The results will be entered into our John Wink spreadsheets, allowing us to closely analyze student performance and identify specific standards and skill gaps prior to the upcoming STAAR administration. This targeted data will help teachers refine instruction and focus intervention efforts where they are most needed.

In addition, all students have completed the middle-of-the-year NWEA assessment. We are using this data to make informed, data-backed decisions regarding RTI placements and individualized student interventions, ensuring that students receive the appropriate level of academic support.

## Principal for the Day

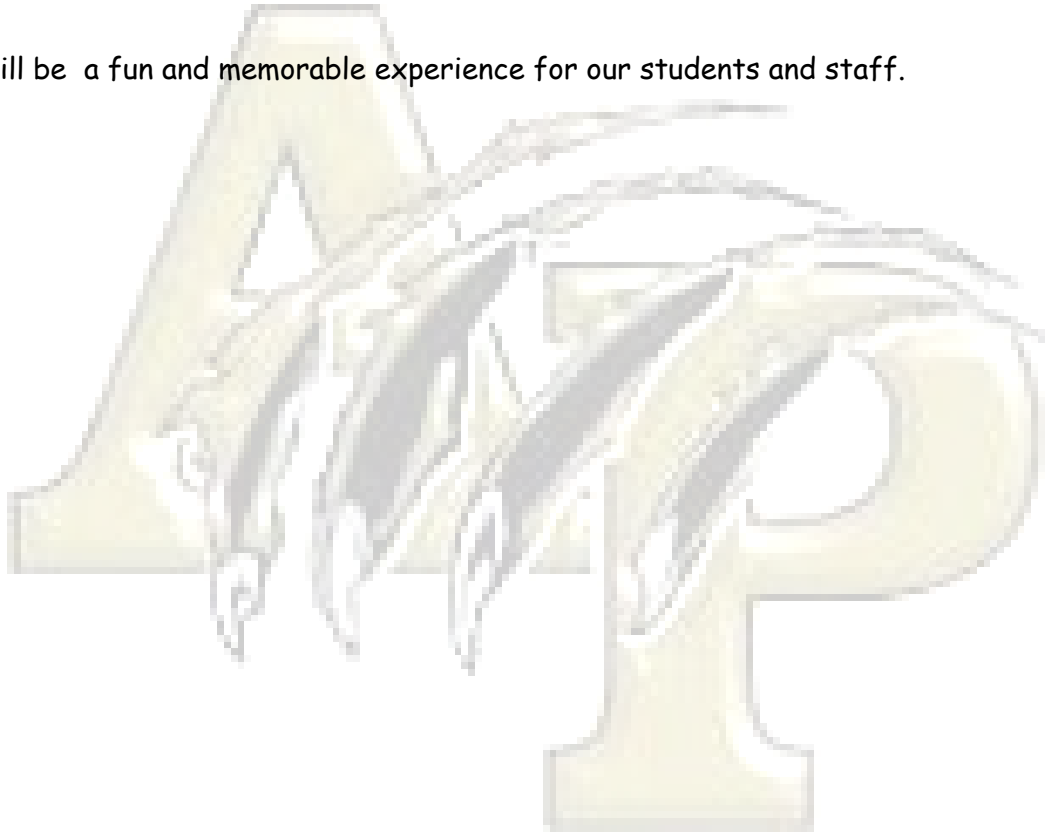

## **ELA Dept**

- English I and English II teachers attended the Lead4ward Rockin' Review for STAAR, which proved to be very insightful and beneficial, offering new and engaging strategies for reviewing with our students.
- English II Honors- students are beginning a persuasive writing project not only to prepare for STAAR but also to persuade Mrs. Green to approve their participation in a field trip to the 26th Annual Food Show and Tasting. Students will compose essays convincing the principal to grant permission and will subsequently write reviews of the food options.
- English III: Concluding *The Great Gatsby*, students will create one-pagers that reflect the historical context of the 1920s, incorporating themes of the Jazz Age, the American Dream, social class, and post-World War I values as they appear in the novel.
- English IV: Currently reading *Macbeth* by William Shakespeare, which reflects the historical and cultural context of medieval Scotland and the Jacobean era. Students will analyze how Shakespeare develops themes such as ambition, power, fate, and the divine right of kings, and how these ideas relate to the time period in which the play was written, as well as their relevance today.

