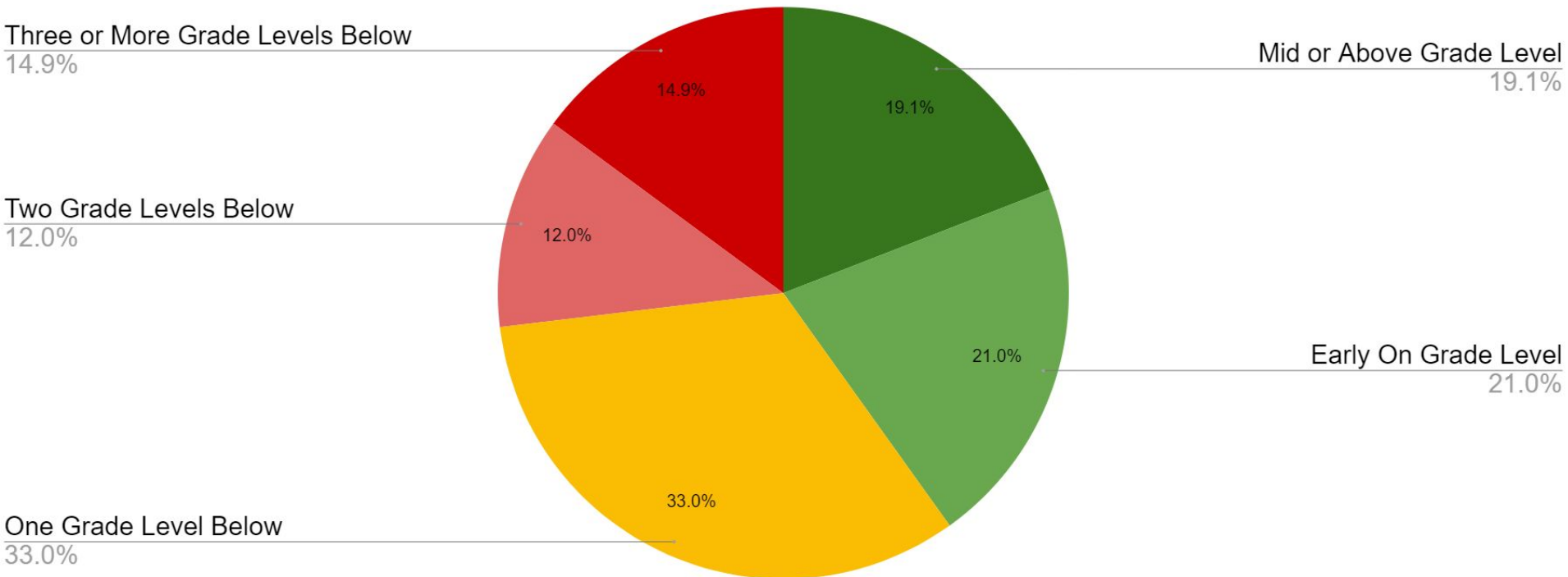

Percent of Students at Each Performance Level

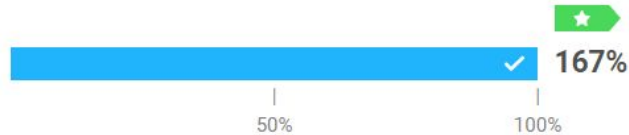

Superintendent's Report – January 2021

Lisle Elementary School - We are pleased to share that at Lisle Elementary School, learning goes on...TOGETHER! The emotional impact of the pandemic has been different for different students and adults. In an effort to support ALL at LES, we have implemented the following:

1. Virtual Buddies - Classrooms are paired to do virtual activities together. For example, a Kindergarten class paired with a 3rd grade class will read books to each other, share their writing, play virtual games, etc... during a defined time that is collaboratively planned by the classroom teachers.
2. Teacher Buddies - The classroom teachers above are also buddied up to support one another, check in with each other and be a friendly support during these times.
3. LES Student Connections - Classroom teachers identified students who just needed a little extra support, time to talk, and/or guidance from an adult. The rest of the staff then chose one of these students to mentor. This adult serves as another school based adult, beyond their classroom teacher, in the life of this child in order to maintain a connection to school. We have 47 students being served by this. The list was filled immediately. Way to go LES teachers!

Lisle Junior High School - Teachers have continued to push themselves as virtual pedagogical trailblazers in order to best engage students in digital and hybrid environments. Teachers have become near experts on navigating Google Meets and have been able to use the new breakout room feature to allow students to collaborate in small groups including analyzing articles and breaking out further to share with classmates.

