Dear Parents/Guardians of Resort Academy Students,

On Thursday, May 8th, 2014, the students of the Resort Academy will be traveling to Seattle, WA to tour the Suncadia Resort, Underground Tour, Duck Tour, Hotel 1000, and The Fairmont Olympic Hotel. This trip will give students the opportunity to compare various hotel accommodations as well as enjoy tourist attractions such as the Space Needle, Woodland Zoo, Pike's Place Market and a Seattle Mariners game at SafeCo Field.

The bus will **depart** from the Coeur d' Alene Resort at **7:00am** on Thursday, May 8th. Students will need to arrive at **6:45am** to ensure everything is packed and ready to go before departure. We will return to the resort between 9:00-9:30pm on Saturday, May 10th.

I expect that all students will pack two business casual outfits. They may wear dark dress pants or skirt (knee length or below) with a blouse/sweater, dark dress shoes (preferably comfortable flats or low heels as we will be doing some walking), and a single pair of small earrings. Any other jewelry should be in good taste. Students are to dress in business attire for all tours during our trip.

Students will want to bring casual clothes for the rest of the time we are in Seattle. Casual clothes **must** be in accordance with school policy. We will be in Seattle for 3 days total. Pack accordingly.

Students will be expected to turn in any homework due Thursday, or Friday to their teachers prior to leaving and will have any assignments that may be due Monday prepared and ready to turn in upon their return to class on Monday.

There will be a strict no drugs, no alcohol policy. If for any reason there is suspicion your child is in possession of any drugs or alcohol there will be a luggage and room check. Being such a large group in a new city we will be participating in activities as a group. Students will be expected to participate in all tours and activities. There will be no leaving the group. If any drugs, alcohol, or behavioral issues arise, parents/guardians will be responsible for the return home trip of their child at your own expense. These are serious issues and will not be tolerated.
