Instructions for certification of unopposed candidates:

The authority responsible for preparing the ballot must certify the unopposed status to the authority responsible for ordering the election. This document is filed with the presiding officer of the political subdivision. The governing body must meet, accept this certification, and issue an order or ordinance declaring the election cancelled and the unopposed candidates elected. To complete the cancellation process, a copy of the order or ordinance canceling the election must be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used in the election. See sample Order of Cancellation and outlines for additional instructions.

An election* may be cancelled if:

- 1) The election is one in which a declaration of write-in candidacy is required; and
- 2) No opposed at-large race is on the ballot* within that election;*and
- 3) Each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot* is unopposed, with some exceptions;

This means:

- In an all at-large election* (with no single-member districts), if there is one or more opposed at-large races, then all the races go on the ballot within that election.*
- In an election* in which any members of the governing body are elected from single-member districts, an election in a particular district may be cancelled if the candidate is unopposed and the election otherwise meets the above requirements (i.e., there is no at-large opposed race on the ballot).

Note: A general election (for full terms) or a special election (to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term) is considered a *separate election* with a *separate ballot* for purposes of these tests, even if held on the same election date. See our online Cancellation guide for details.

- *En una elección* por acumulación (sin ningún distrito con miembro único), si se encuentra una o más de una carrera por acumulación con oposición, entonces todas las carreras estarán en la boleta dentro de esa elección*.*
- *En una elección* en la que cualquiera de los miembros de la entidad gobernante se eligen de distritos con un solo miembro, se puede cancelar una elección en un distrito específico si hay oposición para el candidato y la elección cumple con los requisitos que anteceden (ej. no hay oposición para la carrera por acumulación en la boleta).*

Baird ISD is committed to maintaining a professional, student-centered environment and to complying with all applicable provisions of the Texas Education Code, Board policy, and other legal requirements governing employee conduct, instructional practices, and prohibited diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) duties.

Attached to this correspondence is an Administrative Procedure regarding Employee Conduct, Instructional Requirements, and Prohibited DEI Duties. The purpose of this Administrative Procedure is to supplement existing Board policy and establish the notification and enforcement procedures required by Texas Education Code §§ 11.005(c) and 28.0022(h).

This Administrative Procedure applies to district employees and, as applicable, contractors, vendors, service providers, and other individuals performing services or duties on behalf of Baird ISD. All individuals associated with the district are expected to familiarize themselves with the requirements applicable to their role and to conduct themselves accordingly.

The district takes its legal and ethical responsibilities seriously. Compliance with applicable law and Board policy is essential to protecting our students, supporting our employees, and maintaining the trust of our families and community. Questions regarding the Administrative Procedure or its application should be directed to the appropriate district administrator.

Please review the attached Administrative Procedure carefully and ensure that your actions and responsibilities are consistent with its requirements.

Baird ISD Administrative Procedure

Compliance with Texas Education Code §§11.005(c) and 28.0022(h)

Purpose

Baird ISD is committed to complying with all applicable provisions of the Texas Education Code regarding employee conduct, instructional requirements, and prohibited diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) duties. This administrative procedure supplements Board policy and establishes the notification and enforcement procedures required by Texas Education Code §§11.005(c) and 28.0022(h).

Applicable Board Policies

This procedure is implemented in conjunction with the following Board policies, as adopted and amended:

Employee and Contractor Expectations

District employees and contractors shall not intentionally or knowingly:

1. Engage in or assign duties prohibited by Texas Education Code §11.005.
2. Engage in instructional practices or assign activities prohibited by Texas Education Code §28.0022.

3. Direct another employee or contractor to engage in conduct prohibited by either statute.

All employees and contractors are expected to comply with applicable state law, Board policy, administrative regulations, and directives issued by the Superintendent.

Reporting

Any employee who becomes aware of conduct that may violate these requirements should promptly report the matter to his or her immediate supervisor or another appropriate administrator. Reports will be reviewed promptly and, when appropriate, investigated in accordance with District procedures.

Investigation and Discipline

The Superintendent or de Employee Signature Date

signee shall investigate reports of alleged violations.

If it is determined that an employee or contractor intentionally or knowingly violated Texas Education Code §§11.005 or 28.0022, the District may impose appropriate disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment or termination of the contractual relationship, consistent with Board policy, applicable law, and the employee's due process rights.

Employees shall be given all procedural protections required by law and Board policy.

Notification

The District shall provide each employee and contractor with both electronic and physical access to:

- This administrative procedure;
- Applicable Board policies; and
- Any future revisions required by law.

Notification shall occur:

- Upon initial employment or execution of a contract;
- At the beginning of each school year; and
- Whenever these procedures are materially revised.

The Human Resources Office shall maintain documentation that employees and contractors have been notified of these requirements.

Responsibility

The Superintendent is responsible for implementing this procedure and ensuring District compliance with Texas Education Code §§11.005(c), 28.0022(h), and 39.008.

Proposed Library Purchase List (SB 13, 2025)

Summary of Law

Texas Senate Bill 13 (2025) requires school boards to adopt policies governing the acquisition, review, and reconsideration of library materials. Key requirements include:

- Board adoption of an acquisition policy (fulfilled by EFB(LOCAL)).
- Public posting of proposed purchase or donation lists at least 30 days prior to Board action.
- Board approval or rejection of proposed lists in an open meeting.
- Efficient parental access to library catalogs and the ability to restrict their child's access to specific titles.
- Procedures for formal challenges and appeals of library materials.
- Compliance with standards established by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission, including prohibitions against harmful or pervasively vulgar materials.

District Policy

Baird ISD updated and adopted EFB(LOCAL) on July 31, 2025 to comply with SB 13. This policy:

- Establishes collection development standards and goals.
- Defines procedures for recommending and procuring library materials, including the requirement that the Board approve proposed lists in open meeting.
- Requires the initial posting of proposed purchase lists at least 30 days before the Board takes action.
- Provides parents with catalog access and the ability to restrict their child's selections.
- Establishes procedures for informal and formal challenges, including use of the TEA form and challenge committees.
- Requires restricted access to challenged materials during review and provides for Board appeals.
- Sets expectations for ongoing collection maintenance, review, and compliance with state law.

Current Status

Tonight's agenda item fulfills the requirement for initial posting of the proposed library purchase list. The list has been made publicly available in accordance with SB 13 and EFB(LOCAL) and is also posted on the District's website for community review. Formal Board action to approve or reject the list will occur at the next regular meeting following the 30-day posting period.
