Improve Outcomes - Students at our high school currently come from 29 distinct middle schools. Bringing students into our program in middle school will improve outcomes for students once in high school.

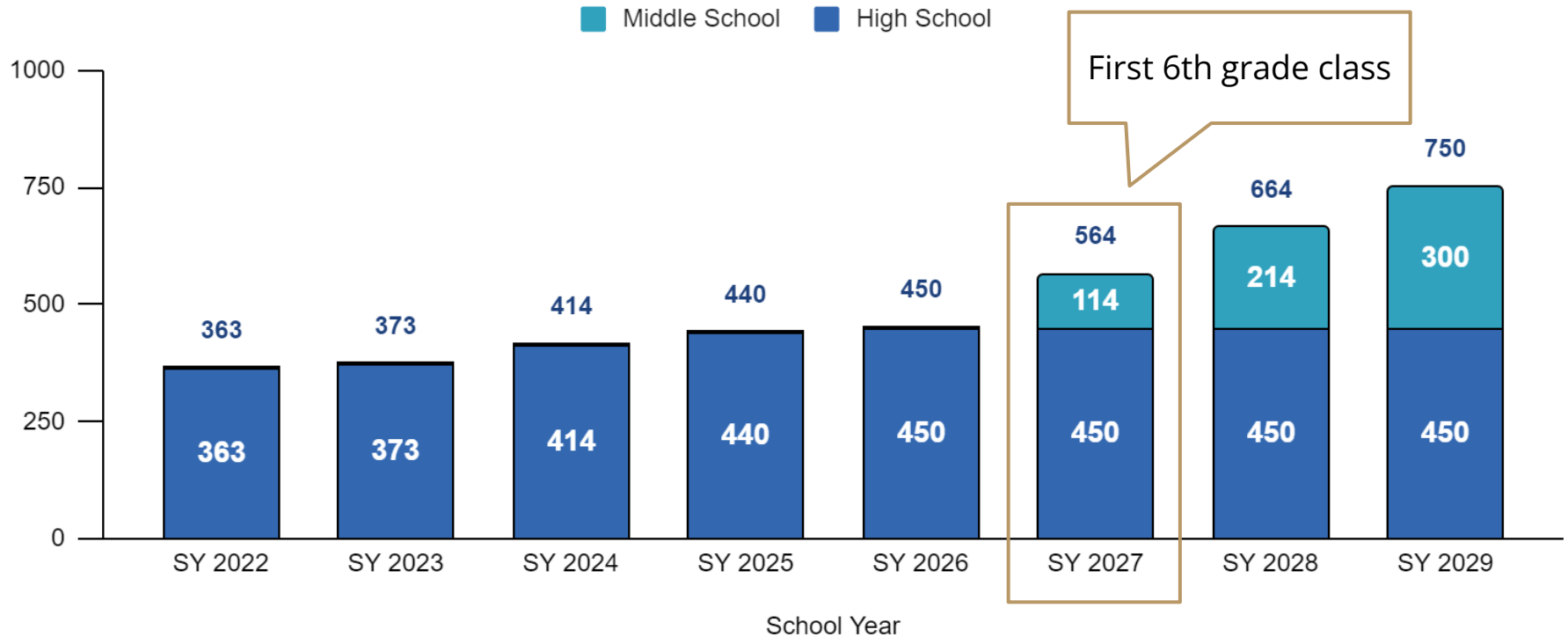
Consistent Demand - Our school community has consistently expressed a desire for a comprehensive and predictable pathway from middle to high school.

G-114: Reduction-in-Force

Approved by: Governing Council

Effective Date: June 13, 2005

Revision Date(s): April 22, 2024

POLICY:

Reduction-in-force (RIF) will be in accordance with New Mexico law and New Mexico Public Education Department regulations.

PROCEDURES:

Pursuant to 6.67.3.8, EMHS has the right to discharge or terminate licensed school personnel when a reduction in school personnel is required as a result of decreased enrollment or a decrease or revision of educational programs or insufficient legislative appropriation or authorization being made by the state and/or federal government. If the Executive Director determines that a reduction in force is necessary, the Executive Director will determine which employees will be terminated according to the following guidelines:

