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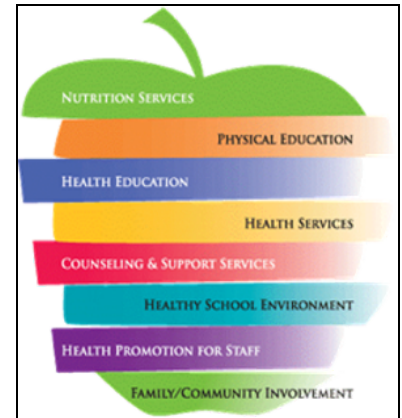

3. Food Services Update

Presenter: Brandon Carroll

Brandon Carroll shared an update on the progress that has been made on implementing a third meal. The district continues to work on this program. Mr. Carroll shared information about the Bikes and Breakfast program coming up at the Primary and Elementary along with the New Year, New Habits promotion at the Middle School and High School. Both programs are put in place to encourage students to start their day with a healthy meal. Information was shared about the food services app. There will be information sent out to families about downloading and using this app in the spring semester. Benjamin Cochran provided feedback about lunch service improvements he has noticed at the high school. He shared that food options are still available at the last lunch.

Students shared information about the Fentanyl Awareness campaign and how they shared information at the high school during morning announcements. Mrs. Gilbreath provided an update on the health services in the district. She noted that Flu and COVID cases are down right now. Texas Government Code Section:

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| 551.071 | Private consultation with the Board's Attorney. |
| 551.072 | Discussing purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property. |
| 551.073 | Discussing negotiated contracts for prospective gifts or donations. |
| 551.074 | Discussing personnel or to hear complaints against personnel. |
| 551.075 | To confer with employees of the school district to receive information or to ask questions. |
| 551.076 | Considering the deployment, specific occasions for, or implementation of, security personnel or devices. |
| 551.082 | Considering discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel. |
| 551.083 | Considering the standards, guidelines, terms, or conditions the Board will follow, or will instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups. |
| 551.084 | Excluding witnesses from a hearing. |

Texas Education Code:

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| 39.030(a) | To discuss or adopt individual assessment instruments or assessment instrument items. |
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Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

- (a) In the open meeting covered by the notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting; or
- (b) At a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof: as the School Board shall determine.
