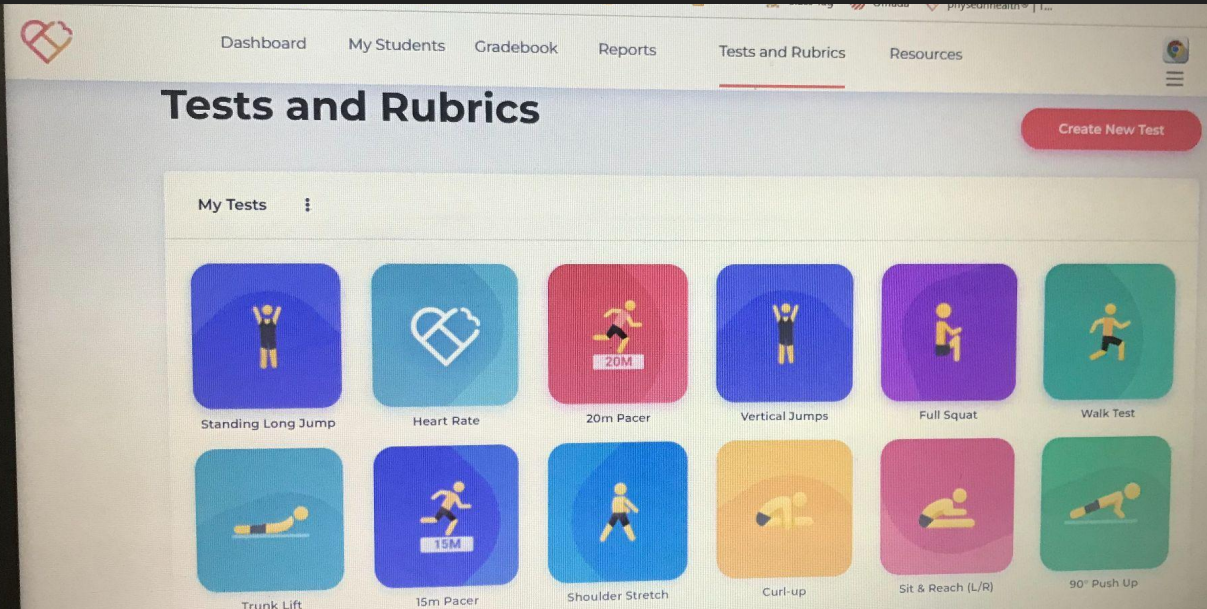
Summer Work

This year the school has revamped the middle school health class to be included with the PE class to make room for WIN time. We also invested in a new program to better communicate with the students and test their fitness levels throughout the year.

I spent the summer creating new assignments for Health (with a schedule of events) and changed the PE work to include more physical fitness homework & take home activity tests.

I am using Physed N Health to record and complete the students fitness testing this year. The program also allows students to log in and complete physical “tests” for assignments outside of class.

I have set up 12 to send out throughout the year.