1. Priorities:
 - a. The Executive Director will review school personnel with a demonstrated commitment to the school's mission and values.
 - b. School personnel performance, including classroom observations and evaluator review. Performance will be considered a higher priority criteria than seniority.
 - c. The Executive Director will review the non-core or elective classes to determine how well they support the vision, mission, and student goals of the charter and how well they are integrated with the core curriculum. Those ranking lowest in this review process will be considered for elimination.
2. Teachers with fewer than 3 consecutive years of teaching service to EMHS:
 - a. Teachers with fewer than three consecutive years of teaching service to EMHS may be terminated before those with more than three consecutive years of teaching service. Termination procedures are described in the procedures of Policy G-014; the Executive Director may terminate an employee with fewer than three consecutive years of service to EMHS for any reason the Executive Director deems sufficient.
3. For teachers with more than three consecutive years of teaching service to EMHS, the following factors will be considered:
 - a. Performance and commitment to the mission and values of the school.
 - b. Those teachers licensed and qualified to teach the core classes and those retained non-core and elective classes receive priority.

- b. Those teachers performing to expectations and not on professional improvement plans will be given priority in teaching assignments over those not performing to expectations or on professional improvement plans.
- c. The Executive Director will make the teaching assignments from those licensed and qualified teachers based on the academic needs of the school and the Executive Director's assessment of which teachers will best meet those needs; priority will not be given to the teacher who is currently assigned to the particular class.
- d. Teachers whose classes are eliminated, or whose classes are assigned to another teacher, will be assigned to other classes or duties to the extent reasonably feasible based on their licensure and qualifications, consistent with the academic needs of the school.
- e. A teacher with more than 3 consecutive years of teaching service to EMHS may be terminated and a teacher with fewer than three consecutive years of teaching service retained as an alternative to a staff realignment that would seriously affect the educational program.
- f. A teacher with more than 3 years of teaching service to EMHS will not be terminated pursuant to a reduction in force during the middle of the school year unless projected financial burdens indicate that the school cannot survive financially for the current year without the termination, taking into consideration use of the 5% reserve. However, independent of a reduction in force, a teacher with more than 3 consecutive years of teaching service to EMHS may be discharged for cause pursuant to the procedures of Policy G-014.

Services Contract

Between:

New Mexico School Superintendents Association, hereby referred to as “NMSSA” and East Mountain High School a New Mexico public charter school, hereby referred to as “School” agree as follows:

Date of Contract: April 23, 2024

Background: This Contract is entered into between the NMSSA and the School to provide advocacy services on behalf of School concerning recent school calendar changes in the state of New Mexico. Contract terms are below.

Scope of Services: NMSSA agrees to perform the following services for the School:

- Conduct advocacy activities to support challenges to recent school calendar changes in the state of New Mexico, including filing litigation to enjoin implementation of laws, rules and/or policies that impact the School’s FY2025 academic year calendar ,which is the basis for calculating state funding to the School.
- Provide timely strategic guidance and advice to the School regarding advocacy efforts.
- Timely distribute relevant communications and materials, including but not limited to, regular reports on the progress of litigation and copies of court filings, information about negotiations with the New Mexico Public Education Department, presentations to state legislative bodies, communications to and from the Governor’s office related to the issue, or other activities that do or may affect the School’s FY 2025 school calendar.
- Represent the School's interests in relevant meetings, forums, and discussions and provide prompt and regular reports related to such efforts.
- Timely respond to the School’s inquiries about the services provided herein.

Payment Terms:

- The total cost for the services outlined above shall not exceed \$2,500.00 inclusive of New Mexico gross receipts taxes.
- An initial payment of \$1,250 shall be paid by the School within 30 days of signing this Contract.
- The remaining balance of \$1,250 shall be paid within 30 days from the date NMSSA (by and through school districts and/or public charter schools) files a petition in

state district court to enjoin implementation of state laws, rule or policies that are or will negatively impact the School related to the School's FY 2025 school calendar, or 30 days from the date the PED agrees to withdraw its current directives concerning the FY2025 school calendars, whichever is sooner.

- All payments shall be made in accordance with the payment instructions provided by the NMSSA.

Term of Contract: This Contract shall commence on the date of signing and shall remain in effect until the completion of the Scope of Services or entry of a court order that satisfies the purpose of this Contract, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement of both parties or by breach of its terms.

Confidentiality: Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information shared during this Contract, to the extent permitted by law.

Termination: Either party may terminate this Contract with written notice to the other party delivered by email. If NMSSA terminates the Contract on or before six (6) months from the effective date and prior to completion of the Scope of Work, it shall return fifty percent (50%) of the fees collected hereunder. If the School terminates the Contract, it shall not be entitled to recover payments paid through the date of termination and such payments shall be determined to be consideration in full for services provided by NMSSA through the date of the School's termination.

Amendment: Any amendment to this Contract must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
