## Instructional Focus: Data Informs Instruction

As we've completed our first 6 weeks, leveraging data from Renaissance Star, mClass, and DRA (Developmental Reading Assessment), has been crucial for tailoring early literacy instruction. These assessments have provided valuable insights into each student's reading levels, comprehension skills, and phonemic awareness. By analyzing this data, we are able to identify students' strengths and areas needing support, allowing for the formation of targeted small groups. Students with similar reading challenges can be grouped together for focused instruction on specific skills, while those who are more advanced can engage in enrichment activities that foster their growth. This data-driven approach ensures that instruction is both relevant and responsive to the diverse needs of learners.

Similarly, using Renaissance Star data for planning math instruction is essential for effective differentiation. This assessment offers a comprehensive view of students' mathematical understanding, helping teachers pinpoint specific areas where students may struggle or excel. By organizing students into small groups based on their math proficiency levels, educators can provide targeted interventions for those who need additional support while challenging more advanced learners with complex problem-solving tasks. This strategic use of data not only enhances student engagement but also promotes a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts, ultimately setting the stage for success in future learning.

The collaboration among our teachers and support staff is vital for maximizing the impact of data-driven instruction, and our PLCs play a key role in this process. By engaging in regular data dives during PLC meetings, our teachers have collectively analyzed the results from our beginning of year assessments. This collaborative approach encourages the sharing of insights and strategies, allowing educators to identify trends, discuss effective practices, and brainstorm innovative solutions to support their students' diverse needs. By working together, our teachers have developed coherent, evidence-based instructional plans that align with their students' needs and goals. This ongoing dialogue not only fosters a culture of continuous improvement but also enhances accountability and support among colleagues, ultimately leading to more effective teaching and improved student outcomes.

Our PTO held their second meeting with many in attendance. They've provided lots of treats and snack for teachers and staff, as well as collaborated with us to plan for future events and fundraisers. We are thankful our amazing PTO is working with both the Primary and Elementary campuses with great success.

# AHS Board Report September 2024

## **Math Dept**

- Algebra 1 has just finished learning about functions and equations in one variable. We will now be starting domain and range before we go into linear equations.
- Honors Algebra 2 has just finished learning about Absolute Value Functions, Equations, and Inequalities.
- In Geometry, we just finished our unit on Transformations. We are starting our unit on Parallel and Perpendicular Lines.
- Algebra 2: We are currently working on inequalities including absolute value. Students will be testing over the intro to inequalities first before moving on to graphing linear and absolute value inequalities. From there we will discuss transformations on a graph of absolute value functions.
- Algebraic Reasoning: Students will be tested over absolute value and literal equations. They also have learned how to solve multi-step inequalities and graph them on a number line. Once we complete testing we will move on to solving absolute value inequalities and graphing,
- Math of Models: Students have gone over linear equations and functions this six weeks. We are completing the unit by doing a project over linear functions, how to collect data and use that data for real world application
- College Prep Math is working on percent change.
- College Algebra Prep is on Linear Application Problems and solving equations with Fractions.
- Precalculus just tested over Continuity and the types of discontinuities, and also End Behavior as a Limit.

## **ELA Dept**

- The English Department had a productive PLC meeting on Thursday 9/19. We discussed how best to utilize the Savvas Textbook in order to benefit our student population. We are excited to be attending Professional Developments that will further enable us to address the needs of our "bubble students." Our goal is to better equip ourselves to address the needs of our students with various learning needs and styles.

## **Science Dept**

- In Chemistry, we are currently exploring Unit 3: Changes in the Nucleus. This unit covers topics such as electrons, the electromagnetic spectrum, and nuclear chemistry.
- In Biology, we are concluding our unit on ecosystems and transitioning into a study on the importance of biodiversity. To enhance this learning experience, students will embark on a field trip on Wednesday, September 25th, to observe native birds in the SETX area. Each student has been assigned a common local bird species to identify during the trip and will be responsible for presenting their findings to the class.

## **CTE**

### **Digital Arts and Animation:**

In Digital Art and Animation we are finishing up a unit on graphic design careers and the skills and education needed to be successful in these types of careers. Soon we will be designing or remaking our own board games using the skills we have acquired over the 1st six weeks.

### **Business:**

BUSIM - Resumes, Cover Letters, spreadsheets introducing formulas, students created slideshows showcasing the new businesses they would like to see in Anahuac since it is growing.

PRINBMF - Creating business cards, mission statements for our classes, designing a cost analysis for Mr. Cook's poster printer (how much to charge per request), Business Management scenarios, business letter written as a thank you letter to a teacher leader, counting cash money back "old school" way.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP - Developing an entrepreneurial mindset, thinking like an entrepreneur, creating slideshow highlighting one entrepreneur, creating presentations about a real world problem students would like to fix or change, remembering to always think outside the box.

