Last week, June 13 2022 Cheri Burke went over Heath Education. It was very helpful to hear an overview. It was noted by Cheri that the curriculum has not changed in 10 years. On September 23, 2019 the Health curriculum was brought before the BOE and all of the major changes were noted. This includes everything from new and updated lesson plans to brand new programs and materials. Second Step Social Emotional Learning is noted as one of the "major changes". This is the same program that was suspended by a school board in Utah for its controversial age-inappropriate content. From            The Glastonbury 2019 report "Health and PE teachers will learn and be able to teach new SEL concepts and learning activities throughout the year to address social and emotional learning needs in PE, K-12." I am not in a position to say whether this program is appropriate or not, but I am concerned as to why it wasn't mentioned as an addition. Cheri, why wasn't SEL discussed last BOE meeting? The health curriculum has in fact changed as recently as 2019 and parents have the right to know this. This question is not being repeated because we don't like the answer. It is being repeated because the answers given are inaccurate. As we've repeated many times, we cannot opt out of what we do not know exists. I spoke to you about this book at your last meeting. Please attach this to the official record of your next meeting.</p> <p>The High School Library catalog lists this book as appropriate for ADULTS. In other words, when it was added to the High School library it was meant for adults not children. That fact has not changed.</p> <p>The book contains inappropriate language. When I quoted from the book at your BOE Meeting on 6/28/22, you informed me that meeting rules forbade such language. That is a clear indication that the book's content is not meant for grades K-12.</p> <p>The book contains explicit sexual scenes. It is against the law to expose children to written text that graphically depicts acts of sex. DCF is explicit about adults presenting pornography to minors. Educators are mandated to report child abuse to DCF. Presenting pornography qualifies as child abuse. I find it ironic that the education establishment is exempted from the law.</p> <p>The book promotes promiscuous sex.</p> <p>The book is anti-faith, anti-male, anti-Christian, anti-police, anti-white and political throughout. Second Step was adopted as a curriculum in 2019, according to Ann Colebrook's Health and Physical Education report on September 23 2019. Dr Bookman confirms this in an email to me on November 23 2021 that directs me to Second Step as part of the elementary curriculum. A direct quote "We use the Second Step program to promote social emotional learning and teach self-management, relationship building, cooperation and conflict resolution. You can see more about it here: <a href="https://www.secondstep.org/elementary-school-curriculum/classroom-kits">https://www.secondstep.org/elementary-school-curriculum/classroom-kits</a>.</p> <p>I am now being told that Second Step is not part of the curriculum and that no major changes have been added to our Health and Development Curriculum in 10 years. Second Step was certainly added and, I believe, should've gone through board approval. Did Second Step go through Board of Education approval? This is critically important not only in policy, but so that parents are made aware of what is being added to their children's learning environment. Once again I will repeat why this matters at all, parent cannot opt out of subjects that they aren't aware of. This doesn't seem to be a matter of technicality or confusion. It is a matter of transparency and accountability.</p> <p>In regards to the technology report on the agenda tonight, I am wondering why a budget was voted on months before these numbers were ever seen. How did board members make responsible decisions on how to vote on technology when they had never seen the actual expenditure? I am also curious as to how necessary all of this is. Has anyone considered pulling back a little on technology? I know how concerned many parents are regarding the ridiculous amount of screen time kids have just at school.</p>

