CALL TO ORDER: Chair Jones called the meeting to order at 2:11 PM

ROLL CALL OF COMMISSION MEMBERS:

Present: Chair Jones, Commissioner Lee, Vice-Chair Wright.

Absent: Commissioner Wilder. There was a Quorum.

1. WORKSHOP

- A. **2026 Hayden Arts Showcase** Commissioner Wright spoke with Dan Connelley, he is open to doing a day long workshop for children. He is also willing to play music during the rest of the event as well. The cost would be \$20.00 per child, with lunch provided. The program would be a 4-hour duration for 10-30 elementary age children. The options for the performance were "Tangled", "Treasure Island", "The Greatest Showman" and "Peter Pan". The Commission agreed to go with "Treasure Island". The Commission set the deadline for the workshop registration to August 31, 2026. It would start with a "meet and greet" at 11:00 AM, 11:15 would be learning script and assigning parts. The children would take a lunch break at 12:15 with practice beginning at 12:45. From there, the performance would begin at 3:00 PM and would be approximately 30 minutes long. From 3:00 PM- 5:00 PM would showcase each artist's booth.

The Chair has taken on the responsibility of creating a flyer for the event, Vice-Chair Wright will confirm the age range of children. The Liaison asked if Mr. Connelley would be willing to do a discussion to engage the audience and explain the process of how he does his workshops as another showcase for the event. The Vice Chair will reach out to Dan Connelley about that aspect. The booths will include painting, sculpting, culinary, craft booth, and a photo booth. The Commission determined set-up for the booths would begin at 2:00 PM.

The event will be advertised on the City's website, social media, reader board as well as flyers. It will also be shared with the Coeur D Alene Press as well as news media. On the day of, there will be several sandwich boards showing parking and the event. Vice-Chair Wright has offered to create signs for each booth. Chair Jones will look into banners that may be donated, and if not, she will come back with a cost estimate.

The Commission would like to reach out to the schools, Boys & Girls Club, Dan Connelley will also share the event. They may also reach out to local daycares, music and dance studios, and Facebook parenting groups. The official title of the event is "Hayden Arts Showcase". The August workshop will discuss the craft booth, volunteers if needed, children's lunch, as well as a spreadsheet tracking outreach.

CALL TO ORDER Chair Jones called the meeting to order at 3:05 PM

ROLL CALL OF COMMISSION MEMBERS

Present: Commissioner Lee, Chair Jones, Commissioner Wright.

Absent: Commissioner Wilder, A Quorum was present.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE Chair Jones led the pledge of allegiance.

ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS None.

1. **CONSENT CALENDAR** **All items on the Consent Calendar are Action Items**

A. Approval of the Workshop Meeting Minutes and Regular Meeting Minutes for June 10, 2026. Commissioner Wright made a motion to approve the workshop and regular meeting minutes on June 10, 2026. Commissioner Lee seconded the motion. Voice Vote: All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.

2. **VISITOR/PUBLIC COMMENT on Non-Agenda Items (5-minutes maximum)**
None.

3. **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

A. **ACTION ITEM** Come Together Bench Program Community Announcement The Liaison gave a recap of the artist meeting, she shared the artists seem very enthusiastic. She informed the Commission that several of the artists provided updated quantities of paint as well as additional colors requested. She informed the Commission the City is in contact with Sherwin Williams and currently requesting a cost estimate. The artists will be using the Forte acrylic, with the smallest quantity available being the quart size. The dates for the first round of benches to be painted are tentatively, the last week in July and the first week of August. The dates may need to be adjusted depending on when the paint order will be available.

The Liaison has additional paint weeks available on the week of August 17-21st and August 24th-August 28th, if needed. The Liaison informed the Arts Commission that the Public Works department cleaned the floors of the shop and sprayed down the benches; she would like Commissioner Lee to take a look and see if they need to be primed again. The manufacturer suggests each bench just be wiped down with a cloth, the Liaison is requesting the assistance of the Arts Commission to wipe down the benches before the artist's paint. Vice-Chair Wright shared she would like to be part of painting the bench, but her availability is the last week in August. Chair Jones wanted to know if the topcoat needed to be painted or sprayed on. The Liaison let her know both are an option. They will determine if it will be better to spray or paint it on and how to incorporate the spray tent, if needed. The Arts Commission will be tasked with painting the topcoat on the benches. The Arts Commission will supply brown paper and tape and allow the artists to tape off their benches. The Liaison would like to have a ribbon cutting event once the benches are placed for the public and the artists. She would like to have it ready by September 12th when the Arts Commission is doing the Hayden Arts Showcase. It will depend on painting

and if Public Works has been able to install the benches. The Liaison posed the question of what type of finish the topcoat should be, as far as glossy, matte, or satin? Or if that should be left up to each individual artist. The Commission decided to go with glossy, the artists will be emailed to let us know if they have preference on base coat, knowing the topcoat will be glossy.

