**RESOLUTION OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION
OF THE ANAHUAC INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

WHEREAS, Anahuac Independent School District (“AISD”) has a substantial public interest to protect the health and safety of its students, staff and community;

WHEREAS, in the event school facilities and/or equipment are damaged or undergo operational failures as a result of an unforeseen catastrophe or emergency, Section 44.031(h) of the Texas Education Code authorizes the Board of Trustees to determine that the delays posed by competitive procurement laws would prevent or substantially impair the conduct of classes or other essential school activities;

WHEREAS, a chiller waterline overhead burst at AISD’s Anahuac Middle School, causing damage to school facilities and equipment; and

WHEREAS, AISD Board Policy CH (Local) states, “In the event of a catastrophe, emergency, or natural disaster affecting the District, the Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to contract for the replacement, construction, or repair of school equipment or facilities in accordance with law, if emergency replacement, construction, or repair is necessary for the health and safety of District students and staff;” and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent made the emergency purchase of goods and services to restore and repair the damage to Anahuac Middle School and to protect the health and safety of AISD students and staff.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of AISD formally declares that (1) the bursting of the chiller waterline overhead constitutes an unforeseen emergency; (2) the delays posed by competitive procurement of contracts necessary to restore and repair Anahuac Middle School will prevent or substantially impair the conduct of classes or other essential school activities; and (3) ratifies the purchases made by the Superintendent that were necessary to remediate the damage caused by the emergency.

No Dielectric Unions on 18 Fan Coil Units (FCUs)*



- Insulate dissimilar metals to prevent galvanic corrosion.
- Often used to connect copper to iron pipe.
- Prevent corrosion and deterioration.
- Corrosion resistant and lead free.

* FCUs are 25+ years old and have been very well maintained

Biofouling in the Chilled Water Loop

- The discoloration on the pipe insulation indicates bio fouling in the water
- In a chilled water loop, biofouling refers to the undesirable accumulation and growth of microorganisms (like bacteria, algae, and fungi) on surfaces, forming biofilms.
- Microorganisms in the system can reduce heat transfer efficiency, clog pipes, and promote corrosion

Building Controls

- Antiquated Andover Continuum Controls no longer have support from manufacturer (gradually phased out – 2004)
- Known for communication problems with BacNet (communication protocol for building automation and controls systems)
- Currently displaying several alarms and communication errors that cannot be addressed by maintenance staff