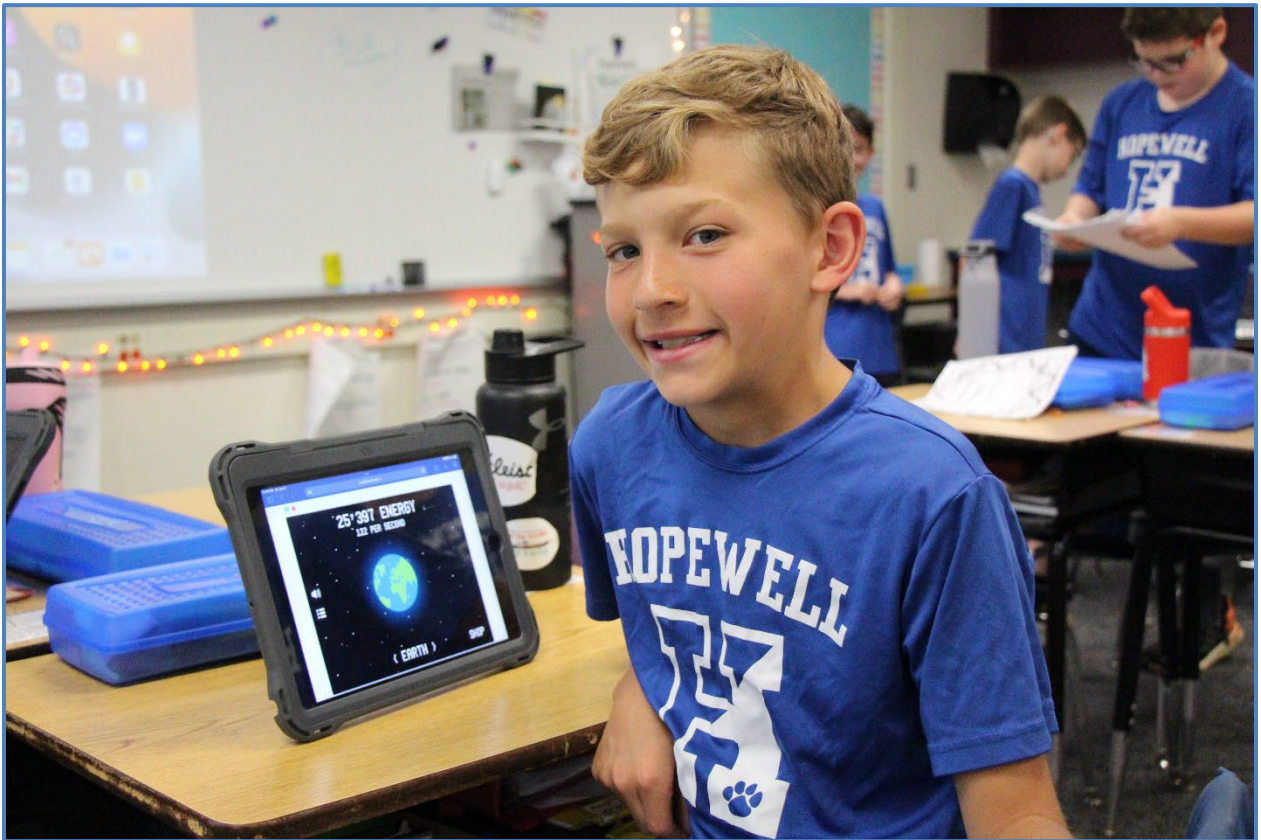

## 2021-22 Accomplishments

## Deployed newly leased iPads

In accordance with our technology plan, we refresh iPad leases each spring for students in 6th and 9th grades. At Gideon Welles, we swapped iPads one class at a time. Students will use these new iPads for the next three years. At Glastonbury High School, 9<sup>th</sup> grade students scheduled individual appointments during a free period and met with Technology Support Specialists to exchange their iPads. These students will use their new iPads through the end of senior year. Incoming 4th graders will receive their new iPads at the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year this fall. Their current iPads will be cleaned and configured for the incoming kindergarteners.



## Implemented new cybersecurity measures

**Two-Step Verification.** Over the past several years, risks from phishing emails, ransomware attacks, and other fraudulent activities have increased dramatically. Our insurance carrier is now requiring Glastonbury Public Schools to take more advanced steps to protect ourselves, our students, and our data. One of the steps is that Glastonbury Public Schools faculty and staff must use Google 2-step verification.

**New laptop management system.** We implemented a cloud-based management system for our Windows laptops, similar to the Mobile Device Management System we use for our Apple Products. *Microsoft Azure* and *Intune* are both part of this system. They allow us to encrypt or remotely wipe a managed laptop.

## Manage new software subscriptions

We implemented several new instructional cloud-based subscriptions this year. These included Formative, Actively Learn, Seesaw, and Classkick, among others. Each required specific configuration and data needs. Some of these subscriptions are designed to integrate with our current Google accounts, while others require a separate log in process. The TIS department collaborates with curriculum directors to assess individual app/subscription data and support requirements to ensure teachers can maximize their use of these instructional tools.

The TIS Department uses a 5-year replacement plan for school technology equipment. This includes staff, student, and office equipment as well as infrastructure, iPads, planetarium equipment, etc.

Equipment replacement at Glastonbury High School is spread over two years. Equipment at Smith Middle School and Gideon Welles School is also replaced (both schools simultaneously) over two years. Elementary school equipment is replaced in a single year. This plan helps us ensure equity for teachers and students across all grade levels. It also helps us keep replacement costs more consistent through the years. Unfortunately, the cost of laptops and desktops has increased recently, which is reflected in our estimates for future years.

