NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS, VENDORS, AND SERVICE PROVIDERS

SUBJECT: **Prohibitions against Discrimination and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Activities**

This memorandum serves as notice to all employees, contractors, vendors and service providers of the District of important changes in state law and District policy prohibiting the consideration of race, sex, color or ethnicity in connection with District operations and decision-making. **All District employees, vendors, service providers and contractors are required to review this memorandum in its entirety,** disseminate its contents to all personnel assigned to District accounts, and maintain operations in strict conformity with District policy. Execution of services under any current or future District agreement serves as an acknowledgment of, and consent to, these contractual conditions.

I. Discrimination Prohibited

The District prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex or disability. Additionally, Texas Education Code Section 11.005 and District policy prohibit District employees, contractors, vendors, and service providers from performing, carrying out, or assigning certain responsibilities or job duties at, for, or on behalf of the District. This notice clarifies District policy prohibiting the consideration of race, sex, color, or ethnicity in District operations and decision-making.

Consistent with Texas Education Code § 11.005, the District prohibits certain activities related to Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) initiatives. The District's policies may be accessed online at: <https://pol.tasb.org/PolicyOnline?key=696>. Employees, contractors, vendors and service providers are charged with complying with all District policies while providing services to the District.

II. Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Duties Defined

Diversity, equity, and inclusion ("DEI") duties prohibited by District policy are any action, role, or practice that involves the following:

1. **Influencing Employment Practices:** Any effort designed to influence hiring, recruitment, promotion, or general employment practices with respect to race, sex, color or ethnicity, unless strictly necessary to maintain compliance with established state or federal antidiscrimination statutes.



2. **Promoting Differential Treatment:** Proactively promoting differential treatment of individuals, or providing special or exclusive benefits to individuals, solely on the basis of race, color, or ethnicity.
3. **Developing Protected-Class Programming:** Developing, implementing, structuring, or delivering policies, operating procedures, professional trainings, educational activities, or instructional programs that reference race, color, ethnicity, gender identity, or sexual orientation. Exceptions exist for student recruitment collaborations involving historically black colleges and universities, or as otherwise mandated by state or federal law.
4. **Compelling DEI Statements:** Compelling, requiring, inducing, or soliciting any prospective or current employee, contractor, service provider or vendor to submit a diversity, equity, and inclusion statement, or granting preferential consideration or advantage to any individual based on the provision or substance of such a statement.

III. District Policies

The following District policies are of particular importance in regulating the District's prohibition against DEI duties:

1. **Board Policy BT (LEGAL):** Provides that except as explicitly required by state or federal law, the District shall not assign DEI duties to any person and must proactively prohibit independent contractors from engaging in such activities.
2. **Board Policy CJ (LEGAL) and (LOCAL):** These policies govern contracted services and provide that a District contract is subject to termination if a contractor or vendor intentionally or knowingly engages in DEI duties or assigns such duties to another individual. It further establishes the appeal process through which an affected contractor may appeal an adverse contract action.
3. **Board Policy DH (LOCAL):** Outlines employee standards of conduct, including the prohibition against engaging in or delegating to another DEI duties.
4. **Board Policy BJA (LEGAL):** Requiring the Superintendent to certify to the Commissioner of Education the District's compliance with TEC Sections 39.008, 11.005 and 28.0022.
5. **Board Policy CMD (LEGAL):** Regarding the acquisition of instructional materials.
6. **Board Policy DF (LEGAL):** Providing for the appropriate discipline, including termination, of a District employee or contractor who intentionally or knowingly engages in or assigns to another person prohibited diversity, equity, and inclusion duties.
7. **Board Policy DG (LEGAL):** Providing that a teacher may not be compelled to discuss a widely debated and currently controversial issue of public policy or social affairs.
8. **Board Policy BJCF (LOCAL):** Providing violation of the District's prohibition against engaging in or delegating to another DEI duties is a ground for Superintendent contract nonrenewal.