### **Culinary:**

Introduction to Culinary Arts students just completed their food safety unit and are ready to get hands-on in the kitchen.

Advanced Culinary Arts students have successfully explored, researched and cooked foods from a variety of global cuisines including France, Japan, and the Middle East.

Food Science students investigated the purpose of sanitation in commercial kitchens through experiments in which they grew bacterial cultures and are now exploring the world of sensory evaluation and taste test panels used by companies to predict success rates of new food products.

### **Anatomy:**

Anatomy students just finished their unit on body systems and locations, regions, and terminology of anatomy. The next chapter will cover the chemistry of the body, cells, and tissues.

### **Forensic Science:**

Students finished 2 chapters over observation and perception and how it applies to crime scene investigation and how to process a crime scene while collecting and securing the evidence. The next chapter will cover hair analysis.

### **Clubs & FFA**

- The Anahuac FFA officer team recently attended the District Leadership Camp, where they sharpened their leadership skills, networked with fellow FFA members, and participated in workshops aimed at building teamwork and enhancing their ability to serve the chapter. The camp provided a great foundation for the upcoming school year, helping officers gain valuable insights into planning events, communicating effectively, and fostering a positive environment for all members. Bentley Abshier represented the Anahuac FFA chapter as the Ricebelt District President!
- Upon returning, the officer team hit the ground running by hosting our first FFA meeting of the year, which featured a dodgeball theme! 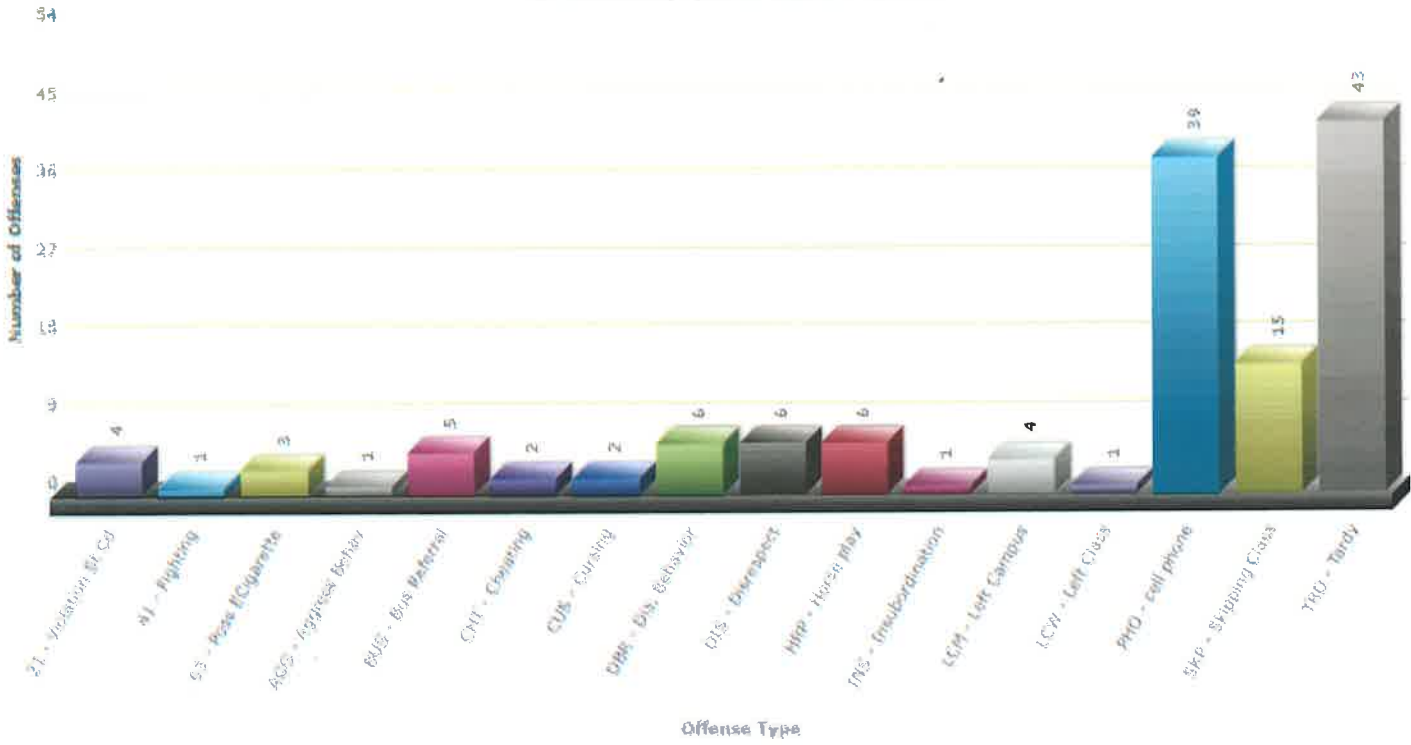