- B. **ACTION ITEM** 2026 Hayden Art Showcase The Arts Commission would like to put the demonstration booths near the stage and stagger them around it. The Arts Commission would like to consider renting chairs or borrowing them for the performance during the August meeting.
- C. **ACTION ITEM** T- Mobile Grant Opportunity The grant opportunity is no longer available. The Arts Commission will continue to look for other grant opportunities.
- D. **ACTION ITEM** Hayden Arts Commission Signage No update.
- E. **ACTION ITEM** Hayden City Hall Gallery Guidelines Commissioner Lee shared the 3rd Quarter artist does not want to do an artist reception and there is still wall space available if anyone knows of an additional artist who may be interested in displaying art in Hayden City Hall. He also donated chain to the gallery for artists to use when hanging their art pieces. The Liaison asked the Commission to look at the guidelines and come up with ways to improve it and make a draft that would be helpful so City Staff can amend it.

4. **NEW BUSINESS**

- A. **ACTION ITEM** Hayden City Gallery Featured Artist Letter of Reference The Vice-Chair inquired about a letter we can create for the Hayden City Hall Gallery artists as an acknowledgement and for their portfolio. The Liaison informed the Commission that as an official letter from the City of Hayden, it would need to be very generic and across the board for each artist. Vice-Chair will draft a letter and send it to the Liaison.

5. **REPORTS** The City is trying a new approach to the newsletters. They are going to do a one page, double sided "tid-bits" that will go out with the sewer bills and will direct people to the website for more information. It will go out every 2 months. The Liaison will also complete the Hayden Days Parade application. The Commission would like to walk with the banner and hand out packs of crayons and sidewalk chalk in packages with a quote and signage stating it is from The Hayden Arts Commission. The Arts Commission is also due to report to City Council on the July 28th meeting. The City is also beginning Phase I of the McIntire Park re-design project. It will begin with the parking lot, to the shop and include the ballpark and band shell. The City is also beginning a Master Plan for a civic center which will be partnered with the Hayden Urban Renewal Agency. There will be opportunities for community engagement on the project. In Hayden Canyon, the City owns 19 acres, the developer is responsible for the Phase I of the park. It will come to fruition in the next couple years. Marks Ranch is also being developed as well.

6. **ADJOURNMENT** **ACTION ITEM** The Chair adjourned the meeting at 3:52 PM.

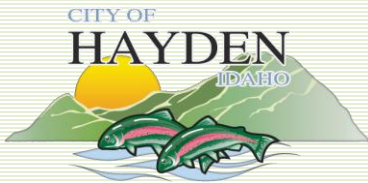

OVERVIEW:

*The Hayden Arts Commission invites artists, artist teams and organized groups to submit applications to display art in the Hayden City Gallery. The Hayden City Gallery was established by the Arts Commission to **promote art and local artists** in the community. The display of art is a valuable benefit to artists and the public.*

BACKGROUND:

In 2008, after years of planning, the 'Central Business District' was established in downtown Hayden. With the help of grants, the city began improving the District by widening Government Way, burying utilities, and adding sidewalks, street lights, and greenspace. In 2009, Hayden City Hall received a facelift and addition in order to set an example for businesses in the District. As a result, a new entry and hallway was created to facilitate visitor traffic. This area, now referred to as the Hayden City Gallery, provides a corridor of natural light, large wall spaces, display cases and pedestals for the display of local art.

ALL ART DISPLAYED SHOULD:

- Provide a positive impression and lasting memory for visitors.
- Be original work.
- Be no wider or longer than the space will allow.
- Be labeled with a card including, at a minimum, the following:
 - Name of the piece
 - Artist name
 - Contact information
 - Price (or NFS)

WALL REQUIREMENTS:

- No projecting points or sharp edges.
- Artwork must be professionally presented (framed & matted, on canvas, metal print, wood print, etc.)
- Wall art must hang from the existing ceiling grid. No nails!
- Artist is responsible for providing wire/line and hardware.
- Minimum grouping or individual size framed of 16"x20"
- Standard display height: 57" – 66" 'on center' (eye level)

CASE REQUIREMENTS:

- Artwork must fit into the cases with the doors closed and locked.
- Be positioned for optimal viewing, including the use of easels for 2-dimensional pieces.

PEDESTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- No projecting points or sharp edges.
- Art must not impede pedestrian traffic.

USE OF THE FACILITIES:

The City will execute an agreement with the artist for use of the facilities. The agreement states that artwork will be displayed as to not cause damage to the walls and other parts of the premises. The art will not obstruct the flow of City Hall visitors and staff through the lobby and hallway area. **Artists will not display any art piece(s) that depict nudity or violence or that foster discrimination against persons based on their race, religion, gender, age or ethnicity.**

If an art piece is sold during the term of the agreement, the artist shall either replace the piece or notify the gallery manager that the space will be available for another artist and not remove the sold piece until a suitable replacement is found. **Customer interaction and sales shall be between the artist and the customer.** No commissions will be collected by the City.

It is the artist's responsibility to provide any equipment or materials necessary for the placement of the art and the protection of the artwork while it is on display.