## **Math Dept**

- Algebra 2 is completing our unit over solving quadratic equations by factoring then getting into radical functions.
- Math Models is going over data and statistics currently discussing theoretical versus conditional probability and will end the unit with a project pertaining to probability.
- Algebra 1 is finishing the factoring unit and we will then learn about quadratic equations. Students are also prepping for the STAAR by doing STAAR questions warm-ups everyday to help review the fall semester material
- Algebraic Reasoning is wrapping up the polynomial unit and tying it to real word examples of how computers use polynomials. The next unit is rational equations.
- Geometry is beginning a unit on right triangles and trigonometry.
- College Prep Math is reviewing the Personal Finance chapter where they are calculating compound interest on savings and loans.
- Precalculus is about to test over the Six Trigonometric Ratios including application problems.
- College Algebra is getting ready for Exam #1 which includes functions, solving all types of equations from linear and quadratic to rational equations and radical equations, transformations of functions and function compositions.

## Social Studies

- The Social Studies Department is engaging in real world applications and learning about great things! In World Geography students have been discovering the European continent and its countries. Next week they will move into North Africa.
- World History sophomore students are learning about the Mongols and Japanese Medieval History.
- U.S. History our junior students are finishing up how the United States fought and won the 2nd World War against the Axis powers in Europe and Japan. Next they will be introduced to what led to the Cold War Era and how the United States fought to preserve democracy amidst the threat of nuclear war and the spread of communism globally.
- Economics seniors participated in a project creating their own businesses including using cost analysis to determine the supply and demand curve and the optimum price for one of their products or services. Moving forward, students have been differentiating between supply and demand curves while analyzing the role of substitutes, complements, and consumer preferences. The next lesson is how to file income taxes as a real world application.

## Science Dept

- **Biology-** Mrs. Perez recently attended the Lead4Ward Rockin' Review to help better prepare students for the upcoming STAAR exam in April. The conference provided a variety of engaging, hands-on strategies and a clear framework for a 10-day STAAR review plan. These new methods will be implemented in class to support student understanding and confidence. The conference was extremely valuable and is highly recommended for any teacher looking to increase student engagement, not just those teaching STAAR-tested subjects.
- **Forensics-** Forensics students are finishing the blood and blood spatter unit and will begin the toxicology unit. During the blood spatter unit, students created their own blood spatter patterns to compare how force, height, and distance affect cast-off patterns. They also recreated famous crime scenes by producing detailed crime scene sketches that included a legend, compass rose, and precise measurements. These activities helped students better understand how evidence is documented and analyzed in real investigations.
- **Chemistry-** Chemistry students are currently working through the stoichiometry unit, where they are learning how to track and count matter using balanced chemical equations. This unit focuses on understanding how reactants and products relate to each other, including concepts such as limiting reactants, mass relationships, and percent yield. Students are applying math skills like ratios and conversions while building a strong foundation for future chemistry topics through hands-on labs and real-world applications.
- **Physics-** Physics students are currently in the current electricity unit, where they are learning how electrical energy moves through circuits. Students are designing and building series and parallel circuits, identifying key components such as voltage, current, and resistance, and using Ohm's Law to calculate electrical properties. The unit emphasizes hands-on learning as students analyze circuit behavior, troubleshoot designs, and connect classroom concepts to real-world examples like household wiring and everyday electrical devices.

## CTE

- ENTRE 2 - 3 students are preparing to compete in DECA state 2/19-2/21 in Dallas. In the classroom, students are focused on studying for and passing their IBC exam related to Entrepreneurship/Small Business, study materials are uploaded. Official testing will begin after spring break.

- **CHILD DEVELOPMENT & HUMAN GROWTH and DEVELOPMENT-** Students are learning about milestones among the JH and HS ages (12-19). Differentiating the milestones between physical, emotional, social, moral, and cognitive. They will prepare presentations and lessons related to the different milestones, including what excessive screen time does to children at this age. Students will also design their own toys and games that do not involve screens.
- **PRINCIPLES OF EDUCATION** - The Panther Buddies mentorship program planned out the best way to begin a small garden, as instructed by The Giving Field. We are scheduling a date in February to visit APS again to interact/work with the mentees. In the classroom, students are learning about special education, ARD's, IEP's, and completing a Misunderstood Minds Project in which they each take a disability, educate the class about it, including a simulation for others to learn what it's like to live with said disability.

