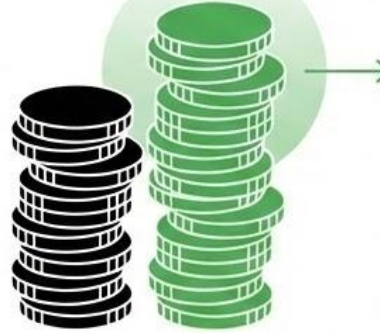

8. HVAC / Ventilation Issues – 4 mentions

(Cold classrooms, inconsistent temps, ventilation fixes, air filters)



9. Playground Improvements – 4 mentions

(Mat surface completion, inclusive equipment, retaining wall, landscaping)



10. Music Room / Fine Arts Renovation – 3 mentions

(Band/Choir renovation, soundproofing, music suite expansion)



11. Athletic Facilities Improvements – 3 mentions

(Bleachers, press box, discus cage, fencing)



12. Tennis / Pickleball Courts – 3 mentions