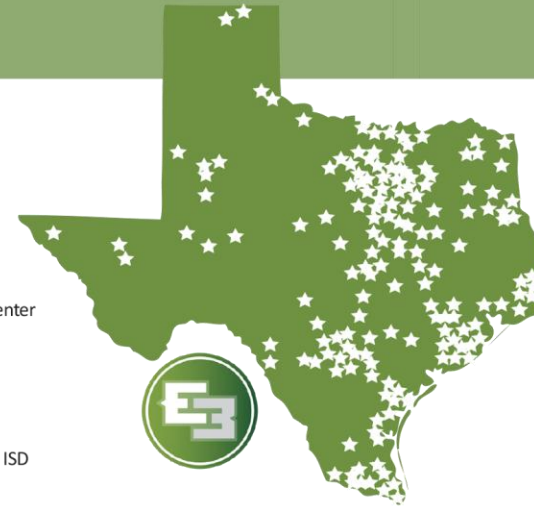

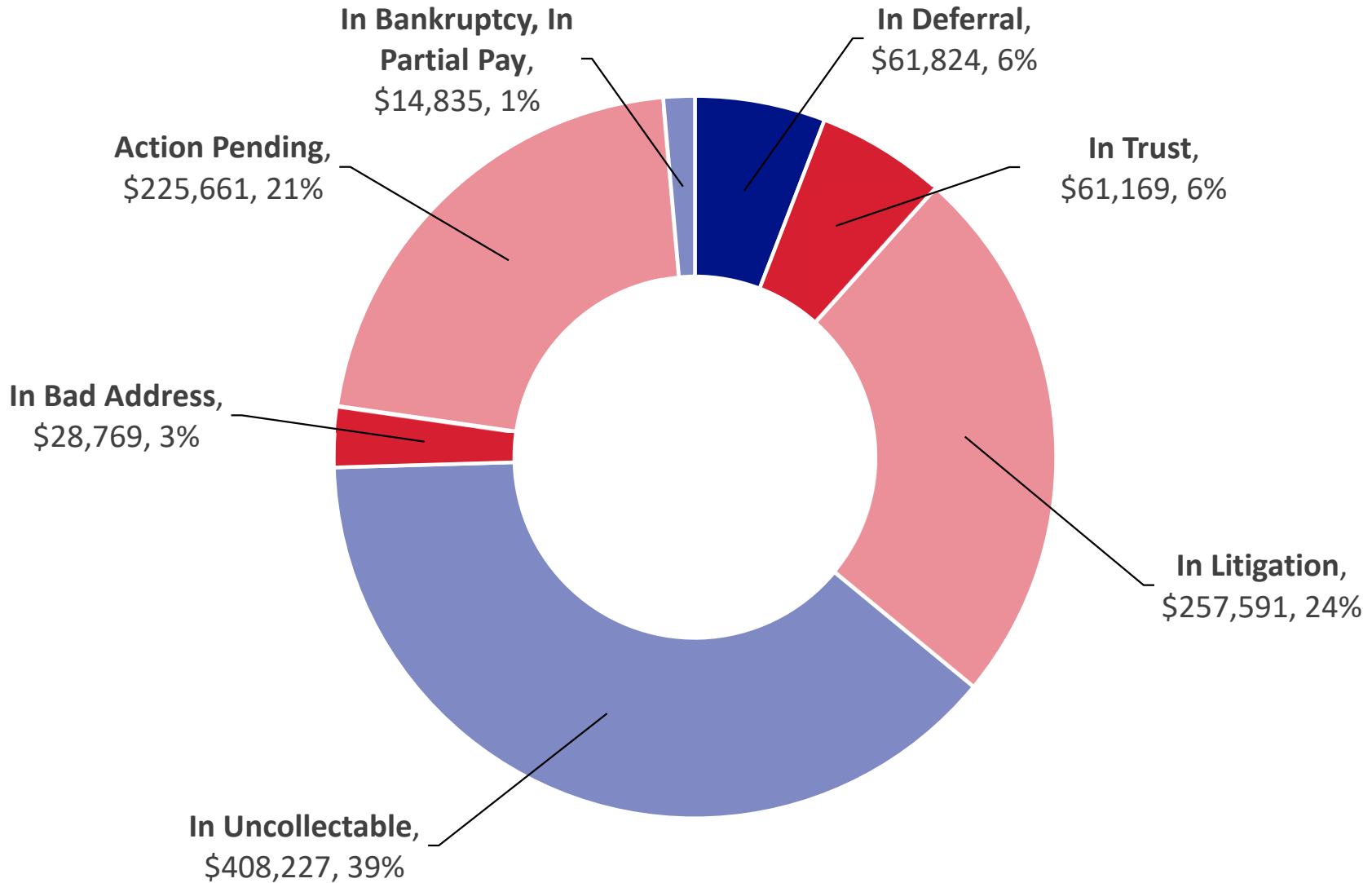

ACCOUNT BREAKDOWN CHART FOR ANAHUAC ISD

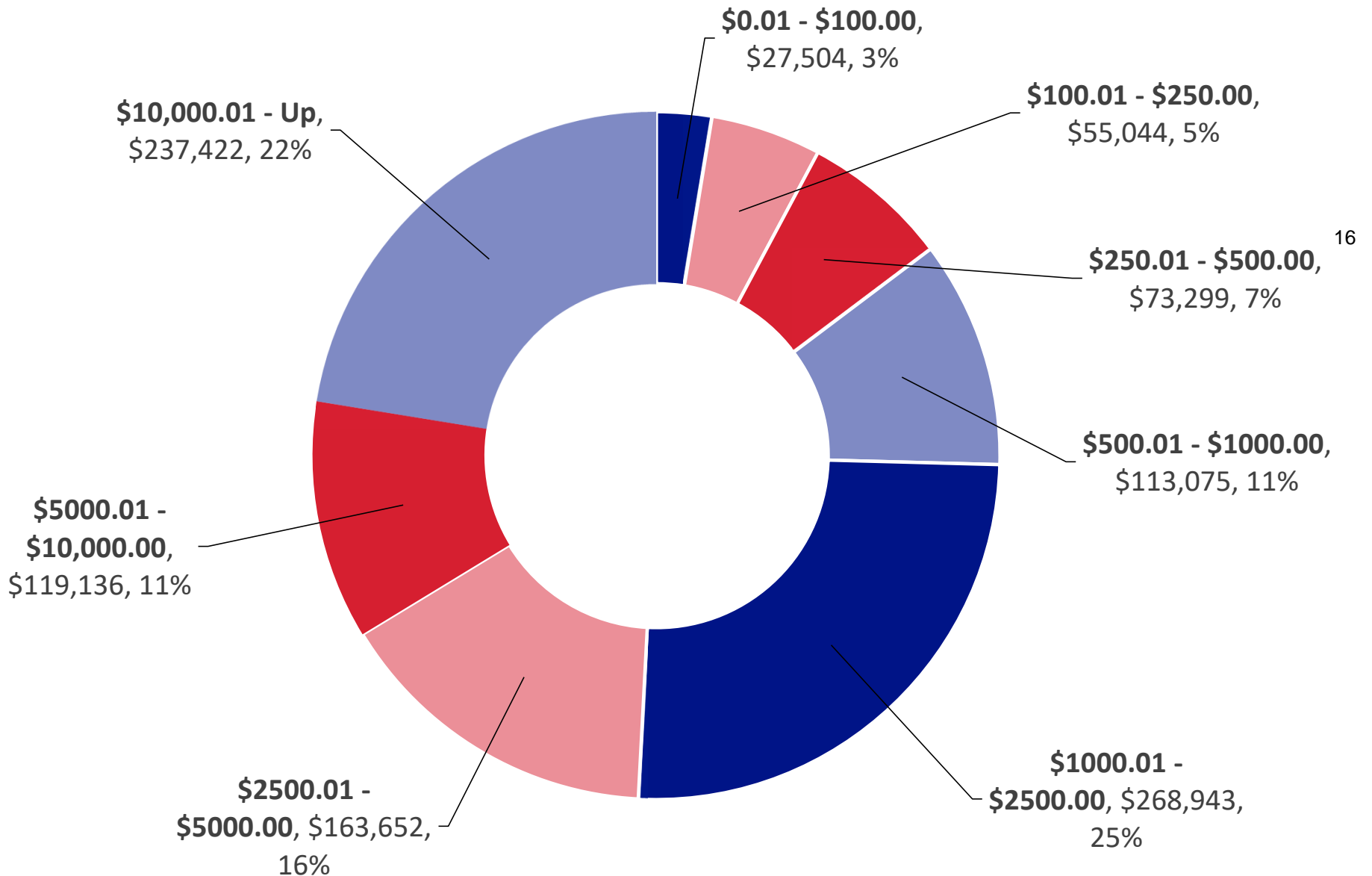

DOLLAR RANGE CHART FOR ANAHUAC ISD

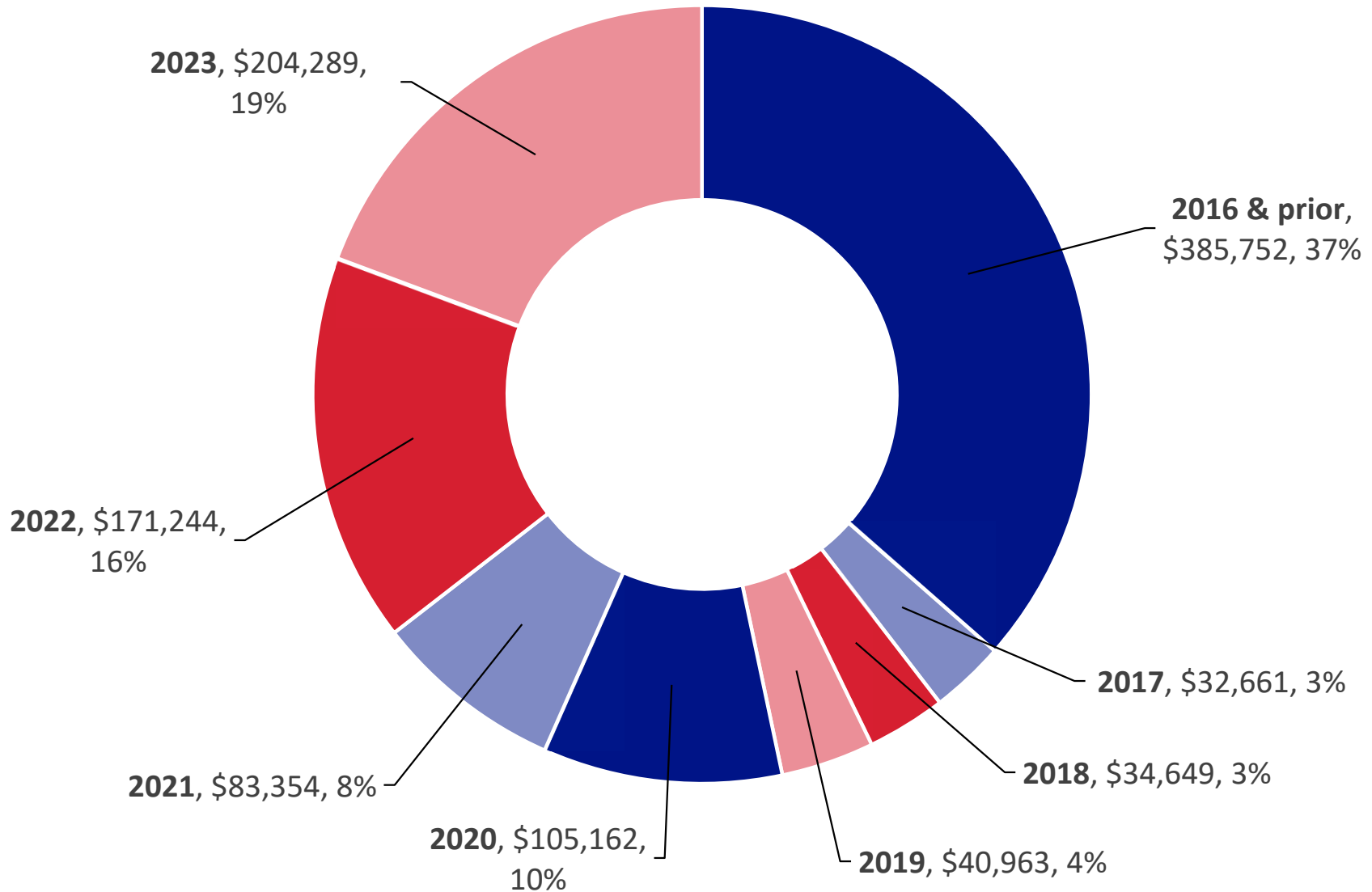

TAX YEAR CHART FOR ANAHUAC ISD

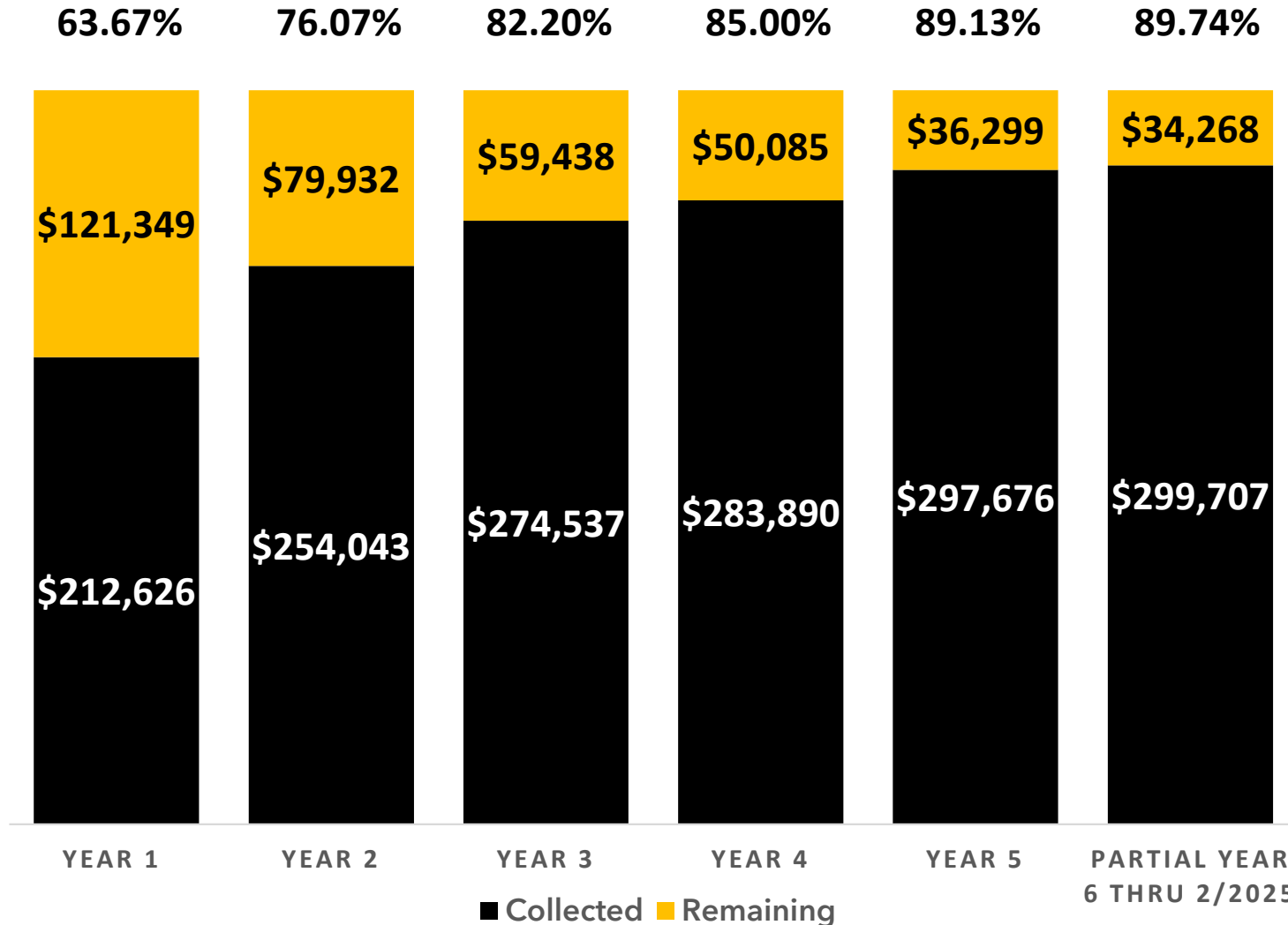

2018 PERCENTAGE OF COLLECTION FOR ANAHUAC ISD