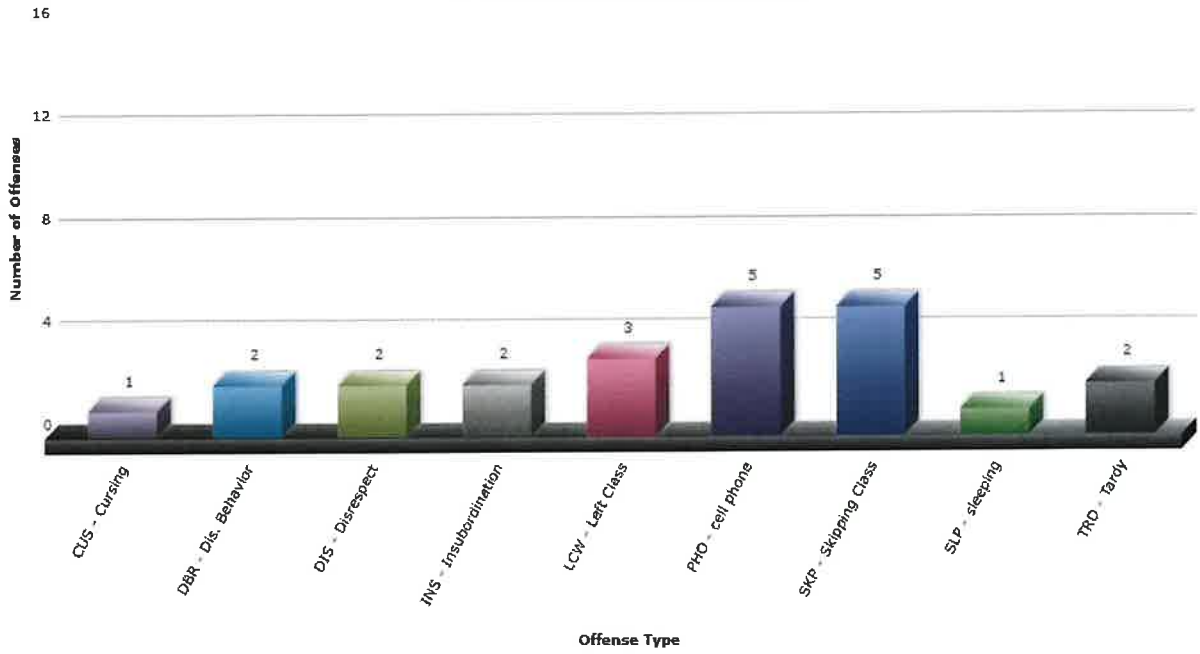

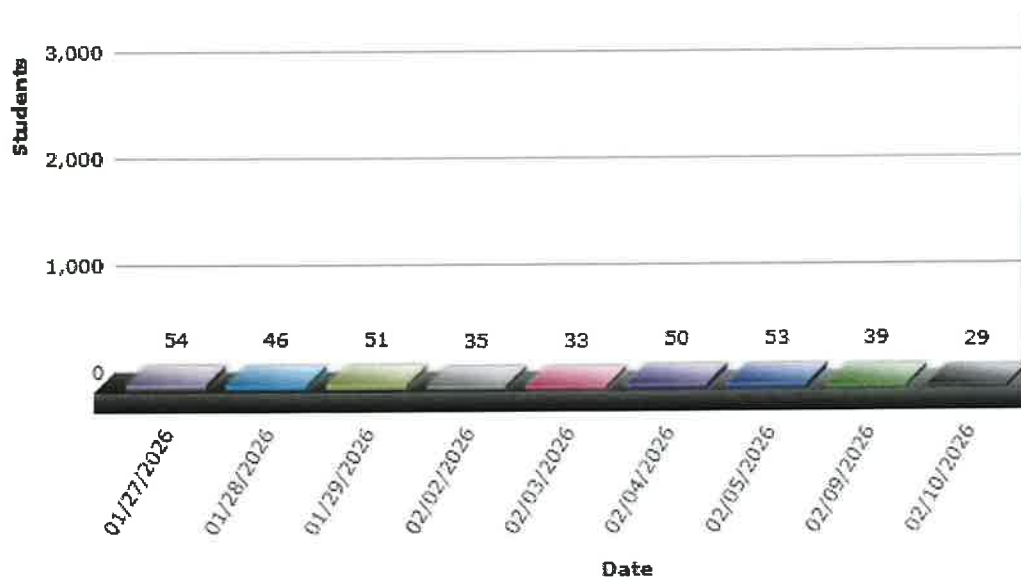

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
ANAHUAC INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
REGARDING SENTATE BILL 11**

**WHEREAS**, the 89<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature enacted Senate Bill 11, adding Texas Education Code § 25.0823, which permits a school district’s board of trustees, by a recorded vote on a specified resolution, to adopt a policy requiring each campus to provide an opportunity for students and employees to participate in a daily period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious texts, subject to statutory conditions;

