**Goal I: Increase academic achievement by strengthening educational programs for all students:**

- AP English 3 students are presenting pros and cons of research topics. Students are interacting with the presenter through Q&A. They will begin working on Annotated Bibliography and understanding the importance of sources. AP English 4 students will finish medieval literature through scoping a small Middle English poem. They will move on to Elizabethan literature. However, they have also begun researching Non-American poets from any era to turn into a research project at another date. English III students have just begun exploring the literature of the Romantic Era. At the same time, they are researching argumentative topics to understand the research process for higher level papers.
- Students in Entrepreneurship are learning about the similarities and differences between contract and employment law. The protections it gives them as an employer and an employee.
- Biology is finishing up a unit on cell environments and will be studying photosynthesis and cellular respiration after Thanksgiving.
- Ms. Rosillo's College Transition is learning the differences between high school and college. Geometry is working on classifying triangles, applying Triangle Angle-Sum Theorem, Exterior Angle Theorem, starting two column proofs, then we will move to proving triangles are congruent. TSI Pullouts started...in Mrs. Rodriguez' algebra 2 class. We're about to start project based learning. Mr. Lugo's Algebra 1 is learning about scatter plots and is will start working on solving inequalities. Mu Alpha Theta will had 10 members participating in the Veteran's Day program as well as hosting Math Fun Day at the Elementary School on Friday, November 12th. Moulton's College Prep Math classes are manipulating Formulas and calculating BMI and BAC. Pre-Calculus is studying Polynomial Functions and their graphs. Math of Models is struggling to solve systems by elimination and Honors Algebra 2 is starting Quadratics after mastering Systems using four methods.