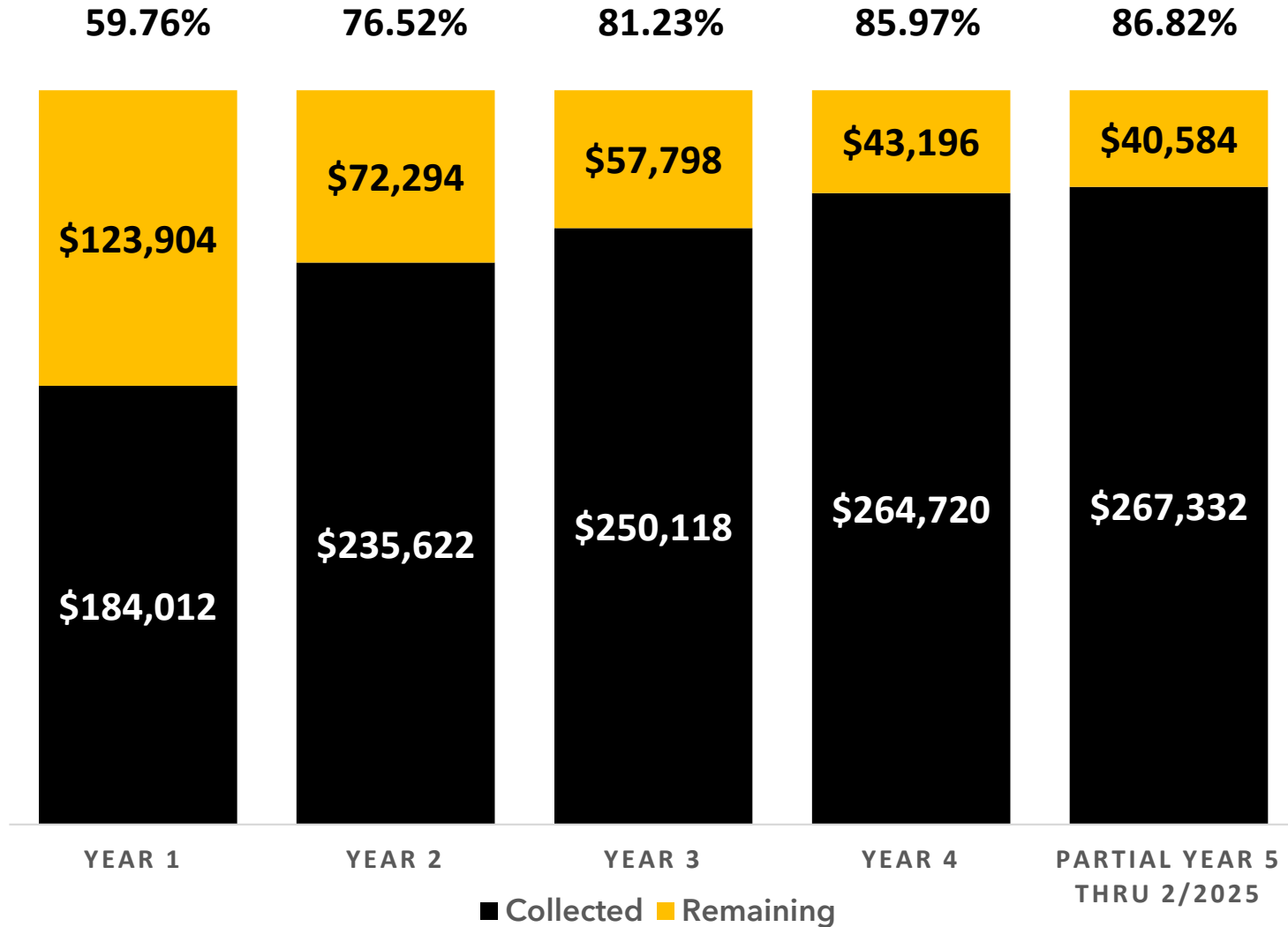

2019 PERCENTAGE OF COLLECTION FOR ANAHUAC ISD

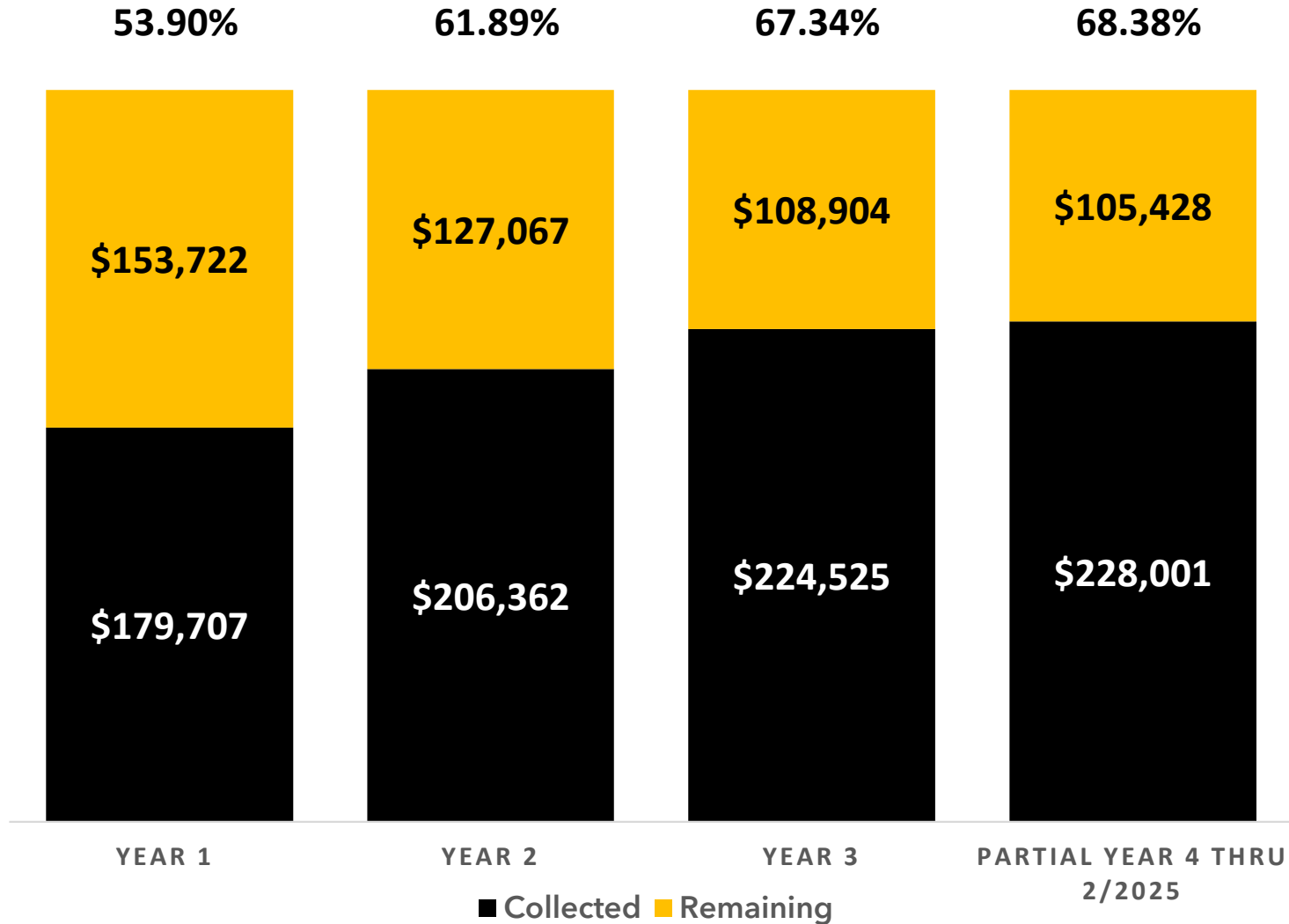

2020 PERCENTAGE OF COLLECTION FOR ANAHUAC ISD

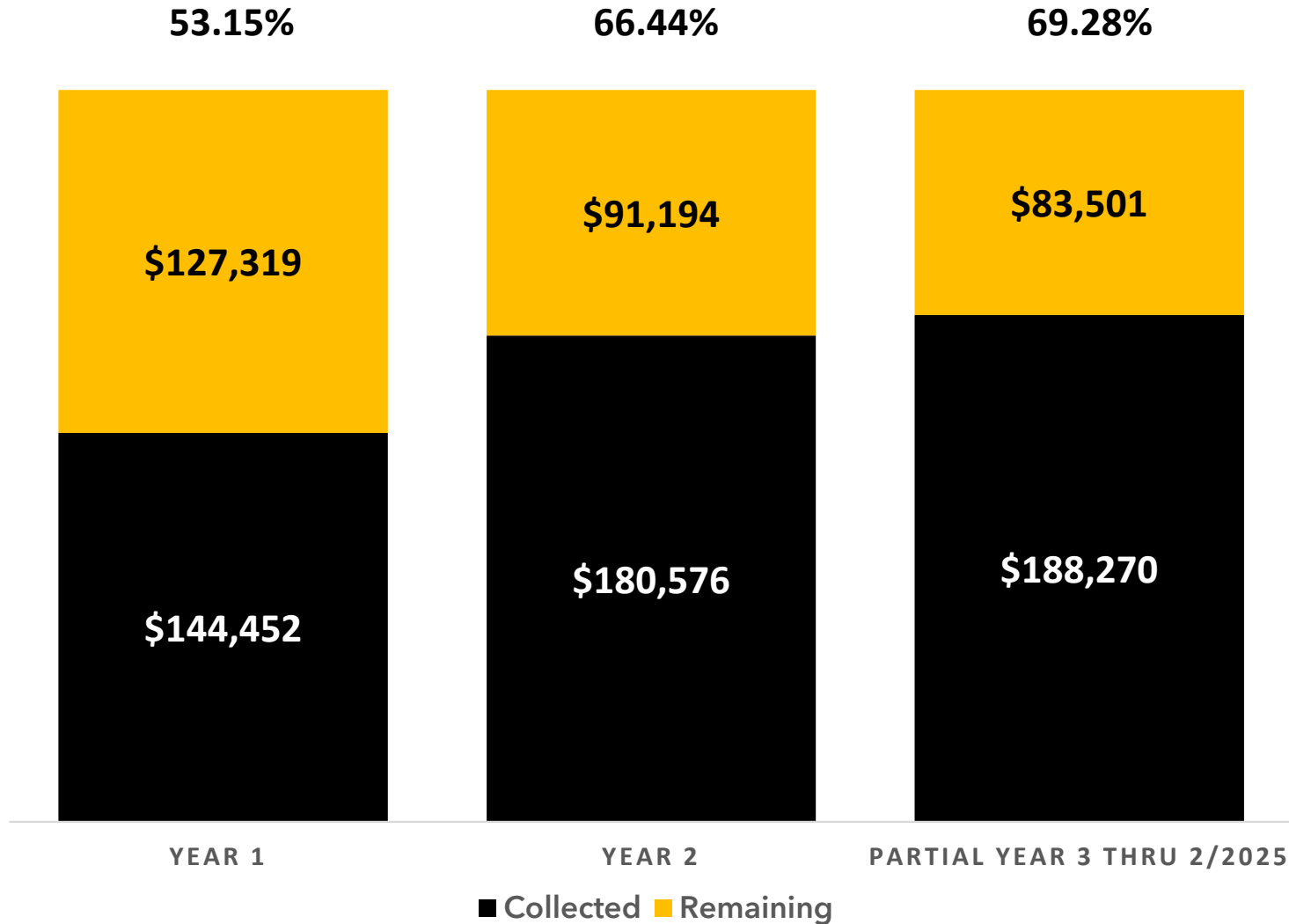

2021 PERCENTAGE OF COLLECTION FOR ANAHUAC ISD

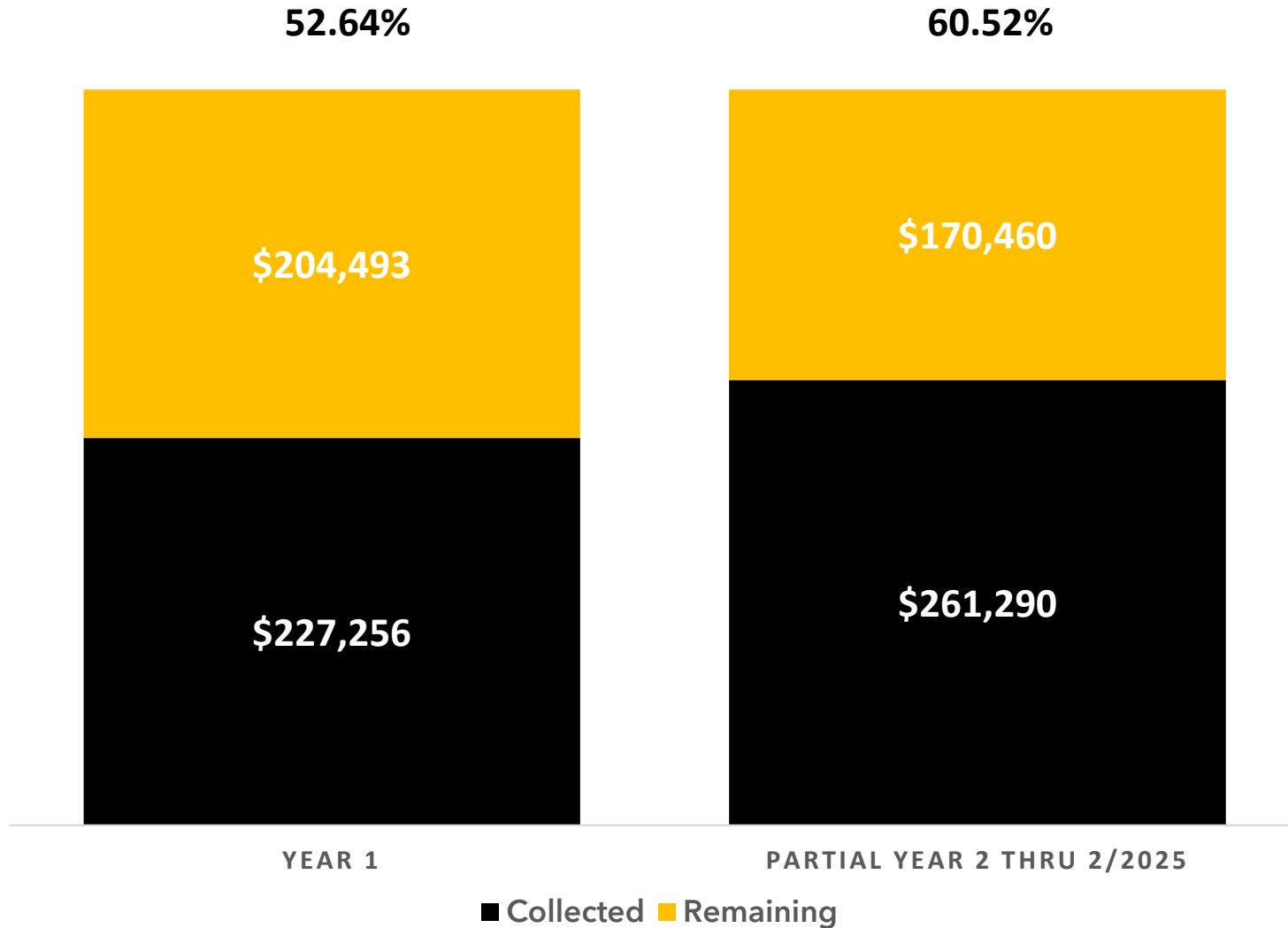

As of 07/01 - 6/30 for each year - Initial Outstanding Base Tax \$431,749