**WHEREAS**, Texas Education Code § 25.082 already requires every campus to provide a one-minute period of silence each school day following the pledges to the United States and Texas flags, during which each student may reflect, pray, meditate, or engage in other silent activity not likely to interfere with others;

**WHEREAS**, the Anahuac Independent School District (the “District”) Board of Trustees (the “Board”) recognizes and reaffirms the rights protected by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution—including the Free Exercise Clause, the Establishment Clause, and the Free Speech Clause—which together protect private religious expression while prohibiting government establishment of religion in public schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to reaffirm its commitment to respect and safeguard the personal religious liberty of students and staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ANAHUAC INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:**

1. Pursuant to Texas Education Code § 25.0823, the Board has considered whether to adopt a policy creating a daily period for prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious texts and hereby declines to adopt such a policy;
2. The Board reaffirms the District’s commitment to the First Amendment rights of students and staff, including their rights to the free exercise of religion and to engage in private, voluntary religious expression consistent with law;
3. The Board reaffirms its view that decisions regarding religious belief, expression, and practice are inherently personal matters best left to individuals and their families, and not to the Board of Trustees or the District. The Board believes its proper role is to respect and protect the constitutional rights of all students and staff by maintaining a neutral environment in which individual freedom of conscience is preserved.

4. The District shall continue to comply with Texas Education Code § 25.082 by: (a) providing the pledges of allegiance to the United States and Texas flags once each school day at each campus; and (b) observing a one-minute period of silence immediately following the pledges, during which students and staff may, at their choice, reflect, pray, meditate, or engage in other silent, non-disruptive activity; and
5. Nothing in this Resolution limits or abridges any right of students or employees under the United States Constitution, the Texas Constitution, or applicable state and federal law regarding voluntary religious expression in public schools.

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 23rd day of February 2026, at Anahuac, Texas, by and between the ANAHUAC INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT of Chambers County, Texas, acting by and through its duly elected Board of Trustees, hereinafter called LESSOR, and Kevin Clanton, of Chambers County, Texas, hereinafter called LESSEE (*LESSEE must be an employee of Anahuac ISD*)

1. LESSOR hereby leases to LESSEE, and LESSEE hereby leases from LESSOR, that certain and real property, hereinafter called the Leased Premises, situated in Chambers County, Texas, and described as follows, to-wit:

School Rent House – 702 Willcox St., Anahuac, Texas

2. The term of this Lease shall be for a period of twelve (12) months, hereinafter called the Lease Term, commencing on March 1, 2026, and ending on June 30, 2026; subject however, to earlier termination as hereinafter more particularly provided.

3. For and during the term of this Lease, LESSEE shall pay to LESSOR as rent for the Leased Premises the total rent of \$7,500.00, payable as follows:

The sum of \$625 per month; to be deducted from the LESSEE's monthly paycheck beginning March 10, 2026 and a like payment being deducted each month succeeding thereafter during the term of this lease.

4. The Leased Premises are to be used as a single family dwelling house and directly related activities.

5. LESSEE shall not commit, or allow to be committed, any waste on the Leased Premises, create or allow any nuisance to exist on the Leased Premises, or use or allow the Leased Premises to be used for any unlawful purpose.

6. LESSEE shall pay all utilities furnished the Leased Premises for the term of this Lease, including electricity, gas, water, sewer, cable T.V., and telephone services.

7. LESSOR shall be responsible for maintenance of the dwelling. LESSEE, however, shall reimburse LESSOR for the cost of any maintenance due to the neglect of LESSEE. This shall include maintenance due to (but not limited to) clogged sewer lines, dirty air conditioner filters, and damage done by pets or children.

a. Any alteration or addition to the premises shall become the property of Anahuac ISD.

b. LESSEE shall not make any improvement to the above without obtaining written approval from ANAHUAC ISD Maintenance Director.

8. LESSOR represents that the premises are in fit condition for LESSEE'S use as described herein. LESSEE agrees to accept the premises on possession as being in a good state of repair and in sanitary condition. LESSEE agrees to surrender the premises to LESSOR at the end of the Lease Term, if the Lease is not renewed, in the same condition as when LESSEE took possession, allowing for reasonable use and wear and damages by act of God, including fire and storms. LESSEE herein agrees that LESSOR may determine the amount of deposit to be retained for damage to the premises which are not normal wear and tear. LESSEE also agrees that retention of the deposit in no way limits LESSOR's right to pursue further payment for damages that exceed the amount of the deposit.

9. LESSEE agrees not to assign or sublease the Leased Premises, or any part thereof, or any right or privilege connected therewith or to allow any other person, except LESSEE'S family, to occupy the premises or any part thereof, without first obtaining the LESSOR'S written consent. LESSEE'S interest in this Lease is not assignable by operation of law, nor is any assignment of their interest herein, without LESSOR'S written consent.

