Mike Joynt will serve as Interim Director of Teaching & Learning for the 2022-2023 school year. In this role, Mike will build on work he implemented as Principal of Shorewood Intermediate School for the past seven years, including a co-teaching service model to address the needs of students with disabilities, integrated social-emotional learning curriculum, and culturally relevant teaching practices.