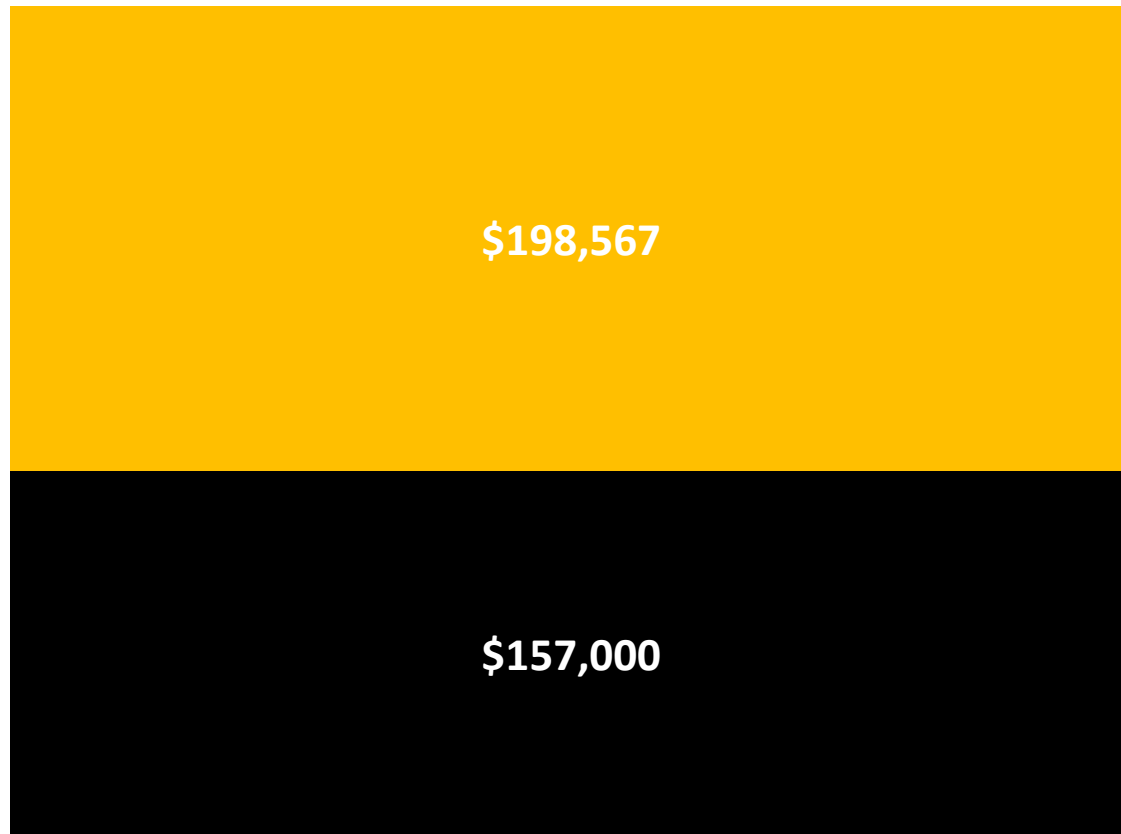




2023 PERCENTAGE OF COLLECTION FOR ANAHUAC ISD

ELA Dept

- Beginning STAAR Reviews.

Math Dept

- Algebra 1 is now starting to review for the upcoming STAAR test. Also reviewing testing strategies on how to write equations and then how to solve them
- Honors Algebra 2 is wrapping up square roots and cubic roots. We will then move on to Rational Functions
- Geometry is working on three dimensional figures. We are beginning Volume and Surface Area this week. Next week, we will wrap up our unit on Perimeter, Area, and Volume. Then, we will begin Probability to start the month of April.
- Algebraic Reasoning is working on Exponential Functions and plans to work on Monomials next. Math of Models are learning about their credit scores and then they will do a project called "Paying for College".
- Algebra 2 is working with complex numbers learning about the pattern of four, how to do the basic operations of math with these complex numbers.
- College Prep Math is getting ready to test over Linear versus exponential functions and their applications.
- Precalculus is working on the Law of Sines and Cosines in order to solve any triangle. Finally our dual credit class Math 1314 is wrapping up the chapter over exponential and logarithmic functions. We will be starting sequences and series next concentrating on Arithmetic and Geometric sequences.