Students also have designed their own digital lessons to teach classmates about different vocabulary terms; the lessons were uploaded onto FlipGrid in order to allow students to watch and review each other's lessons.

Teachers have also dug in to our newest learning tech tool Kami. Kami allows students to be able to annotate, comment, and record themselves all within a PDF pushed out by the teacher. While more professional learning opportunities are in the works, many teachers and students have eagerly jumped in the sandbox to play and explore Kami and all it can offer.

The amount of learning our staff has done to meet the needs of students is immeasurable. Their dedication to students in these trying times is unmatched. We appreciate their work and are so proud of them.

Lisle High School - On Tuesday, Jan 12th, the Lisle High School DECA students competed in a DECA Sectional vs Elmwood Park, Geneva, and Timothy Christian. They took a content area exam (100 questions) and performed a role play before judges. For the role play, students were presented with a real-world business problem, given 30-minutes to prepare, then presented their solution to the judges.

We are pleased to share that the following students qualified for the State Competition. To qualify, students needed to place in the top 3 in their content area.

Criminal Justice and Police Reform

- HB 3653 (Sims) passed the General Assembly bringing changes to police training policies, police accountability, transparency in law enforcement and the rights of detainees and prisoners.
- There was no inclusion of language to remove SROs from public schools.
- Passed both chambers.

Senator Gillespie presented the Seclusion Time Out Restraint legislation:

Seclusion Time Out Restraint

- The bill passed the Senate but was stalled in the House.
- The sponsors of the bill (Representative Carrol and Senator Gillespie) will move the language again in the spring.
- This is a negotiated bill vetted by special education cooperatives in DuPage.

102nd General Assembly

History was made with the election of a new Speaker of the House. Speaker Emanuel "Chris" Welch takes the gavel as the first Black Speaker of the House ever elected in Illinois. This action ended the historic tenure of now Former Speaker Michael Madigan, as the longest serving speaker in history.

LEND Council Zoom Meeting, Friday, 1/22/2021

LEND welcomed DuPage elected officials for an introduction on what we can expect for the Spring 2021 session.

Both chambers have a full session calendar and new bills are being introduced daily; the Senate will be back 2/8; still meet remotely every week.

- House Republican Leader Jim Durkin - Expressed that any changes to EBF need to come with study and explanations; 300 new bills have already been introduced and probably another 5,000 bills will be coming; State faces a deficit of nearly \$3 billion; Covid has a big impact on all states; budget issues will be massive; hope for bi-partisan agreement on House rules
- Senator John Curran
- Senator Tom Cullerton
- Senator Laura Ellman

- Senator Laura Murphy - Represents mostly Cook county but some DuPage; e-learning will not be the solution; path out will not be additional taxes; hopeful for federal help; not a fan of changing EBF at this time
- Senator Karina Villa - Former elementary teacher; looking at SEL standards with an emphasis on equity; and trauma informed curriculum.
- Representative Amy Grant - Expressed concerns with unfunded mandates; AIM scholarship program formula; and duplication
- Representative Terra Costa Howard - Emphasized the need to tone down rhetoric and lead by example; former school board member; need to represent all not just the vocal minority; let EBF settle before changing; advocate of public education
- Representative Maura Hirschauer
- Representative Seth Lewis - Dedicated to education; focus on getting dollars to students and the learning environment
- Representative Deanne Mazzochi - Concerned that new teacher certifications look more at ideology than experience; will reintroduce unfunded mandates bill; restorative justice needs to focus on behavior in relation to violence; feels Covid vaccine is not a panacea; supports in school learning
- Representative Anne Stava- Murray
- Representative Michelle Mussman - Education Committee - Looking at how to bring in new resources and revenue
- Representative Kathleen Willis - Believes academic equity is critical; spent 12 years on her local school board; early childhood education saves in the long term
- Representative Janet Yang Rohr - Recent D203 school board member; D203 graduate; represents D203, D204 and D200; supported D203 resolutions relating to PTELL and election day as an e-learning day
- Dr. Darlene Ruscitti, DuPage Regional Office of Education - HB 2170; focus on equity in education and recruiting, hiring and retention; "acceleration of learning" rather than "learning loss"; concerns with truancy and language barriers; rise in work permits by 15 year olds; micro-credentials and how to demonstrate competencies.