9. **Board Policy EMB (LEGAL):** Addressing the teaching of controversial topics, and prohibiting instruction, guidance, activities, or programming regarding sexual orientation and gender identity to students.

IV. Consequences for Violation of Policies

Employees and District contractors are on notice that violation of these District policies may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employees, or termination of third-party contracts with vendors and service providers:

- **Mandatory Termination of Contracts:** Policy CJ (LOCAL) provides that any intentional or knowing violation of these prohibitions constitutes a material breach of contract. If the District determines through administrative review or inquiry that a contractor has intentionally or knowingly engaged in DEI duties, assigned DEI duties to another individual, or conducted prohibited instruction or guidance, the violation shall result in the termination of the contract. Penalties for violating the District's policies apply to all contractors, vendors and service providers, regardless of whether the prohibited act was committed by an executive officer, a staff employee, or a third-party agent acting on behalf of the contracting entity.
- **Employee Discipline:** Employees who violate the District's policies and standards of professional conduct may be subject to discipline, up to and including possible termination of employment.

V. Certain Practices Exempted

Policy BT (LEGAL) explicitly clarifies that these prohibitions do not apply to, restrict, or modify several core educational and commercial functions. Contractors and employees may safely engage in the following activities without violating the District's anti-discrimination policies:

1. **Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUBs):** The policy does not limit or prohibit the District from actively contracting with historically underutilized businesses in accordance with applicable Texas procurement statutes.
2. **Commemorative and Holiday Instruction:** Contractors may acknowledge, reference, or teach the historic significance of state and federal holidays, or celebrate federally designated commemorative months, provided the curriculum aligns with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) frameworks.
3. **Constitutional Protections:** Nothing in these guidelines shall be construed to infringe upon or affect a student's core constitutional rights under the First Amendment to the United States Constitution or Article I, Section 8, of the Texas Constitution.
4. **Academic Achievement and Data Reporting:** Data collection, standard monitoring, or state reporting are not impacted by the District's policies. Practices, procedures, or programs designed to eliminate unlawful discriminatory patterns, address academic achievement gaps, or enhance



post-graduate student success are not impacted by these policies. These programs are structured and implemented entirely without regard to race, sex, color, or ethnicity.

LONE OAK ISD

BOARD REGULATIONS GOVERNING SCHOOL MARSHALS

The purpose of these regulations is to meet the requirements of CKE
(LEGAL)

- 1) A Lone Oak ISD school marshal may make arrests and exercise all authority given to peace officers under Section 2, Chapter 2, Article 2.127, Code of Criminal Procedure, but only to the extent necessary to prevent or abate the commission of an offense that threatens serious bodily injury or death of students, faculty, or visitors on school premises, provided, however, a Lone Oak ISD school marshal may not issue a traffic citation for a violation of Chapter 521, Transportation Code, or Subtitle C, Title 7 Transportation Code. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal may access a handgun only under circumstances that would justify the use of deadly force under Section 9.32 or 9.33 of the Penal Code.
- 2) A Lone Oak ISD school marshal may only carry an approved handgun
 - a. in compliance with the legal requirements for a licensed to carry handgun carrier
 - b. at all Lone Oak ISD district campuses
 - c. on any grounds or in any building where a Lone Oak ISD-sponsored activity is being conducted;
 - d. where a Lone Oak ISD athletic sporting event or interscholastic event is taking place;
 - e. at any meeting of the Lone Oak ISD Board,
 - f. on a Lone Oak ISD passenger transportation vehicle.
- 3) If a Lone Oak ISD school marshal's primary duty involves regular, direct contact with students, the marshal shall carry a concealed handgun.
- 4) If a Lone Oak ISD school marshal is wearing a uniform identifying him/her as a school marshal, he/she may openly carry a handgun on the school marshal's person
- 5) Any approved handgun carried by or within access of a Lone Oak ISD school marshal must be loaded only with frangible ammunition designed to disintegrate on impact for maximum safety and minimal danger to others. Such frangible ammunition must be approved by the Board.
- 6) A Lone Oak ISD school marshal's status as a "school marshal" becomes inactive on:
 - a. Expiration of the employee's school marshal license under Occupations Code 1701.260.
 - b. Suspension or revocation of the employee's license to carry handgun license.