Science Dept

- Biology is currently working on the unit titled "Evidence of Evolution," covering the following TEKS: B.9.A, B.9.B, B.10.A, and B.10.C. Students will participate in two engaging labs aligned to these standards:
 1. Peppered Moth Natural Selection online simulation.
 2. Peppered Moth Natural Selection group activity.
- Chemistry is progressing through Unit 9: Acids and Bases, addressing TEKS C.12B, C.12C, C.12D, and C.12E. Students will write an evidence-based essay, selecting their own topics that connect acids and bases to real-world applications. This essay aligns horizontally with English 2 requirements, providing preparation for the upcoming English 2 STAAR assessment.
- Physics is exploring Unit 10, which emphasizes Thermochemistry, specifically addressing TEKS C.13B, C.13C, and C.13D.

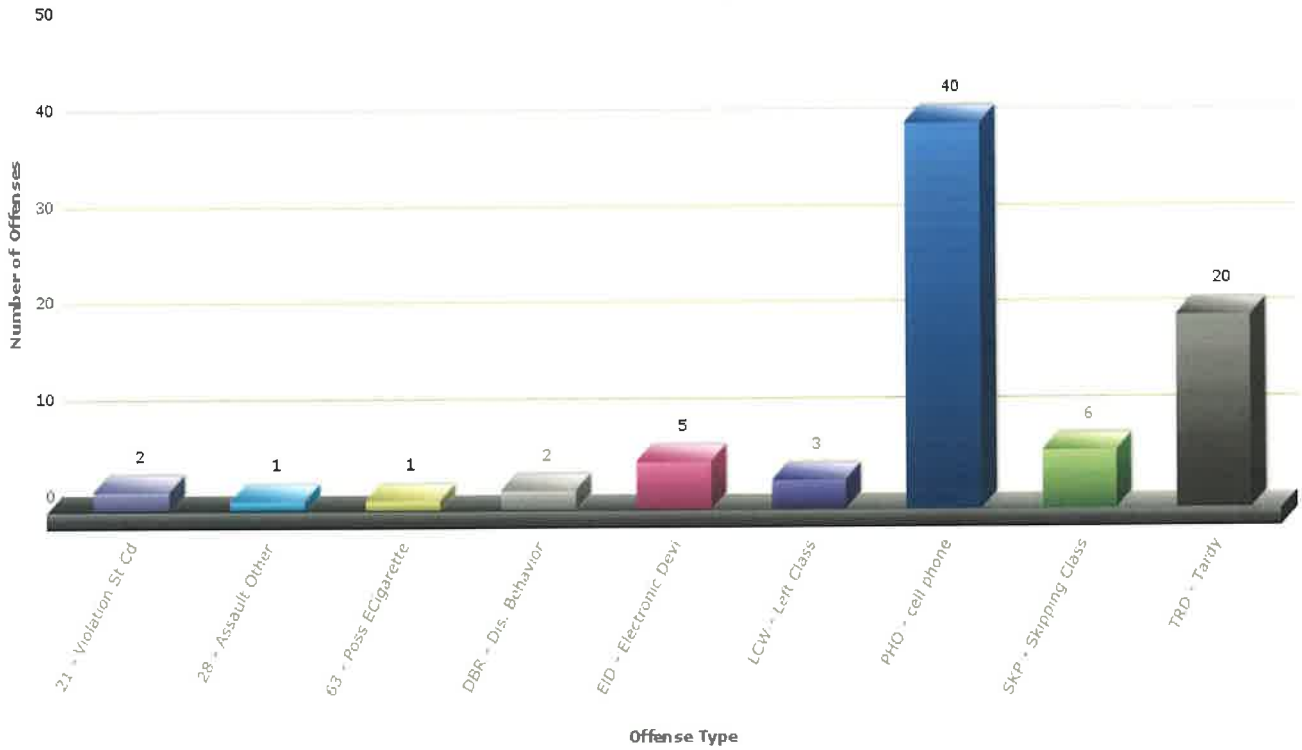

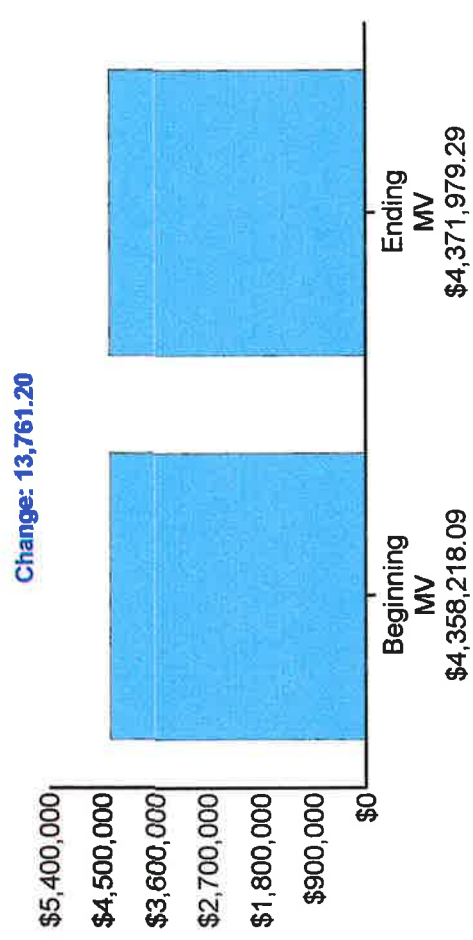
