Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the School Board of Special School District No. 6 (South St. Paul Public Schools), State of Minnesota, was duly held in the School District on May 20, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. for the purpose, in part, of canvassing its special election.

**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS
OF VOTES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT SPECIAL ELECTION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Special School District No. 6, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the special election of the voters of this School District held on May 12, 2026, was in all respects duly and legally called and held.
2. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, at said election a total of 1,811 voters of the School District voted on the question of authorizing the issuance of school building bonds for a school acquisition and betterment program (SCHOOL DISTRICT QUESTION 1), of which 784 voted in favor, 1,025 voted against the same, and there were 2 completely blank or defective ballots.. Said proposition, having not received the approval of at least a majority of such votes, is hereby declared to have failed.

3. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, at said election a total of 1,811 voters of the School District voted on the question of approving a capital project levy authorization of the School District for taxes payable in 2030 and thereafter (SCHOOL DISTRICT QUESTION 2), of which 833 voted in favor, 975 voted against the same, and there were 3 completely blank or defective ballots. Said proposition, having not received the approval of at least a majority of such votes, is hereby declared to have failed.

4. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the results of the election to the County Auditor of each county in which the School District is located in whole or in part and to the Commissioner of Education.