ELIGIBILITY:

Individual artists, artist's teams, and organized groups are eligible to apply, including teams of artists from multiple disciplines. Artists may submit multiple designs and medium groupings, including requests for use of the walls and cases at the same time.

SELECTION:

The Arts Commission will consider applications based on the following criteria, including, but not limited to: Artistic quality, theme, content, context, media, performance, public safety, originality and diversity.

1. A completed Hayden City Gallery Application.
2. A brief, one-page artist bio (separate bios for each team member in a team, one bio for a group).
3. A one-page description of the art, including information on the type of medium, materials used, framing/mounting/presentation style, approximate number of total pieces proposed for the gallery space, average size of pieces, size of smallest piece, and size of largest piece.
4. A least 3 images of artwork proposed that accurately represents the artwork, provided on 8 ½" x 11" pages in color or electronically by email in pdf. or jpeg. format.
5. **The Arts Commission will require physical samples or additional electronic images in order to make their decision.**

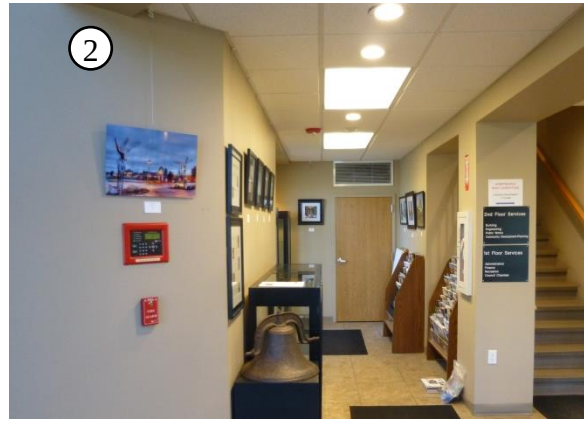

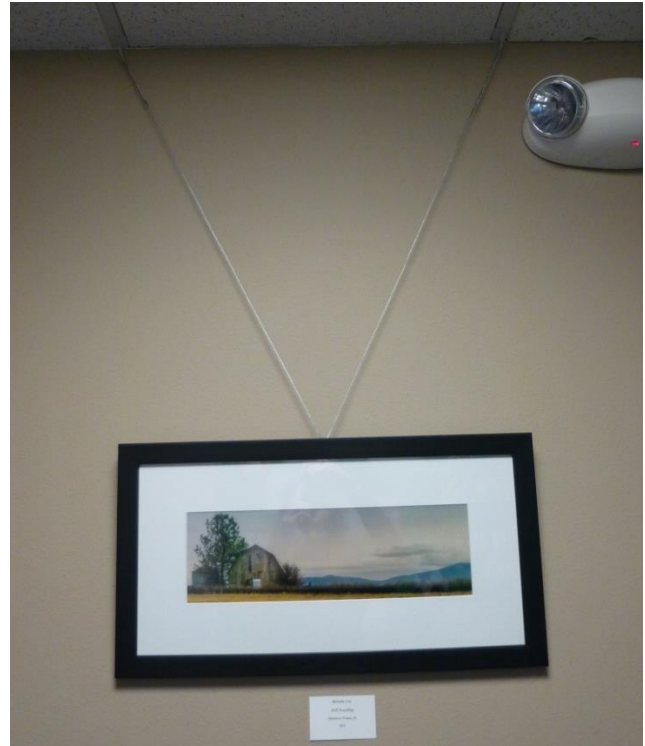
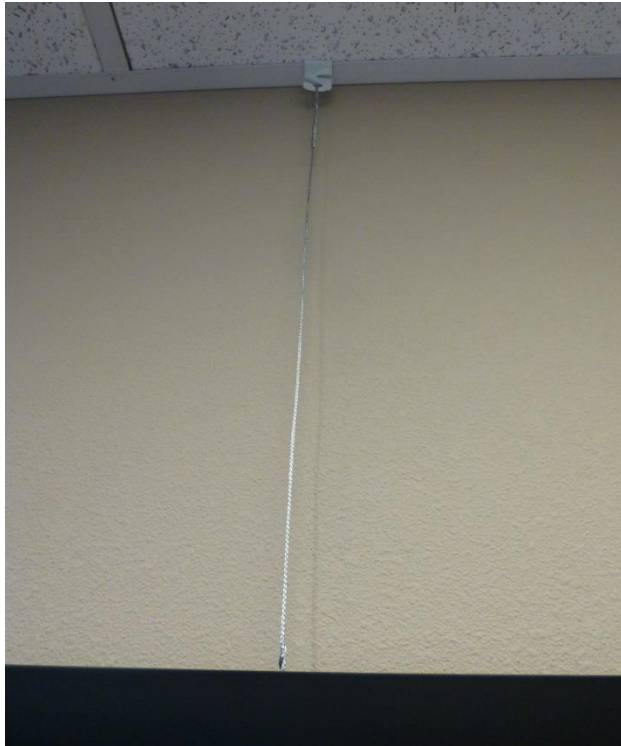