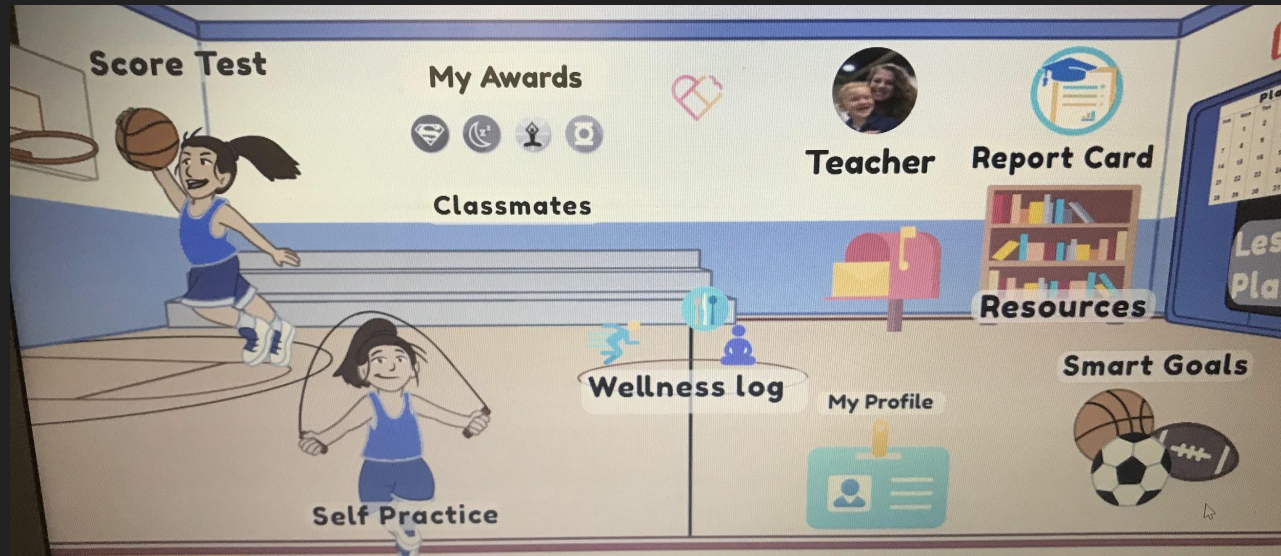
New fitness program

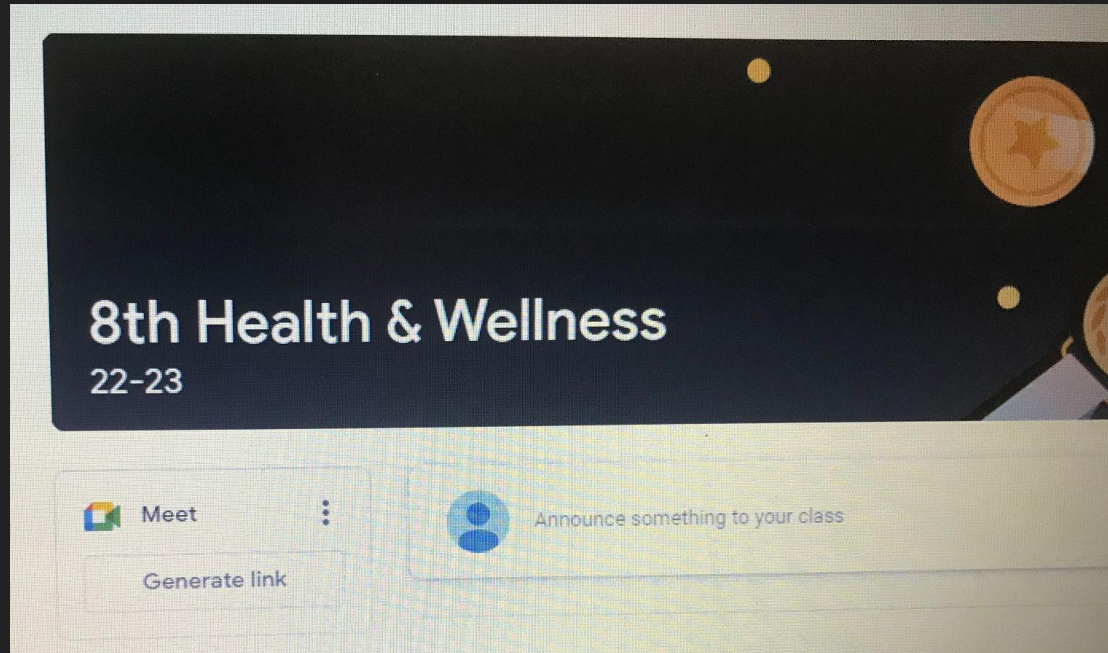
New Fitness Program



This is what the students dashboard looks like.

They are able to complete the “fitness tests” homework I send, the weekly wellness assignment, and create personal SMART goals for their fitness just like we do in ACP.

For the health portion students will still complete assignments and follow a powerpoint on google classroom. The assignments will be given on alternate weeks from the physical assignments. The health portion will now follow the full year format with their PE class.

I created a schedule so the MS teachers can stay connected and follow and to make sure we get through all needed health class time hours.

I will be taking each grade level once a month during homeroom to have in-class time for discussions and questions. While one grade meets with me, the other 2 will have health work time with the MS teachers so they can help answer questions.

Goals & Timeline

The goal of the scheduling is that students have 1-2 assignments a week for health, which will equal out to the amount of assignments they usually get with the 6wk class previously.

We wanted to disrupt their PE time as little as possible, that is where the idea of using homeroom time 1ce a month came so I can still go through the important information in person. There are some topics in each grade where I really wanted to make sure we talk about together.

The students schedule will include weekly health/wellness updates, 2ce a month health assignments following their specific grade level information, 2ce a month fitness skills that all grade levels will complete.

New Program Extras

The high school classes will also be using the new PE program for regular fitness testing and complete physical tests along with wellness updates.

Students are able to track their progress through more than just the current year so they can see how their health changes as they go through each grade level.

Summer Curriculum Work - John Legrid

- Goal was to create reference documents for current and future teachers that ensured organized courses that met district and state standards.
 - Math: using suggested course pacing from the CPM program, a pacing chart was created for each grade for the year based on the district calendar
 - Language Arts: a unit-by-unit guide was created for writing and literary skills to ensure that resources in the textbook are systematically used throughout middle school
 - Writing and Social Studies: writing units within the literature textbooks were aligned to social studies curriculum to create cross-curricular writing units throughout the year.