10. If LESSEE breaches this Lease, LESSOR shall have the following remedies in addition to other rights and remedies, and in such event:

- (a) LESSOR may reenter the premises immediately and remove all of LESSEE'S personal property immediately therefrom. LESSOR may store the property in a public warehouse or at another place of LESSOR'S choosing at LESSEE'S expense or to LESSEE'S account.
- (b) After reentry, LESSOR may terminate this Lease on giving ten (10) days' written notice of such termination to LESSEE.
- (c) After reentering, LESSOR may relet the premises or any part thereof, for any term, without terminating this Lease at such rent and on such terms as LESSOR may choose. LESSOR may make alterations and repairs to the premises at LESSEE'S expense.
- (d) Under the above, LESSEE is liable to LESSOR in addition to LESSEE'S other liability for breach of this Lease for all expense of the reletting, and of the alterations and repairs made, which LESSOR may incur. In addition, LESSEE is liable to LESSOR for the difference between the rent received by LESSOR under the reletting and the rent installments that are due for the same period under this Lease.
- (e) LESSOR at LESSOR'S option may apply the rent received from reletting the premises as follows:
  - (i) To reduce LESSEE'S indebtedness to LESSOR under this Lease, not including indebtedness for rent;
  - (ii) To expenses for the reletting and alterations and repairs made;
  - (iii) To rent due under this Lease;
  - (iv) To payment of future rent under this Lease as it becomes due.

11. This Agreement shall be construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and all obligations of the parties created hereunder are performable in Chambers County, Texas.

12. This Agreement shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns except otherwise expressly provided herein.

13. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

14. This Agreement constitutes the sole and only agreement of the parties hereto and supercedes any prior understanding or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting the within subject matter.

15. If any action at law or in equity, including an action for declaratory relief, is brought to enforce or interpret the provisions of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees from the other party, which fees may be set by the Court in the trial of such action or may be enforced in a separate action brought for that purpose, and which fees shall be in addition to any other relief which may be awarded.

16. LESSOR'S waiver of breach of one covenant or condition of this Lease is not a waiver of breach of others, or of subsequent breach of the one waived. LESSOR'S acceptance of rent installments after breach is not a waiver of the breach, except of breach of the covenant to pay the rent installment or installments accepted.

17. This Agreement and all other copies of this Agreement, insofar as they relate to the rights, duties, and remedies of the parties, shall be deemed to be one agreement. This Agreement may be executed concurrently in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

18. Unless otherwise provided herein, any notice, tender, or delivery to be given hereunder by either party to the other may be effected by personal delivery in writing or by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, and shall be deemed received as of mailing to the addresses listed below:

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
ANAHUAC INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Anahuac Independent School District Board of Trustees recognizes that the territory included in the Anahuac Independent School District (“AISD” or the “District”) was recently under a winter storm with extreme freezing weather, causing icy conditions and risking lack of power and to citizens’ homes and school property;

WHEREAS, effective January 24, 2026, the Chambers County Judge declared a local state of disaster based on the imminent threat of severe damage and injury of loss of life or property resulting from winter weather, freezing temperatures, and frozen precipitation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to cooperative efforts with state and local officials to prepare for and attend to the severe winter weather and the related infrastructure issues, and in consideration for the safety of employees and their families, AISD was closed on January 26, 2026;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of AISD believes there is a public purpose in paying employees for one missed workday on January 25, 2026 (“Missed Day Pay”), which will not be made up as instructional days or additional time worked; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the District finds that the public purposes to be served by paying employees for the Missed Day Pay and not made up because of the severe winter weather and related infrastructure issues, include the equitable treatment of all employees which provides for enhanced employee morale and increased retention, reduction in turnover, reduction in unemployment claim exposure, ensuring the safety of all employees and their families and fair treatment of employees who could not work due to the District’s cancellation of the school day.

IT IS THEREFORE:

RESOLVED that the Board finds a public purpose is served by this Resolution as stated above;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Anahuac Independent School District, in accordance with Board Policy DEA (LOCAL), hereby authorizes the administration to compensate employees who were unable to work on January 26, 2026, the District was closed due to severe winter weather, infrastructure issues and hazardous road conditions and to ensure the safety of its employees and their families according to the duty schedule they would normally work (“Missed Days Pay”);

FURTHER RESOLVED that, implementation of this Resolution and applicability to each employee shall be at the discretion of the Superintendent or his designee.