## Technology Replacement Plans (Hardware)

### 2022-2023 (This Year) GHS Replacement Year 1, iPad Leases, and Infrastructure

In accordance with our 5-year replacement plan, the technology in Glastonbury High School is updated over two years. During the 2022-2023 school year, we plan to replace the following:

**Faculty and Staff laptops**— GHS Teachers will have the option of requesting an Apple MacBook or a Windows laptop.

**iPad cases, keyboards and headsets**—During the 2022-23 school year, iPads will be replaced in several grades due to expiring leases. This includes iPads for students in grades K-3, along with the annual grade 4, 6 and 9 leases. K-3 iPads will be returned during the summer of 2023 and we will stagger the end dates of the new leases for each grade so that they are replaced in 4<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grade. This will establish a cycle in which we replace student iPads for grades K, 3, 6, and 9 annually. Cases are purchased with each new iPad lease. In addition, each year we replace broken and worn keyboards and headsets across all grades.

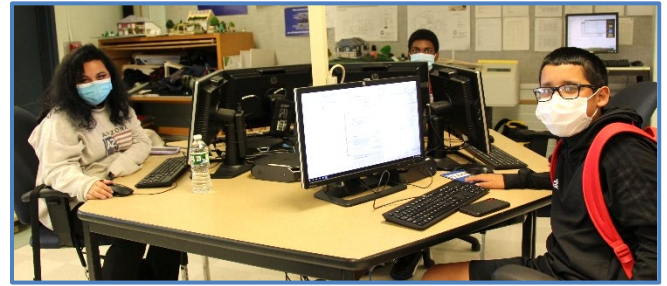


**Infrastructure**—Virtual Servers and Storage. These items are critical to the smooth, reliable and secure operations of our school system. Similar to other computing equipment, they need to be periodically replaced. The virtual servers include security servers that support user logins, secure storage of files and databases, and software that we use in several specialty labs such as World Languages, Computer Aided Design (CAD), and video editing.

## 2023-2024 (Next Year) GHS Replacement Year 2, iPad Leases, and Infrastructure

In accordance with our 5-year replacement plan, the technology in Glastonbury High School is updated over two years. During the 2023-2024 school year, we plan to replace the following:

**Specialty Computer Labs**—Glastonbury High School has several computer labs that support both Windows and Apple computers. The specialty computer labs meet the needs of a variety of courses across the curriculum. The specialty computer labs include: Computer Aided Drafting (CAD), Graphics, Art, Music (MIDI), Math (2), World Languages, and Business Education.



**iPad Cases, Keyboards and Headsets**—During 2023-24 school year, we will replace iPads for students in grades K, 6 & 9. Cases are purchased with each new iPad lease.-In addition, each year we replace broken and worn keyboards and headsets across all grades.

**Infrastructure**—Switches, access points and projectors. We will continue to upgrade the switching infrastructure in all locations. The current switches are over 10 years. Projectors will be replaced as needed.

## Technology Software and Subscriptions

The COVID-19 pandemic compelled teachers and students to pivot and adapt to new ways of teaching and learning. eLearning brought abrupt transformations in how we used technology to accomplish our goals. For example, during the pandemic a student would have difficulty showing the work they did with a pencil and paper during a math lesson. Now, with the ClassKick app, students can easily show work in real time to their teacher for immediate feedback. The pandemic and apps such as this have greatly accelerated our integration of technology into teaching and learning.

The three tables below categorize software/subscriptions currently reflected in the BOE Budget. The three categories are:

## iPad Apps

Since our district made its first iPad purchase, we acquired and distributed needed apps for the one-to-one program. Our methods for app purchase and distribution have changed over the years, but the philosophy has not. Any faculty member can request an app, but all requests go through an approval process. The steps for app approval include:

1. The request is entered into a form.
2. The request is forwarded to the appropriate administrator based on the grade and/or subject.
3. The administrator determines if the app is appropriate.
4. Approved requests are then forwarded to the Technology Department for a security and data privacy review.
5. If the app is then approved by TIS, the department will notify the requesting teacher and administrator and the app will be added to the iPad under Self Service.

Students and staff can access apps that are approved for them from the Self Service icon on their iPads. People will see the apps appropriate for their grade/subjects/courses.

Please see the comprehensive list of our district's current Self Service iPad apps below. Many of these apps are free. Many require a paid subscription (and our listed earlier in this report). And others were a one-time purchase (that can transfer from student to student as needed) made in previous years.

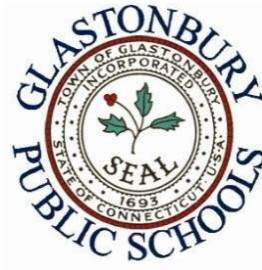
