1. **WIS Campus - Summer Restricted Access**

Summer school program will run July 6 through August 3, 2026, and will be hosted at Weston Intermediate School (WIS), rather than Hurlbutt Elementary as in prior years. The outdoor area and playground behind WIS will be restricted to summer program students only during this period, with district security staff on site throughout the summer to manage access. Communications will be sent to families through the Superintendent's office prior to the start of the program; the HES playground will not be restricted this summer.
