- A. Approval of the December 4, 2025 Veterans Commission Meeting Minutes
2. VISITOR/PUBLIC COMMENTS on Non-Agenda Items (5-minutes maximum)  
Bill Brizee introduced himself as Vice-Chair of the Historic Commission and stated that he had attended meetings of every commission except this one so far. He explained that he had taken the initiative to encourage greater collaboration among the commissions. Brizee stated that the Veterans Commission may have an interest in the Historic Commission's work on publishing a history book about Hayden families that would include any military service. He also mentioned that the Historic Commission is working to track buildings being demolished in the city.

Chair Cosby suggested that quarterly written reports prepared by each commission could be shared among the commissions so members could stay informed about one another's work. Brizee also proposed holding quarterly meetings with two members from each commission to discuss ways to collaborate, noting that this could help keep commissions informed and support one another's efforts. Commissioner Schrader recommended reviewing the by-laws of each commission so members would have a better understanding of each commission's role.

3. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- A. Veterans Commission Recruitment **(ACTION ITEM)**

Chair Cosby noted that the commission currently had five members and could have up to nine, which would provide additional contacts and greater reach for speakers and related efforts. Jennifer Arrotta informed the commission that the City Clerk had attempted to

contact the company typically used for business cards but had not received a response. Arrotta stated that she would proceed with ordering the cards and asked if the commission had any recommendations on vendors, to which the commission responded that they did not.

Commissioner Colangelo asked whether a previous price point had been provided in the past and stated that she was willing to contact printers to see if that price could be matched. Arrotta replied that no price point had been provided. Chair Cosby mentioned going with the minimum amount of cards since they did not need a large number. Colangelo stated that she would contact the printer she typically uses, confirm the quantity the commission had decided on, and send follow-up emails the next day. She added that she would keep Arrotta and the commission's clerk informed. Cosby stated that Arrotta would be Colangelo's point of contact. Commissioner Schrader noted that if a new company is used, there may be an additional charge for setting up the artwork, which could increase the expense, but said it was necessary to move forward with the business cards. Colangelo said she would keep that in mind.

**B. Establishing Guest Speaker Guidance (ACTION ITEM)**

Chair Cosby reviewed several items he believed needed to be changed in the Guest Speaker Procedures in the Veterans Commission Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). Jennifer Arrotta explained that the changes to the SOP came from City Council and Administration and informed the commission that any changes would need to be made as a recommendation. Commissioner Verbrugge noted that the time frame for selecting a speaker made the process difficult.

Vice-Chair Snell made a motion to remove the Guest Speaker Procedures from the SOP, and Commissioner Schrader seconded the motion. The commission discussed the motion as follows: Commissioner Colangelo asked whether it would be simpler to submit all three recommended speakers to City Council at once, with their top recommendation, and receive feedback on all three rather than submitting one, receiving a denial, and starting over. She stated that this process would streamline the procedure. Verbrugge asked whether they could propose that now and begin working on that process. Snell expressed concern that submitting three potential speakers at once could create scheduling conflicts, preparation issues, and require informing two of the candidates that they were not selected. Colangelo responded that this was similar to a job application process: each candidate would be informed of the process and given thirty days for feedback, which she felt addressed the concern. Verbrugge agreed and noted he understood Colangelo's approach.

Snell added that his overall concern was that the SOP introduced a somewhat burdensome protocol to address a problem that is unlikely to occur, as City Council will generally approve the commission's recommended speaker. He noted that as long as a recommendation is submitted in a timely manner and feedback is received within four months, it should provide sufficient time for Council to review and approve the candidate. Verbrugge stated that the feedback from Snell and Colangelo provided useful guidance to help the commission move forward. Chair Cosby stated that because the procurement and approval of Guest Speakers had been included in the SOP without discussion or input from the commission, the process had become unrealistic. He expressed support for Snell's motion to remove the procedure temporarily and return to the commission's prior practice of discussing recommendations internally. Verbrugge added that the commission could conduct due diligence on prospective speakers in a constructive way and encouraged including that step in future recommendations. The motion passed.

**Motion to recommend that Guest Speaker selection protocol be removed from the Veterans Commission Standard Operating Procedure until they have proper time to come up with protocol that makes sense to the commission. This motion, made by Snell and seconded by Schrader, Carried.**

City Clerk Sanchez informed the commission that the flag drop-off box was an Eagle Scout project and that Boy Scout troops had previously been responsible for collecting and properly retiring the flags on a regular basis. She explained that communication with local

Scout troops had been lost and that the flags were no longer being collected. She asked whether the commission had contacts with a Boy Scout or Scout troop that might be interested in taking on this responsibility, noting that this could include holding a ceremony for proper disposal or connecting the City with another appropriate group.

Commissioner Schrader stated that the American Legion retires flags if a Scout troop is unavailable and said he would reach out to them, obtain contact information, and relay it to the commission's clerk.

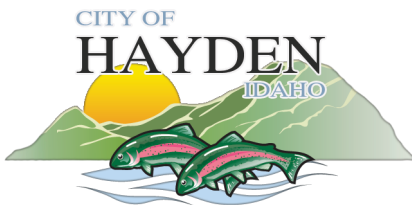

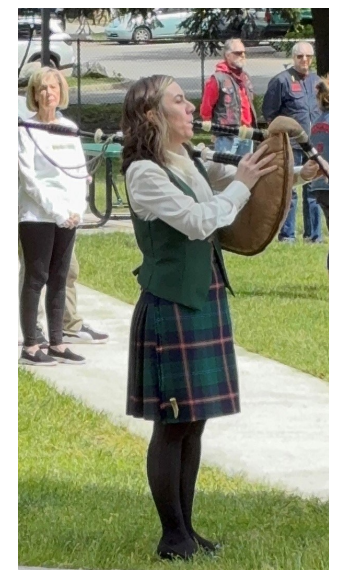