- c. Termination of the employee's employment with Lone Oak ISD.
 - d. Notice from the Board that the employee's services as a school marshal are no longer required.
 - e. Failure to demonstrate weapons proficiency to the satisfaction of the Lone Oak ISD Police Department Chief.
 - f. Violation of any Lone Oak ISD policy or regulation applicable to a Lone Oak ISD school marshal.
 - g. Notice from the Superintendent that the employee's services as a school marshal are temporarily suspended pending review by the Board.
- 7) A Lone Oak ISD school marshal may provide his/her own duty handgun and/or the district may provide a handgun which must be approved by the Lone Oak ISD Police Department Chief. Each duty handgun must meet all of the following requirements (a Lone Oak ISD school marshal will not carry a duty handgun that does not meet all of the following requirements):
- a. The Lone Oak ISD Police Department will maintain a record of any Lone Oak ISD school marshal is authorized to carry.
 - b. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal's handgun(s) must be listed on the Department's approved firearm list.
 - c. All duty handguns to be carried by a Lone Oak ISD school marshal must be registered with the Lone Oak ISD Police Department by the marshal requesting to carry them.
 - d. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal may have a maximum of three (3) duty handguns registered.
 - e. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal must deliver all duty handguns to the Lone Oak ISD Police Department one time per year for inspection and registration by the Lone Oak ISD Police Department staff. Each of a marshal's duty handguns will undergo a thorough inspection and will be test fired and evaluated for reliability and examined to see if it conforms to existing safety standards. Handguns that do not pass the safety inspection may not be used by a Lone Oak ISD school marshal.
 - f. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal's list of approved duty handguns may change during the school year so long as each handgun meets the requirements hereof before it is used in service.
- 8) A Lone Oak ISD school marshal must complete and pass the TCOLE weapons qualification course of fire one (1) time per year. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal must qualify with all firearms that he/she has registered with the Lone Oak ISD Police Department. A Lone Oak ISD school marshal must demonstrate weapons proficiency to the satisfaction of the Lone Oak ISD Police Department.

- 9) Lone Oak ISD school marshal will be required to attend all active shooter training(s) as mandated by the Lone Oak ISD police.
- 10) All school marshals shall wear proper attire/insignia that identifies the individual as a school marshal for Lone Oak ISD.

*These ISD local board written regulations addressing school marshals and school security will be a part of the district's emergency operations plan. For the safety and security of ISD's employees and students, these written policies will not be made available pursuant to a request under the "Public Information Act". Education Code 37.0811(g); Occupations Code 1701.260(j)

SUBJECT: Authorization to Allow Budget Transfers Between Function Codes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Current state regulations require that the Board approve budget amendments by function. In ongoing regular district business, management often finds it necessary to transfer budgeted funds between functional codes in order to ensure expenditures are Board approved. For example, a counselor might need additional supply items that exceed their budgeted allotment; therefore, funds could be transferred to Function 31 from the principals Function 23 to cover the needed supplies. There would be no change in the overall approved budget. This resolution is simply an order to remain in compliance with state guidelines budget adoptions.

With a total 2026-2027 budget of \$15,134,115 serving a student population of approximately 1,041 ADA, it is frequently necessary to make changes to the adopted budget without changing the overall board approved adopted budget.

ITEMS ADDRESSED:

Budget transfers within the same function or outside the original function WILL NOT INCREASE the total operating budget. A monthly report of any transfers from functional area to functional area will be presented to the Board. If ADDITIONAL funds are ever needed, management will present information to the Board for approval requesting a budget amendment.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Authorize the Superintendent/Deputy Superintendent to approve budget transfers not to exceed \$100,000 per transfer per function between functional codes provided there is NO INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT OF THE TOTAL APPROVED OPERATING BUDGET, and provided that the transfers between functions will be reported to the board.
